TODAY'S START

- Bubic is making his 3rd start with Omaha and 8th rehab start this season after opening this year on Kansas City's 60-day injured list, as he makes his recovery from Tommy John surgery early last season ... he was transferred to Omaha on May 27.
This is his 7th season in the Royals organization ... skipped over the Double-A and Triple-A levels to make his MLB debut in 2020 and has almost exclusively pitched in the big leagues since, outside of a short stint in Omaha in 2022 ... since debuting with Kansas City in 2020, Bubic's 325.0 innings and 60 games started for the Royals rank third among the club's pitchers in that span.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JUNE 4 vs. MEMPHIS

Made his 7th rehab start, his 2nd with Omaha and his longest outing this year by innings pitched (4.0), batters faced (16) and pitches thrown (73) ... was his 2nd straight shutout start with the Chasers ... retired his first 4 hitters, worked around a walk and double in the 2nd inning, stranded both runners on ... stranded singles on ... in the 3rd and 4th innings.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Did not appear in any Cactus League games for the Royals ... opened the year on the 60-Day IL, sent to the Arizona Complex League to begin a rehab assignment on May 7, transferred to NW Arkansas on May 18, transferred to Omaha on May 27.
Over 6 total rehab outings this year, is 0-2 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER in 12.0 IP) with 4 walks to 20 strikeouts (5.0 K/BB).

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Only made three starts in his fourth Major League season ... placed on the Injured List on April 16 with a left flexor strain and underwent Tommy John surgery in late April. Threw 6.0 scoreless innings on April 9 @ San Francisco ... allowed two hits and no walks while tying a Major League career-high with nine strikeouts.
2022: In his third season with the Royals, made 28 appearances (27 starts) across two stints tied with Daniel Lynch for the most starts made by a Royal and ranked 5th on the staff with 129.0 innings pitched ... For the second straight year, induced a team-leading 19 double plays, which ranked 4th in the American League, with an AL-best 1.33 GDP-per-9.0 innings rate. Over his first 6 games (5 starts), was 0-3 with a 12.83 ERA (19 ER in 13.1 IP) with 11 walks and 10 strikeouts and was optioned to Omaha (AAA) on May 12 ... made 3 starts in Triple-A and pitched to a 6.59 ERA (10 ER in 13.2 IP) but struck out 17 batters in 13.2 IP (11.2 K/9) with just 4 walks (4.25 K/BB) ... recalled back to Kansas City on June 4 and finished the season in the majors.
2021: Began the season at the Alternate Site but was recalled on May 1 and remained with the Royals for the rest of the season ... tied 2nd among Royals pitchers with 9 quality starts, one behind Brady Singer (10) ... ranked third on the team with 130.0 innings. Named the Royals Pitcher of the Month for September/October, as he pitched to a 2.20 ERA (8 ER in 32.2 IP) over 6 starts with 26 strikeouts to 9 walks (2.9 K/BB).
2020: Despite having never pitched at the Double-A or Triple-A levels prior to 2020, made his Major League debut and 10 starts for Kansas City in the shortened season, going 1-6 with a 4.32 ERA (24 ER in 50.0 IP) and 49 strikeouts. Made his MLB debut in the Royals' 8th game of the season on July 31 vs. Chicago (AL) ... allowed 2 earned runs on 3 hits and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts ... earned his first MLB win in his eighth start, September 11 vs. Pittsburgh with 5.0 one-run innings and 6 strikeouts.
2019: Named Kansas City's Paul Splittorff Minor League Pitcher of the Year and the Wilmington Blue Rocks Pitcher of the Year, as he split the season between Lexington (A) and Wilmington (A+) ... led MiLB with 185 strikeouts (11.15 K/9), tied for the Minor League lead with two complete games, ranked 6th in WHIP (0.97), tied 9th in wins and ranked 10th in ERA. Pitched in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on July 7 in Cleveland and recorded the final two outs in the fourth inning ... also named the MiLB.com Fans' Choice for Best Starting Pitcher, an MiLB.com Organization All-Star, a Carolina League postseason All-Star and a Baseball America High Class-A All-Star.
2018: Spent his first pro season with Idaho Falls (R) and was named a Pioneer League midseason All-Star ... made 10 starts and struck out 53 in 38.0 innings (12.6 K/9).
COLLEGE (2016-2018): Attended Stanford University from 2016 to 2018 and pitched in 51 games (36 starts) for the Cardinal (Pac-12), with a 15-10 record, 2.82 ERA (70 ER in 223.1 IP) and 235 strikeouts. Majored in communications and aspires to one day be a sports color commentator.

2024: 19 of 24 appearances have been scoreless, including a span of 12 outings in a row, 14.2 scoreless innings between April 23 and June 4 ... tied 2nd in the league lead in games pitched (24).
Joins the Royals in 2024 to mark his 4th MLB organization ... spent parts of the first 7 seasons of his professional career from 2014-20 with Seattle before being traded to San Diego for two seasons (2020-21) and spending two seasons with Boston (2022-23) ... signed as a minor league free agent with the Royals last December.
Over parts of 6 Major League seasons, he has appeared in 119 MLB games (all in relief) with a 8-7 record and 4.03 ERA (52 ER in 116.0 IP) and 129 strikeouts to 60 walks ... his last MLB outing was on April 16, 2021 vs. Los Angeles (NL) ... has had five Injured List stints since reaching the Majors, including four for right arm injuries ... spent all of 2022 and most of 2023 rehabbing from Tommy John Surgery he underwent in April 2021, after pitching just two games that season with the Padres.
In 2023, he made 8 rehab appearances between the FCL Red Sox (R) and Greenville Drive (A+), with 7 strikeouts in 12.0 innings during July and August.

2024: Did not appear in any Cactus League games for the Royals, opened the year on Omaha's Injured List ... assigned to NW Arkansas (AA) on April 16 and pitched 5.1 scoreless innings for the Naturals (4 outings) ... assigned to Omaha for his 4th season with the Chasers on April 29 ... has 3 scoreless appearances, as well as 4 outings of allowing just 1 run.
Opened the 2023 season with Omaha and pitched in 5 games (4 starts) before his contract was selected by Kansas City on May 3, threw 2.0 scoreless innings in MLB Debut on 5/4 vs. BAL ... totaled 3 stints with each Omaha and Kansas City by the end of the season ... 4 of 12 appearances with Omaha were scoreless, including 3 starts.
Began his MLB career by retiring 35 of the first 39 batters he faced across 6 relief appearances into June 22, allowed only 4 walks, his 39 batters without allowing a hit marked the longest such streak in the Expansion Era.
Spent the entire 2022 season with Omaha ... made 29 appearances (24 starts) for the Storm Chasers with a 4.21 ERA (69 ER in 147.1 IP) and 105 strikeouts.

2024: Opened the year in Triple-A ... 14 of 22 appearances have been scoreless ... has 2+ strikeouts in 10 outings this year.
Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on August 29, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh ... after giving up 4 runs on 2 hits and 3 walks in his debut, Cruz made 9 MLB appearances and pitched to a 2.25 ERA (3 ER in 12.0 IP) while holding opponents to a .182 average (8-for-44) ... was an opener for the Royals 4 times in September.
Acquired by the Royals on January 23, 2023 from Minnesota as part of the package for OF Michael A. Taylor ... in his first season in the Royals organization in 2023, he recorded 9 saves in 43 appearances with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER in 49.2 IP) and 64 strikeouts (11.6 K/9) between NW Arkansas (AA) and Omaha ... pitched a career-high 67.1 innings, including 49.2 innings in the minors, 12.2 innings in the big leagues and 5.0 innings in the Dominican Winter League.
Over six minor league seasons (2017-23) in the Twins and Royals systems, he's recorded 323 strikeouts in 242.0 innings (12.0 K/9) ... 9 of his 18 career saves came in 2023.

2024: Appeared in 2 Cactus League games with the Royals with 2.0 scoreless innings ... his last spring outing was on February 26, missed time remove a cancerous mole from his back ... opened the year with Omaha and appeared in 6 games, with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER in 8.1 IP) and 10 K ... contract selected by the Royals on 4/22, pitched in 9 games with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER in 9.0 IP) and 10 K ... DFA'd on 5/24, sent outright to Omaha on 5/28.
Joins the Royals in 2024 to mark his 5th MLB organization ... spent the first 11 years of his professional career from 2012-22 with the Twins before being released in August 2022 and signing minor league deals with the Rangers (2022), Yankees (2022) and Cubs (2023).
Over parts of 8 Major League seasons, with the Twins (2015-22) and Cubs (2023), he has appeared in 296 MLB games (37 starts) with a 4.57 ERA (242 ER in 477.0 IP) and 469 strikeouts to 137 walks ... since converting to the bullpen in 2017, his 3.49 K/BB rate ranks 15th among 52 MLB pitchers that have appeared in at least 200 games with 0 starts.
In 2023, pitched 39 games in the Minors, including 36 with the Iowa Cubs (AAA), combined for a 3.47 ERA (19 ER in 49.1 IP) ... pitched 1 big league game, October 1 for the Cubs.

2024: Did not appear in a Cactus League game with the Royals ... placed on the Royals' 15-day injured list on March 25 with right shoulder soreness ... pitched 9 games with Omaha on rehab between April 26 and May 24, with 5 scoreless outings ... activated by Kansas City May 24, allowed 1 ER in 2.1 IP over 4 outings, optioned to Omaha May 30 ... has retired all 10 batters faced since being optioned.
This marks his 8th season in the Royals organization, has made the Major League Opening Day roster with the Royals in each of the last 3 seasons, 2021, 2022 and 2023 ... made his MLB debut with Kansas City on September 1, 2020, and finished that season with the team ... has 123 appearances (25 starts) with the Royals in the last 4 seasons.
Spent all of 2023 in the Majors, his first full season in the big leagues ... led the team in relief innings (63.0 IP), with the most relief strikeouts (67) and lowest opponents' average (.237) ... 77 total strikeouts marked an MLB career-high ... his average fastball velocity in 2023 was 99.1 mph, which ranked 1st in the Majors (min. 1,250 pitches).
Has pitched 18 games (17 starts) for Omaha between 2021 and 2022 ... pitched 50.0 innings over 2 stints in 2022 and 26.1 innings over two stints in 2021.

2024: Opened the year in Triple-A, 10 of 18 appearances with Omaha have been scoreless, including 5 in a row between May 19 and 31 ... 17 of 23 strikeouts have come on his slider.
Pitched at 4 levels in 2023, starting at Columbia (A) before stops in Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) led to his MLB debut on Aug. 17 vs. Seattle, 103 days after his last game in Low-A ... in 37 outings across three Minor League levels, worked a 2.10 ERA (12 ER in 51.1 IP) with 91 strikeouts (15.95 K/9) ... over 4 MLB games, his 4SBF averaged 98.8 mph.
In 39 Minor League games between 2021 and 2022, worked a 6.56 ERA (35 ER in 48.0 IP), with 51 walks and 77 strikeouts (9.56 BB/9 and 14.44 K/9).
Attended Texas Tech University, where he recorded a 3.41 ERA (55 ER in 145.1 IP) over four seasons in Lubbock and signed with the Royals as an undrafted free agent in 2020 ... was twice previously drafted, by the Tigers in 2019 (11th round) after his Junior year of college and by the Rays in 2016 (21st round) after his senior year of high school.

2024: 16 of 24 appearances this year have been scoreless, including 7x of 2.0 innings or more 4.0 perfect innings in a start on 5/11 vs. JAX ... his 39.6% strikeout rate (65 K in 164 TBP) is 2nd in MiLB (min. 35.0 IP) ... tied 2nd in the league lead in games pitched (25) ... tied 5th in strikeouts (65).
Began the 2023 season 3 NW Arkansas (AA), where he made 8 scoreless appearances with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings ... promoted to Omaha on May 3, where he made 41 appearances and went 7-2 with a 3.69 ERA (25 ER in 61.0 IP) ... led Omaha's pitching staff in wins (7), ranked 2nd in appearances (41), tied 4th in strikeouts (64) and tied 6th in innings pitched (61.0 IP) ... worked a 4-strikeout 8th inning on August 22, 2023 vs. St. Paul, the third Omaha pitcher since 2005 to record a 4-strikeout inning.
In 2022, pitched in 36 games between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) with a 3.18 ERA (25 ER in 70.2 IP).
Graduated from the Colorado School of Mines with a mechanical engineering degree ... worked a 4.73 ERA (118 ER in 224.2 IP) and hit .288 with a 1.142 OPS as an outfielder.

2024: Opened the season in NW Arkansas (AA), appeared in 14 games out of the bullpen and went 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (4 ER in 26.2 IP) and 7 BB to 34 K (4.86 K/BB) ... pitched at least 2.0 innings in 10 of 14 appearances with NWA, while 10 of 14 were scoreless ... assigned to Omaha on June 2.
Split the 2023 season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA), going 3-4 over 42 outings with a 3.99 ERA (22 ER in 49.2 IP) ... went 5-for-5 in save opportunities, 29 of 43 outings were scoreless appearances ... made his Double-A debut with a scoreless inning on Aug. 22 vs. Tulsa ... only pitched 2.0 innings or more 7 times.
Spent most of 2022 with Quad Cities (A+) but missed 1.5 months on the Injured List, appeared in 3 games on rehab with the ACL Royals (R) ... made 2 opener starts for Quad Cities, but also had 10 relief appearances that lasted 3.0 innings or longer.
Graduated from Millbrook High School (Va.) in 2017 and attended Coastal Carolina University in 2018, where he was teammates with Anthony Veneziano ... transferred to St. Johns River State College (Fla.) in 2019 and spent two seasons at Virginia Tech University (2020-21) going 7-3 overall with a 3.68 ERA (36 ER in 88.0 IP).

2024: 18 of 21 appearances have been scoreless, including a stretch of 14 straight from April 20 to June 4 (15.1 IP) ... has 2+ strikeouts in 10 games ... left-handed hitters are 5-for-35 (.143) against him this year with 15 strikeouts ... 2nd in Omaha's bullpen with a 13.30 K/9, 3rd with a 3.09 K/BB.
Since being drafted in 2018, Sisk's 220 appearances are the 2nd-most of any Minor League pitcher.
Acquired by the Royals on January 23, 2023 from Minnesota as part of the package for OF Michael A. Taylor ... spent all of the 2023 season with Omaha and went 2-4 with a 6.34 ERA (43 ER in 61.0 IP) and 62 strikeouts in a team-leading 58 outings (3 starts) ... ranked 4th in MiLB in appearances, the only to pitch in 50+ games without a save.
Drafted by St. Louis and traded to Minnesota on July 30, 2021, was a Twins MLB.com Organization All-Star as a reliever in his first full season with Minnesota in 2022, went 5-1 with a 1.57 ERA (11 ER in 63.0 IP) over 50 games with Wichita (AA) and St. Paul (AAA) ... among all Minor League relievers that made 50 or more appearances and threw a minimum of 60.0 innings in 2022, Sisk had the lowest ERA (1.57), while holding lefties to a .085 batting average (9-for-106).
