LAST GAME

The Baysox fell to the Altoona Curve 6-4 in a rain-shortened affair Saturday night. Altoona struck for two in the top of the first, as Liover Peguero launched a leadoff home run prior to an RBI infield single from Drew Maggi. The Curve would manage two more in the second, as this time, Peguero hit a two-run blast for his second long ball of the evening to give Altoona a 4-0 lead against right-handed starter Houston Roth. The Baysox would try and chip away for the remainder of the shortened contest, with Randy Florentino hitting a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the second to get Bowie on the board. An RBI single from John Rhodes as part of a two-hit night made the score 4-2 in the third. Altoona would bash its third home run of the night when Henry Davis hit a solo shot to left field, extending the Curve lead to 5-2 in the fifth. The Baysox got back within one in the bottom half, as Billy Cook laced a two-run double to make it a 5-4 game. As the fifth inning progressed into the sixth, heavy rain began to fall. The Curve would score a run on a wild pitch before the game was put into a delay during the top of the sixth, and then called shortly after.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter this afternoon with a record of 18-18. Altoona currently sits fourth in the Southwest division standings - just one game out of first place. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost four of six games to the Akron RubberDucks at home. Altoona took four of five games played against the Baysox last month at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve are led by C Henry Davis, as the No. 3 Pirates prospect and No. 48 overall prospect (per MLB Pipeline) ranks top five in the Eastern League in OPS (1.123 - 1st), on-base percentage (.463 - 1st), slugging (.660 - 1st), batting average (.311 - 3rd), home runs (10 - 3rd), and extra-base hits (16 - 4th). Davis' on-base percentage and OPS leads all of Double-A, while his slugging is second. Davis is one of six prospects in the MLB Pipeline Top 30 for the Pirates, alongside INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 PIT), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19 PIT), and OF Matt Frazier (No. 22 PIT).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jared Jones gets the ball this afternoon for Altoona, facing Bowie for a third time already this season. Thus far against the Baysox, Jones has given up two runs in nine innings, striking out 12 in the process, including a season-high seven strikeouts on Tuesday night in the series opener. This is only the third start for Jones since he took a brief stint on the injured list following his start against the Baysox in April. He has not gone beyond the fourth inning since his return from the injured list, and only threw 54 pitches on Tuesday. The No. 11 prospect in the Pirates' system, per MLB Pipeline, Jones features a power fastball has climbed to 96-99 mph through his professional career, and is accompanied by a curveball with depth and a sweeping slider, along with a changeup that sits in the high-80s, and can even climb into the low-90s at times. He was a second round pick of the Pirates back in 2020 out of La Mirada High School in Whittier, California.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 54 hits and a .386 average - 69 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto is hitting .422 in the month of May with a .456 on-base percentage. He has collected hits in 15 of his 16 games this month, and has 17 multi-hit games in his first 35 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.427) and OPS (.977).

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has continued to produce at home over the past few weeks for the Baysox. Dating back to the Erie series in early May, Cook is 12-for-27 AB (.444) at the plate in his last eight starts at home. Six of his 12 hits are for extra bases, including four home runs and a pair of doubles, to go along with 15 of his 17 RBI on the season. In this Eight game span, Cook has five multi-RBI contests.

TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.35 ERA with 164 strikeouts in 145.2 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 7.02 ERA, with only 56 strikeouts in 59 innings.

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. The Orioles' No. 5 prospect has demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting fourth in the Eastern League in average (.310), along with second in slugging percentage (.620) and OPS (1.010) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (19) and total bases (80), and sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 23-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base safely in 34 of his first 35 Double-A contests.

CAREER NOTES

- 4th most strikeouts (126), 3rd most innings (117.0), and 2nd most starts (22) across the Orioles' system in 2022.
- Named an Orioles Organization All-Star in 2022 after successful stints in High-A Aberdeen and Bowie. Pitched to a 3.69 ERA in 14 appearances/10 starts across 63.1 innings for the Baysox, including a 2.08 ERA in August with a .137 BAA.
- Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year in 2021.
- Nearly quit baseball before when only team offering him a roster spot out of high school was Division III Pacific Lutheran, "I honestly almost gave up baseball at the end of my high school career, I didn't really know if I loved it, but then I got that one opportunity ... and kind of found this new passion toward baseball."

NOTES BY OUTING

- Baysox Opening Day starter. Allowed two singles in the first inning, and was saved from allowing a run with an outfield assist. Allowed one base hit in every inning besides the third, but never worked with multiple runners on base.
- Allowed first run of the season in the fourth inning after a double and a single. Walked the first two batters of the fifth inning and was lifted.
- Allowed runners into scoring position in three different innings, but none reached third base. Mixed six flyouts and four groundouts.
- Third pitch thrown was hit for a solo home run. Walked and hit a batter later in the frame, but did not see another runner in scoring position. Left game tied at one, bullpen allowed six runs.
- Allowed three consecutive batters to reach in the first inning, and again in the second. An error and a walk lead to another run in the fifth inning.
- Allowed a solo home run to the third batter of the game. Only other runner to reach scoring position was a stolen base with two outs in the fifth.
- Second pitch thrown went for a double, but faced the minimum over the next 17 batters. With two outs in the sixth, a double, error, and three-run home run cost him the shutout performance
