#### **LAST GAME**

The Bowie Baysox used up all of their offense early on in their series finale with Binghamton on Sunday afternoon at Mirabito Stadium. The Baysox plated six runs over the first four innings of the game, and lead by as much as five runs, but fell quiet while Binghamton scored the last eight, settling on a 9-6 final. Despite frigid temperatures and occasional snow flurries, each side cracked three home runs. Bowie scored four runs in the second inning on a three-run home run by Shayne Fontana, and a solo shot by Jordan Westburg, his fourth of the season. Binghamton broke open for four runs against Antonio Velez in the fifth inning, chasing him from the game early, and scored single runs in the sixth and seventh to tie the game and take the lead for good.

#### TODAY'S OPPONENT

Akron has relied heavily on their pitching staff to bounce back from their own 2-3 start to open this series with a 5-4 record. Ending their homestand with a doubleheader against Reading, Akron allowed only one run in the 14 innings to sweep the twin bill. Entering this series, Akron's 3.17 ERA as a staff is the thirdbest in the Eastern League, and their 109 strikeouts lead the league. Offensively, Akron sits in the bottom half of the league in multiple categories, including only three home runs and 86 total bases, fewer than ten per game

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-handed pitcher Hunter Gaddis is slated to make his second start of the season for the RubberDucks, dealing for Akron in his season opener. Last Tuesday against Reading he pitched 5 1/3 innings of scoreless ball, allowing only three hits and striking out seven. Last season, he started 19 games for High-A Lake County, pitching to a 4.16 ERA and striking out 127 batters in 97 1/3 innings pitched. Along with going at least five innings in eight straight starts between July and August, his 11.74 K/9 dropped from 2019, pitching to a 14.45 K/9 that season.

#### SWINGING HAMMERS

Bowie has been seeing the ball leave the park in great volume this season. Bowie's 13 home runs is tied with Binghamton for the second-most in Double-A, while their 11 home runs allowed is the fourth-most in the Eastern League. Akron, meanwhile, has only managed three home runs at the plate, tied for the thirdfewest in Double-A. Akron did not hit a home run until their sixth game of the season, when Brayan Rocchio hit a solo home run against Reading. By Bowie's sixth game of the season, they had already hit seven home runs.

#### DASCH-ING THROUGH THE SNOW

Bowie first baseman Andrew Daschbach swatted his second home run of the season on Sunday afternoon during a snow flurry in Binghamton, part of a three home run day for Bowie. Both of Daschbach's home runs this season came in the Binghamton series. Sandwiched between the home runs, Daschbach struck out 11 times at the plate, including a five-strikeout day on Thursday. Daschbach was known for his strikeouts in 2021, his 144 strikeouts were the second-most in the Orioles system, behind only Kyle Stowers (171)

#### **WEST ROCKS THE EAST**

Infielder Jordan Westburg actively leads the Eastern League with ten runs scored, and is tied for second with four home runs on the year, it's a faster start for Westburg, as he needed 12 games last season before hitting his first home run with Bowie. In those first 12 game with Bowie in 2021, Westburg only went 6-for-45 at the plate (.133), but is already 9-for-33 (.273) this season. Westburg was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at shortstop by MiLB.com for his 2021 season, as he finished second in the system with a .380 OBP and 74 runs scored, while his 79 RBIs, 121 hits, 27 doubles and five triples ranked third and his .479 slugging percentage and .868 OPS ranked fourth

#### GET IT OUT OF THE WAY EARLY

Bowie tied for the early lead in the Eastern League for most walks allowed in a game on April 9, when they gave Richmond 10 free passes, including five walks after the seventh inning. Bowie only recorded double-digit walks in a game twice in 2021, walking 10 against Reading on 5/15, and walking 13, the highest single game total in the league, against New Hampshire on 6/22. While Bowie's entire pitching staff is only fifth in the league in walks allowed, Bowie's starting pitchers have allowed 16 walks in 35 innings, the second-most in the league.

#### Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

#### Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Transaction

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016.
