LAST GAME

The Baysox ended the first half with an 8-4 defeat at the hands of the Altoona Curve on Sunday night. After jumping out to a 4-0 lead through three innings that included a solo home run from Zach Watson and a two-run single from TT Bowens, Bowie fell victim to a disastrous bottom of the sixth inning. The Baysox made two errors in the frame, allowing five runs to score on just two Altoona hits, as right-hander Jean Pinto recorded just two outs after entering in the beginning of the frame, walking two and committing one of the errors with an errant toss to second base, before allowing the go-ahead two-run double to the Curve's Matt Frazier. The troublesome inning canceled out the great start from Alex Pham, as the right-hander fired five shutout frames in his Double-A debut, allowing just two hits and one walk while striking out three. The loss was the fifth in a row for Bowie on a Sunday, pushing the Baysox record to 2-8 on Sundays this season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots finished the first half of 2023 with a 42-26 record - best across the Eastern League, clinching a first half title in the Northeast division. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has been powered by its pitching staff this season, which holds a league-leading 3.74 ERA, while allowing the fewest home runs (50) across the league and accumulating the most strikeouts (681). Offensively, the Patriots have hit the most home runs (100) and stolen the second-most bases (126) - both notable weaknesses of this Baysox team. Somerset's roster is highlighted by six of the Yankees' top 10 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY/ No. overall), C. Austin Wells (No. 2 NYY/ No. overall), OF Everson Pereria (No. 4 NYY), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), RHP Richard Fitts (No. 8 NYY), and RHP Yoendrys Gomez (No. 9 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Yoendrys Gomez is set to get the ball in the series opener for Somerset. The No. 9 prospect in the Yankees' system, per MLB Pipeline, Gomez missed the vast majority of April and May on the injured list, not making his 2023 debut until May 28. He has yet to go longer than three innings in any of his five starts this season, but also has yet to allow more than a single run in any outing. The control has been less than stellar for Gomez at times, with 10 walks compared to 13 strikeouts across his 13.2 innings, but he is holding opponents to just a .159 average. Injuries also hampered Gomez each of the last two seasons, with shoulder issues in 2021, before Tommy John Surgery in August 2021 kept on the injured list until early June 2022 and limited him to just 47 innings. Still, the right-hander was able to progress quickly and make his Double-A debut with the Patriots by September, helping Somerset win game two of the Eastern League Championship series. Signed by the Yankees as an international free agent in 2016 out of Venezuela, Gomez features a mid-high-90s fastball, a sweeping mid-80s slider, a low-80s curveball, and a high-80s changeup.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. At the midway point, Mayo leads Minor League Baseball with his 42 extra-base hits, while his 26 doubles pace the Double-A level. The No. 8 Orioles/ No. 80 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in 14 of 15 games, and is coming off back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards, hitting .440 across the past two weeks with six home runs, seven doubles, and 13 RBI. Mayo also leads all of Double-A in both slugging (.609) and OPS (1.041), while sitting fourth in on-base percentage (.432).

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is enjoying one of the hottest stretches of his professional career. Cook has hits in 17 of 18 games for the first time in his minor league career, including eight straight. He's hitting .366 in that stretch with six doubles and four home runs. Cook has bounced back nicely in 2023, hitting .319 with 20 extra-base hits over the past two months, after hitting just .103 with one extra-base hit in the month of April.

TANDEM TROUBLES

The abundance of starting pitching experience on the Bowie roster has led to a reliance on tandems at times this season. Despite a collective starters' ERA of 3.67 - the best in the Eastern League and second-best at the Double-A level, when Baysox starters enter the game as relievers, they sport a collective 5.41 ERA. Bowie has utilized a tandem in 37 games thus far in 2023, going 19-18 in those contests. The back end of tandems have blown six leads for the Baysox this season, while failing to go two innings on nine occasions, and allowing four runs or more in 12 different contests.

FINISHING WITH A FLOURISH

Despite a last place finish in the Southwest division, the Bowie Baysox ended the first half particularly strong. Bowie won its last three, and four of its last five, series to close things out. Although, peculiarly enough, the Baysox did struggle to close out a series and take care of business during twin bills. Through its last five series of the first half, Bowie went 0-9 in games played either on Sunday, or as part of a doubleheader, while going 16-4 in all other contests.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- 5/23 After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
- 5/28 Faced the minimum over the first two innings thanks to a double play. Allowed three doubles. First five batters reached safely in the fifth inning.
- 6/3 Gave up a single and home run to the first two batters. Needed 71 pitches for just the first three innings. Allowed a second two-run home run in the fourth. Career high in hits allowed
- 6/9 Gave up a two-run home run to second batter of the second inning. Allowed two more runs in the following innings on three-consecutive two-out hits.
- 6/15 Struck out the first six batters, and seven of the first eight. Carried a perfect game into the seventh inning before allowing a leadoff single. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
