FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders stormed back late but ultimately fell 9-6 to the Tampa Tarpons on Sunday afternoon at George M. Steinbrenner Field. Keiner Delgado helped lead the offense, smacking a two-run home run as a part of a five-run eighth inning. Wesley

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to Tueday's contest, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced RHP Brad Case and his Minor League rehab has been transferred from the FCL Pirates to Single-A Bradenton. Case has been on the 60-day injured list with Triple-A Indianapolis since May 7. The right-hander started 13 games for the Marauders back in 2019, where he sported a 5-5 record with a 4.29 ERA. The former 17th round pick in 2018 also appeared in two games on rehab last year in Bradenton.

LAKELAND'S BACK: The Bradenton Marauders welcome in the Lakeland Flying Tigers for the second and final time at LECOM Park this season. The Marauders ended the first half and started the second half of the season against the Detroit Tigers affiliate back in June.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top seven home run leaders in the Florida State League, with **Axiel Plaz** and **Esmerlyn Valdez** currently tied for third with 12. **Shalin Polanco** is tied for seventh with 10 and is just two away from tying his mark from last year. Cárlson Reed tossed four scoreless innings on Friday night in Tampa to lower his season ERA to 2.60. Hé is curréntly third in the FSL in ERA while also holding opponents to a .205 average, the fourth-best in the league.

BLANKED: The Bradenton Marauders were shutout for the fourth time this season after falling 7-0 in a shortened seven-inning affair on Saturday, Bradenton was held without a run last Saturday in a 1-0 defeat in 10-innings by the Jupiter Hammerheads with the Tarpons also blanking Bradenton on May 15 4-0.

THROUGH THICK AND THIN: Marauders C/INF Garret Forrester was activated off the 7-day injured list before Friday's contest. Last year's 3rd round pick by the Pirates has been on the injured list since May 11. Forrester was on rehab with the FCL Pirates over their last seven games.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Among players in Minor League Baseball this season aged 19 years old or younger, no player has more home runs than **Axiel Plaz**, who hit his 12th home run of the season last Friday night against Jupiter. Plaz holds the fifth-highest SLG (.518) among players 20 years old or younger as well. Current New York Yankees slugger Giancarlo Stanton holds the record for most HR hit in a season as a teen when he mashed 39 in 2008 as a member of the Greensboro Grasshoppers in the South Atlantic League (now the current Pirates High-A affiliate).

HOME RUNS SHOULD COME IN PAIRS: Esmerlyn Valdez hit his second multi-home run game of the season last Wednesday. Last season, Termarr Johnson and Rodolfo Nolasco each recorded a pair of multi-home run games. There has never been a three-home run game by a

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 68 home runs in 68 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton has 17 in their first 15 games with Axiel Plaz accounting for five of the 10. Esmerlyn Valdez has three as well. The 17 home runs are the third-most in Single-A this month, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who have 22.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system

CLOSE QUARTERS: Saturday's walk-off loss against Tampa marked the Marauders' 32nd one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 17-15 record in those games
