TODAY'S GAME: The Curve wrap up yet another series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Altoona plays 18 of their final 36 games against Richmond this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Carter Bins drove in a pair, but Altoona dropped their Saturday night matchup with Richmond, 8-4.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (20 games), he's batting: .351/.422/.473/.895 with 5 2B, 2 3B, 10 RBI, 3-4 SB. Siani scored a career-high 4 runs in Altoona's 8-7 win in 11 innings on Saturday, August 17 against Bowie. Siani is batting .377/.406/.508 with 3 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 12 RBI in 16G against Richmond this season, the highest average by a Curve player that has played more than one game against the Squirrels.

Siani is also amid a season-long 11-game on-base streak since August 11 during which he's hitting: .297 with a .409 on-base

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 57 road games, Cheng is batting .249 with a .772 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 50 home games, Cheng is batting . 181 with a .556 OPS totaling 6 2B, 1 HR, 18 RBI and 31 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .370 with a 1.135 OPS in 46 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

KERVIN AND THE GIANT PEACH: Infielder Kervin Pichardo had a 17-game on-base streak from July 23 - August 15, and has picked up right where he left off with hits in 5-of-7 games since. Pichardo has reached base safely in 22-of-25 games since July 23, during which he's hitting .280/.333/.530/.863 with 3 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR, 17 RBI and 2-2 SB. Since then he ranks T-2nd in the EL in HR (6), T-3rd in hits (28) and, T-4th in RBI (17).

YOU GUYS AGAIN?: Altoona and Richmond face off for another six-game series down the stretch of the season. The teams play 18 of their final 36 games against each other. The Curve are 10-6 against the Squirrels this season.

SEND US HOME: The Curve picked up their sixth walk-off win of the season on Saturday, August 17 against Bowie when outfielder **Tres Gonzalez** plated the winning run after Bowie committed a throwing error on a bunt attempt. **Jase Bowen** slammed a walk-off three-run homer on Thursday night for the Curve for the team's first win of the week.

PROVIDING RELIEF: Altoona's bullpen has had a revolving door of talent this year, though of late **Cy Nielson** and **Emmanuel Chapman** have performed the best. Nielson has struck out 16 batters in 10.1 innings since his call-up from Greensboro and Emmanuel Chapman has a 2.13 ERA (42.1 IP / 10 ER), 40 strikeouts and a .152 BAA in his last 16 appearances (3 starts).

SETTING THE TABLE: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has led off 34 times with Altoona this season and has become one of the league's best leadoff hitters. Fajardo has recorded .416 on-base percentage as the team's table setter and he ranks all over the league leaderboards since June 1: 3rd in BA (.299), 2nd in OBP (.405), T-6th in 3B (3) and T-7th in SB (14).

THE SQUIRRELS THAT FLY: Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the postseason in 2023, their first appearance since 2014 and enters this season ranked second on the club's all-time Managerial wins list. The Flying Squirrels are a touch light in the prospect department, but OF Wade Meckler (No. 14) is back in Runs Scored. the fold. INF Diego Velasquez is also here (No. 22) along with C Adrian Sugastey (No. 30).

THE FIRST IN FLIGHT: Dylan Cumming is back for another start on Sunday afternoon against Altoona. Signed as an undrafted free agent in Liberty in 2023, Cumming makes his 15th appearance, 9th start for the Flying Squirrels today, he's allowed 9 total runs in 13.2 innings against the Curve in three outings this season. Cumming hails from Grand Blanc, Michigan and began his collegiate career at Chicago State where he played three seasons. Cumming comes from an athletic family, his mother played Volleyball at Central Michigan and was inducted into the Flint, Mich. Hall of Fame in 2019 and his father played professional volleyball on the AVP tour.
