LAST GAME OUT

(MOOSIC, PA - June 5) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Norfolk Tides 7-6 Wednesday night at PNC Field. The Tides overcame a six-run deficit, but Ben Rice, in his Triple-A debut, launched a go-ahead homer to power the RailRiders to victory.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre sent all nine batters to the box during the opening frame. In his first Triple-A at-bat, Rice roped a single to right field that scored #1 Yankees prospect and MLB rehabber, Jasson Domínguez. After Jorbit Vivias walked, Carlos Narvaez loaded the bases with a single. Taylor Trammell followed with a three-run double to right center field, to make it 4-0. Greg Allen added an RBI base hit to score Trammell and give SWB a five-run advantage.

Norfolk scored one back in the top of the third. Heston Kjerstad tripled in #1 Orioles Prospect, Jackson Holliday, to make it 5-1. The RailRiders answered in the bottom half of the inning. Narvaez scored on a Jeter Downs RBI single making it 6-1 SWB. The Tides chipped away at the lead in the top of the fifth. Holliday and Daniel Johnson's knocked in runs, making it 6-3. Norfolk scored three in the top of the sixth to tie the game. After Terrin Vavra and Blake Hunt singled, Shayne Fontana bunted to reach and load the bases. Robinson hit an RBI single making it 6-4. The Tides inched closer off Holliday's RBI and then Kjerstad tied the game with a sacrifice fly. Rice continued his debut with his first Triple-A homer in the bottom of the seventh. His 365-foot blast gave SWB the lead at 7-6. It was his 13th home run of the season.

Yoendrys Gómez went 4.1 innings allowing two runs on three hits, striking out five. Anthony Misiewicz (W,2-0) gave up one run on two hits and Ron Marinaccio (S,3) closed the door with 2.0 innings of shutout ball. Norfolk's Jonathon Heasley pitched 2.1 innings surrendering six runs on nine hits. Tucker Davidson (L, 1-2) worked 5.2 innings of relief, garnering one run on one hit and striking out seven.

RICE IS NICE: Ben Rice, 25, joined the RailRiders yesterday to make his Triple-A Debut. He was sharp at first base and went 2-for-4 at the plate with two runs batted in and a pair scored. He singled in a run on a line drive to right in his first at-bat. Rice homered in his fourth a bat for the go-ahead run in a 7-6 victory. His 13 total long balls lead the Yankees farm system.

NEWS & NOTES

MAGIC MAN- Josh Maciejewski is set to make the start for SWB tonight, his third of the season but second with the RailRiders. In his last outing, a start against Toledo, Maciejewski worked four scoreless innings on a season-high 54 pitches. The southpaw has impressed in Triple with a 2.70 earned run average in 13.1 innings. He has also had six outings in Double-A this seasonand one inning of work in his Major League Debut backin April.

SAVES ARE BACK- The RailRiders had their first save since May 19th at Worcester. Coincidentally, it was Ron Marinaccio who sealed the victory back then and also last night totalling three saves. SWB has 18 lock downs on the season, good for third most in Triple-A baseball. Phil Bickford's four lead the way, while eight different pitchers have at least one.

WHO IS MATT SAUER?- Matt Sauer made his RailRiders debut last week, pitching one shutout inning. Sauer began his career by being drafted in the 2nd round of 2017 by New York. During the offseason, he was selected in the Rule 5 draft by Kanasa City and made his big league debut this season. With the Royals he made 14 appearances for a 7.71 ERA in 16.1 innings. Sauer was designated for assignment on May 20, was returned to New York on May 26 and was assigned to the RailRiders.

SPARSE SMACKS- Despite three hit by pitches by the RailRiders staff in yesterday's game, the team only has pegged 22 batters on the season. This is third least in all of Triple-A baseball. Will Warren has the most with five hit, while 15 total pitchers have recorded at least one this summer.

CARLOS CAN CATCH YOU- RailRiders primary catcher Carlos Narvaez has worked a 23% caught stealing record this summer. After nabbing Shayne Fontana trying to take second in the eighth inning, Narvaez has now caught 12 of 52 runners this season, including two on the week.

AGAINST NORFOLK- With a win last night the RailRiders secured a winning record against the Norfolk Tides this season. After sweeping them on the road in April, SWB is up 7-1 with four games remaining in the entire schedule against the Orioles Triple-A affiliate.

ONE-RUN FUN- SWB moves to an 9-7 record in one-run games after the close victory last night. The team had two prior one-run wins against the Tides when they met up at Harbor Park.

CLUTCH GENE- SWB leads the International League in batting average with runners in scoring position on the season. The team has hit .293 in this situation, scoring six more runs than the next best organization. The RailRiders are also impressive with RISP and two outs, hitting .289 in that circumstance.
