OCTOBER ONSLAUGHT: The Omaha Storm Chasers tied a modern franchise record with seven home runs, scoring 22 runs on 18 hits to trounce the Iowa Cubs, 22-4, on Friday at Principal Park. Omaha set season-bests in runs (22), extra-base hits (10), and walks (11) while tying a season-best in home runs (7). **INF/OF Lucius Fox** led off the game with a solo home run before **C/3B MJ Melendez** followed with a two-run double to notch his 100th and 101st RBIs of the season. **INF Angelo Castellano** hit a two-run homer in the second and **OF Edward Olivares** hit a three-run shot later in the same inning. **C Nick Dini** drilled a three-run homer in the fourth, **1B/OF Nick Pratto** smacked a solo home run—his 20th in Triple-A and 35th of the season—in the fifth, and Olivares launched his second home run of the night in the seventh. **OF Dairon Blanco** capped the scored with a grand slam in the eighth, the team's ninth grand slam of the season. It was the first time Omaha scored 20+ runs in a game since April 9, 2014 vs. Memphis (W, 20-3), the first time Omaha recorded 10+ extra-base hits since April 27, 2013 vs. Iowa (W, 13-2). It was the second time in modern franchise history (2011-pres.) and second time this season Omaha hit seven home runs in a single game, tying a mark set on June 13 at St. Paul (W, 15-4). With 21 home runs, the Storm Chasers have hit the most home runs in Triple-A during the Triple-A Final Stretch.

BRAGGING RIGHTS: With Wednesday's win over Iowa, the Omaha Storm Chasers clinched a winning or even record this season against each of their 2021 opponents. Omaha is currently 22-16 vs. Iowa, while finishing the year 9-9 vs. Columbus, 12-5 vs. Indianapolis, 4-2 vs. Louisville, 15-15 vs. St. Paul, and 9-9 vs. Toledo.

I-80 RIVALRY: Omaha and Iowa are scheduled to play 40 games in 2021. Through 38 games, the Storm Chasers hold a 22-16 record against the I-Cubs, batting .261/.341/.516 with 83 home runs and a 4.96 team ERA during the season series. Of the team's 76 home runs hit against Iowa this year, 46 have come at Principal Park in 20 games. Omaha holds a 521-485 edge across the 1,006 games played in the history of the two franchises.

HAPPY TRAILS, POLEY: Storm Chasers manager **Brian Poldberg** announced his retirement from managing last week. Poldberg, 64, began his 33-year coaching career with the Appleton Foxes in 1987 before becoming the team's manager in 1988. An Omaha native and Carter Lake, Iowa resident, Poldberg became the 18th manager in Omaha franchise history in 2014, leading the Storm Chasers to a Triple-A National Championship. He also won championships with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (1998) and Northwest Arkansas Naturals (2010). In 21 seasons as a manager in the Kansas City Royals organization, Poldberg has a career record of 1,354-1,409 and a record of 479-495 in seven seasons with Omaha. Poldberg trails only **Mike Jirschele**, who went 995-1,018 in 14 seasons, in wins and seasons as Omaha's manager. Poldberg currently ranks sixth in wins (1,354) among active Minor League managers. Prior to beginning his coaching career, Poldberg spent parts of six seasons as a player, including three with the Omaha Royals from 1983-1985, playing in 179 games for Omaha.

PREPARE FOR TAKEOFF: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and Minor League Baseball with 228 home runs, recording the third 200+ home run season in franchise history in the last 30 years (215 - 1998, 231, 1999). Omaha is the only team in Minor League Baseball with 200+ home runs. The Chasers are currently on pace to hit 231 home runs in the 129 scheduled games in 2021, which would tie the franchise single-season record of 231 home runs in 141 games in 1999. Omaha's rate of 1.80 home runs/game is currently a franchise single-season best. The Chasers have recorded at least one home run in 102 of 127 games this season, notching a 66-36 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 62 multi-homer games, including eight four-homer games, six five-homer games, and two seven-homer games. Of the team's 730 runs scored this season, 358 (49.0%) have been on home runs.

40 AND COUNTING: **C MJ Melendez** has hit 41 home runs between Double-A (28) and Triple-A (13) this season, the most in Minor League Baseball and most since 2014, when Kris Bryant hit 43. He is the first player 2016 (Dylan Cozens, 40) to hit 40+ homers in a single Minor League season and the 14th player (17th instance) since 1990. Melendez is the first primary catcher to record a 40+ homer season since 1995 (Todd Greene, 40). Of Melendez' 41 home runs, 30 have come as catcher, seven as designated hitter, and four as a third baseman. He is the third Royals minor leaguer to record a 40+ homer season, joining **Chris Hatcher** (46, 1998) and **Brandon Berger** (40, 2001). Should Melendez finish the season with the most home runs in Minor League Baseball, he would become the fourth Kansas City Royals minor leaguer to lead all of Minor League Baseball in home runs, joining **Chris Hatcher** (46, 1998), **Craig Brazell** (39, 2007) and **Mike Moustakas** (36, 2010). In addition to leading Minor League Baseball in home runs (41), Melendez is second in RBIs (102), third in OPS (1.020), and fourth in extra-base hits (65). During a current 10-game hitting streak, Melendez is batting .395/.447/.814 with four doubles, four home runs, and 17 RBIs.

RARE COMPANY: **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** enters Saturday one stolen base shy of 30 stolen bases this season, which would give him 30+ doubles, 30+ home runs, and 30+ stolen bases in 2021. The only players to record a 30/30/30 season in the last 30 years (since 1990) are Chicago (AL) prospect OF Luis Robert (31 2B, 32 HR, 36 SB) in 2019 and Oakland prospect Grant Desme (31 2B, 31 HR, 40 SB) in 2009. Witt Jr. would also become just the seventh player to record a 30+ HR/30+ SB season in Minor League Baseball in the last 20 years, joining Kyle Tucker (2019), Robert (2019), Joc Pederson (2014), George Springer (2013), Desme (2009), and Terry Evans (2003). The consensus No. 3 prospect in baseball and top prospect in the Kansas City Royals organization, Witt Jr. is batting .291/.358/.598 with 24 doubles, 17 home runs, 45 RBIs, 54 runs, and 15 steals in 60 games with Omaha. On the season, he's batting .293/.363/.584 with 35 doubles, 33 home runs, 96 RBIs, 98 runs, and 29 steals in 121 games. He leads Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (72), is tied for second in runs (98), third in RBIs (96), fourth in home runs (33), and tied for fifth in hits (143).

FANTASTIC MR. FOX: **INF/OF Lucius Fox** is in the midst of a season-best nine-game hitting streak, batting .425/.500/.775 (17-for-40) in that span with five doubles, three home runs, and nine RBIs. Fox hit .308/.372/.526 in 19 games in September after batting .195/.320/.234 through 36 games entering September. With 19 stolen bases (one caught stealing), Fox is one steal shy of recording his fifth straight professional season with 20+ steals in his five-season professional career.

FOR OMAHA: **LHP Austin Cox** makes his first career Triple-A start with Omaha. He made his Triple-A debut on 9/26 vs. IND, allowing five runs on four hits—including three home runs—with two strikeouts and two walks. He last started in Game 1 of the Double-A Central Championship Game, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings. Cox started the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, posting a 3.00 ERA in 15 starts. The No. 14 prospect in the Royals organization per *Baseball America*, Cox was drafted in the fifth round (152nd overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft following three seasons at Mercer University.

FOR IOWA: **LHP Luis Lugo** makes his eighth start with Iowa and third against Omaha. He allowed four runs (three earned) on five hits in 2.1 innings on 9/25 @ STP. In 10.0 innings against Omaha, Lugo has allowed five runs on nine hits with six strikeouts and six walks.
