**TONIGHT:** The Stripers play game five of a six-game series vs. the Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay Rays) at Coolray Field. It is the 11th of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the fifth of 12 games to be played in Georgia. The first 2,500 fans through the gates will receive a **Sean Kazmar Jr. Bobblehead** (presented by **Slow Pour Brewing**). The Commissioner's Trophy won by the Atlanta Braves following the 2021 World Series also makes an appearance.

**VS. DURHAM:** Gwinnett is 65-61 (.516) in 126 games vs. Durham all-time at Coolray Field, including 2-2 (.500) through four meetings so far in 2022. The Stripers are 7-4-1 in season home series vs. the Bulls dating back to 2009, including 2-0-1 over the last three seasons (2018-21).

**TUI AT THE FUTURES GAME:** Tonight at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles, Stripers manager **Matt Tuia** will serve as the third base coach for the National League Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game (airing live at 7 PM ET on Peacock). Tui was named to the staff led by former MLB manager **Mike Scioia** on 7/7, and will be the first Gwinnett coach to participate in a Futures Game.

**WALK IT OFF:** **Chadwick Tromp** delivered Gwinnett's fifth walk-off win of the year last night with an RBI single scoring pinch runner **Braden Shewmake** with none out in the bottom of the ninth. It was Tromp's first walk-off RBI as a Striper and his third last-at-bat GWRBI of 2022 (also on 5/5 vs. CLT and 5/26-G2 at NOR). **The win was Gwinnett's 11th walk-off triumph over Durham all-time** (first since 8/11/21-G1, won 4-3 in 7th on **Cristian Pache** single).

**THE ELDER STROLLS:** **Bryce Elder** turned in his second scoreless start of the year last night, working 7.0 innings (6 H, 0 BB, 5 SO) in a no-decision. Over three starts in July, he's 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (4 ER in 20.2 IP), 1.02 WHIP, .219 BAA, and two quality starts. For the season, Elder ranks among the IL top 10 in WHIP (7th, 1.19) and BAA (8th, .237), going 5-4 with a 4.78 ERA in 13 starts.

**KINGS OF THE "K":** Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 875 in 88 games (9.94 SO/game). That's 21 behind Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (896 SO in 88G) for the most in Triple-A. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). **Kyle Muller** (1st, 117), **Tucker Davidson** (4th, 83), **Huascar Ynoa** (7th, 77), and **Bryce Elder** (15th, 71) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

**JULY TRENDS:** Through 13 games this month, the Stripers are 7-6 with a -1 run differential (outscored 36-35). Eleven games have been decided by three runs or less.

• **Dominant Arms:** Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in July in ERA (2.76), WHIP (1.05), BAA (.211), fewest runs allowed (36), and fewest walks allowed (31).

• **Struggling Bats:** Gwinnett hitters rank last in Triple-A in July in runs (35), homers (4), slugging (.631), and OPS (.631). The team's .232 average ranks 27th.

**DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:** **Delino DeShields Jr.** has reached base safely in 49 of 60 games (81.7%) with a plate appearance for the Stripers this season, batting .256 (44-for-172, 6 2B, 1 HR, 26 R, 17 RBI) with team highs in stolen bases (19, 2-7th in IL) and walks (43, T-11th in IL). In 34 games at Coolray Field, DeShields is batting .283 (28-for-99, 4 2B, 1 HR, 17 R, 13 RBI, 9 SB, 23 BB).

**OFFENSIVE ODDS & ENDS:** **Chadwick Tromp** is riding a five-game hitting streak since 7/8, batting .412 (7-for-17, 0 XBH, 2 RBI, .824 OPS) in that span. **Alex Dickerson** is batting .324 (12-for-37, 2 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 4 RBI, .798 OPS) in 11 games in July. **Ryan Goins** is batting .367 (22-for-60, 6 2B, 6 R, 9 RBI, .891 OPS) in 18 games since 6/14.

**DEMERITTE ALWAYS ON:** **Travis Demeritte** has reached base safely in 174 of 206 career games (84.5%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .275 (196-for-712, 52 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 140 RBI, 17 SB, .910 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining **Stefan Gartrell** and **Ernesto Mejia**.

**MULLDOZING:** **Kyle Muller** notched his team-leading ninth quality start of the season (has 9 of Gwinnett's 25 QS) on Thursday, working 6.0 innings (7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO) in a no-decision. Over his last eight starts since 6/2, Muller is 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (13 ER in 52.0 IP), 0.88 WHIP, .202 BAA, 10.56 SO/9.0 IP (61 SO), and seven quality starts.

• **IL Leaderboard:** **Muller leads the league in strikeouts (117, 6th in MiLB)** and ranks among the top 10 in WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (2nd, 94.1), CG (T-2nd, 1), ERA (3rd, 2.96), starts (T-4th, 16), and BAA (5th, .223).

**CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN:** **Michael Tonkin** pitched the ninth inning (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO) and earned his team-leading seventh save (T-6th in IL) on Wednesday. **The outing extended his scoreless streak to 13.2 innings, the third-longest active streak in the IL.** The streak has covered his last 12 appearances since 6/5, a stretch in which Tonkin has posted a 0.66 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .128 BAA, 14.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (22 SO), and four saves.

**FERGUSON DEBUTS:** On Thursday, 28-year-old RHP **Tyler Ferguson** made his Triple-A debut, pitching a scoreless seventh inning (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO). **He is riding a nine-game scoreless streak (9.2 IP, 0 H, 1 HB, 2 BB, 16 SO) dating back to 6/16 with Double-A Mississippi.** Ferguson is the eighth player to make his Triple-A debut for Gwinnett this season (see "Players Used" chart on Pg. 2).

**TARNOK TAMES DURHAM IN TRIPLE-A DEBUT:** Making his Triple-A debut on Wednesday, **Freddy Tarnok** pitched 6.0 innings (2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 4 SO) for the win. He is the first Gwinnett pitcher to log a quality start in his Triple-A debut since **Jeremy Walker** on 9/2/18 vs. Charlotte (win, 8.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 SO in 2-0 victory).

• **Dominant Stretch:** Including his final four starts with Double-A Mississippi from 6/18-7/7, Tarnok is 2-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5 ER in 27.0 IP), .167 BAA (16-for-96), and 11.67 SO/9.0 IP ratio (35 SO) over his last five starts.

**PROSPECTING:** Gwinnett's active roster features six listed on the MLB.com Atlanta Braves Top 30 Prospects list: **LHP Kyle Muller** (1), **RHP Bryce Elder** (2), **INF Braden Shewmake** (3), **LHP Tucker Davidson** (5), **RHP Freddy Tarnok** (6), and **RHP Victor Vodnik** (10).

### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

**Matt Tuiasosopo** is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... **On 7/7/22, was selected as the third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game (7/16 at Dodger Stadium)** ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
