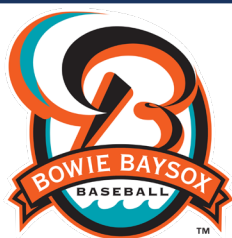


2021 SOMERSET PATRIOTS GAME NOTES

On the Bay: The Patriots continue a six-game series at home against the Bowie Baysox tonight. The Patriots took the first two games over Bowie despite falling behind 2-0 in the top of the first inning each night. Bowie has taken each of the last three games and have now scored first in each of the first five games of this series.

On Assignment: RHP Luis Severino is scheduled to make his second rehab appearance for the Patriots tonight. Severino tossed 2.2 innings on Tuesday and allowed two runs on two hits while striking out four. Chris Gittens, who has appeared in 16 big league games this season will also play for the Patriots tonight. The Texas native was the Double-A Eastern League MVP in the 2019 season leading the league in home runs (23), RBI (77) and OPS (.893).

Well Regarded: The Patriots have eight players on their active roster ranked in the Top 30 prospects in the Yankees' system: Clarke Schmidt (No. 2), Oswald Peraza (No. 4), Luis Medina (No. 8), Josh Breaux (No. 14), Brandon Lockridge (No. 15), Ken Waldichuk (No. 21), Oswaldo Cabrera (No. 23), and Hayden Wesneski (No. 24).

Playoffs, Don't Talk About Playoffs: The Patriots currently find themselves in a playoff position if the season were to end today. Somerset holds the second spot, one game behind the Akron Rubberducks and a half game ahead of both Portland and Bowie. The postseason will consist of just a championship series between the two teams with the top records in the league regardless of division.

Arms Race: The team's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.29) and BAA (.208), most shutout wins (13), second-most strikeouts (920), and third-lowest WHIP (1.17) across all levels of Minor League Baseball.

Where's OsWaldo: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera improved his on-base streak to 27 games with a hit last night. Over the streak, Cabrera has reached base at a .317 clip. It's the longest such streak for Cabrera this season and is the second-longest on-base streak on the team this year.

Locked In: Brandon Lockridge clubbed his sixth home run in last night's game. It was his first since July 22 and extended his on-base streak to nine games. Despite only playing in 22 games with the Patriots this season, Lockridge leads the team with six three-hit games. He has multi-hit games in nine of his 22 games with the team and is hitting .330 with a .374 OBP. That includes a .348 average and .429 OBP over six games in August.

Going Streaking: Isiah Gilliam and Jesus Bastidas are enjoying impressive streaks. Gilliam is batting .297 (11-for-37) with a .366 OBP over his current ten-game on-base streak. Bastidas is hitting .306 and getting on base at a .432 clip on his 11-game on-base streak to begin his time in Double-A.

Running Low: The Patriots have scored just four total runs over their last three games. It's the lowest run total in any three game stretch this season. Somerset has now lost three straight, losing consecutive games for just the fifth time this year.
