Day Baseball

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the second of 18 matchups between the teams this season, with nine at each location. Reading won the season-series over Somerset in 2023 10-8, which included a 2-4 record at home and 8-4 on the road. Christian McGowan gets the start for Reading today, opposite Bailey Dees for Somerset.

Two in a Row

Reading started this week's series on a high-note, topping Somerset 10-4 Tuesday night. Carson Taylor had two hits and two RBI, while Marcus Lee Sang added two hits and drove in four runs. Andrew Baker earned the win, marking his first victory since the 2022 season. The 10 runs were a season-high for Reading, and five scored in the eighth was also a season best. Additionally, the Fightin Phils were 5-13 with RISP in the win. The lineup batted around in the eighth, marking the first instance this season after doing it six times last season (Last: 8/1/23 at HFD). The Fightin Phils have now won four of their last five games.

Bullpen Success

After a slow start to the season, Reading's bullpen found much success at Binghamton last week and on Tuesday to start the series with Somerset. Over the seven games, the group allowed eight-earned runs over 31 IP, which is good for a 2.32 ERA over the last seven contests.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr. stayed hot Tuesday night with a hit and two-runs scored. He is on a 12-game on-base streak and has been impressive as of late. Since April 10, he is slashing .324/.378/.500, with an .878 OPS. He also has three doubles, a homer, two RBI and eight runs scored over that span.

Carson on a "Tear"lor

Carson Taylor's scorching-hot start to the season continued on Tuesday night, with two hits, including a triple, and two RBI. His .378 average would be second in the Eastern League if he qualified. His 16 RBI lead the league and also rank second in all of Double-A. He is additionally hitting .333 with two outs and .692 (9-13) with RISP, which would lead the league and be second in Double-A if he qualified. With RISP, Taylor also has: 3 HR (5 XBH) and 15 RBI.

Lee Sang Rolling

Marcus Lee Sang snapped out of a 2-32 slide with a two hit and four RBI performance last night. He had a two-run home run in the fourth that proved to be the eventual game-winner, and added a two-run double later in the game. The four RBI were both a season-best for Lee Sang and a Double-A high as well.

Streaks on Streaks

A couple Fightin Phils currently hold impressive on-base streaks early in the season. Gabriel Rincones Jr. has reached base in his last 12 games, dating back to Opening Night on Apr. 5. Also, Robert Moore has an eleven-game on-base streak, dating back to his first start on Apr. 6.

Magic Number

Five runs is appearing to be the magic number in runs scored for the Fightin Phils this season. So far, Reading is 7-1 when scoring north of five runs in a game this season, while the Fightin Phils are 0-8 when failing to hit the five-run plateau.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 24, 2003: At Reading, Marlon Byrd, on rehab assignment from Philadelphia, hits a solo home run in the bottom of the 14th to beat Harrisburg, 9-8. Byrd was 2-for-8 in the game.

Somerset Synopsis

Somerset enters today with a 7-9 record, after going 3-3 vs Hartford last week. After this week, the Patriots host New Hampshire. Somerset finished 84-53 last season and ultimately lost to Binghamton in the Eastern League Semifinals. Nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects are on Somerset's roster, featuring: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (4), Brock Selvidge (10), Ben Rice (12), Agustin Ramirez (21), Zach Messinger (22), Trystan Vierling (23), Jack Neely (25), Tyler Hardman (26) and Danny Watson (28). DJ Lemeiahu is also expected to make a rehab appearance this week.

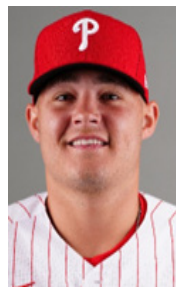
Patriots Pitcher

Righty Bailey Dees makes the start this afternoon for Somerset. Through three starts, Dees is 1-1, with a 7.90 ERA. He tossed a quality start last Thursday against Hartford, going six-innings, allowing three runs on six-hits with a season-best nine strikeouts. He was roughed up in his first start Apr. 6 against Richmond, allowing eight runs and five walks in just 3.1 innings. Dees split last season between High-A Hudson Valley (26 games) and Somerset (16), going 2-2, with a 2.60 ERA. He split 2022 between Single-A Tampa and Hudson Valley and 2021 with the FCL-Yankees. This is the first season Dees is a full-time starter. The Yankees drafted Dees in the 18th round of the 2021 draft out of Penn State. He pitched from 2018-21 with the Nittany Lions, going 8-9 with a 4.52 ERA in Happy Valley.
