INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT, GAME 1: The Indians rode the right arm of Bubba Chandler and tallied three extra-base hits – their only hits of the game – to take the opener, 2-1. Nick Yorke and Jack Suwinski strung together a two-out double and triple in the bottom of the first to put Indy up 1-0, and Liover Peguero cleared the wall in left-center in the Indians' next at-bat to double the advantage. Chandler stranded two runners apiece in the second and third before the Bats scratched a run across in the fourth. Joey Wiemer doubled with two outs and scored on the next ball in play, when Eric Yang reached safely on a fielding error by first baseman Seth Beer.

BUBBA BATTLES: The Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, right-handed pitcher Bubba Chandler, picked up his second Triple-A win with one unearned run allowed with five strikeouts over 5.0 innings in yesterday's opener. In four starts with the Indians, Chandler is 2-0 with a 1.17 ERA (3er/23.0ip) and 28 strikeouts. Currently rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 41 prospect in MiLB, he ranks among full-season minor league leaders in WHIP (2nd, 0.75), batting average against (3rd, .160), strikeouts (5th, 75), innings (T-5th, 63.0) and ERA (10th, 1.86) since June 21.

LAUNCHED BY LIOVER: Liover Peguero launched his fourth home run in his past six games in Game 1 last night and followed it up with a two-hit performance in the nightcap. He has now hit safely in six of his last seven games with a .417 batting average (10-for-24) with five runs, three doubles, four home runs and eight RBI since Aug. 21 at Columbus. In 28 games since July 24, he is hitting .274 (29-for-106) with 15 runs, eight doubles, seven home runs and 25 RBI.

NICK KNACKS: Nick Yorke doubled in the first game yesterday and scored the first run of the game on Jack Suwinski's triple. He has reached base safely in 28 of his last 31 games since July 19 and has hit safely in 24 of his last 29. Since beginning a 15-game hitting streak on July 25, he is hitting .367 (37-for-104) with 10 runs, 13 doubles and 17 RBI. In that time, he leads the International League in doubles while ranking among leaders in hits (T-2nd) and batting average (.7th). He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after being traded to the Pirates from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester and is hitting .367 (33-for-90) with 11 doubles, 15 RBI, a .489 slugging percentage and .909 OPS in 25 games with the Indians.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT, GAME 2: Playing as the visiting team in Game 2 due to a July 3 postponement at Louisville Slugger Field, Indianapolis overcame an early 1-0 deficit with single runs in the fourth and seventh to take the nightcap, 2-0. The Bats led 1-0 through three innings behind a run-scoring single by former Indian Erik González in the second, but Liover Peguero knotted the score with an RBI double to plate Joshua Palacios. In the decisive inning, Andrés Alvarez drilled his second three-bagger of the season and third hit of the game into the right-field corner to capitalize on a leadoff walk drawn by Edward Olivares.

EXTRA BASES FOR ALVY: Andrés Alvarez led the Indians offense with three hits, finishing a home run shy of the cycle in last night's nightcap. It was his first game with three-plus hits since going 4-for-4 on June 15 at Jacksonville and his first multi-hit performance since July 26 at Iowa. It was also his first game with multiple extra-base hits since roping two doubles on June 3, 2023, with Double-A Altoona vs. Binghamton. His triple in the top of the seventh inning was the game-winning hit for Indianapolis, scoring Edward Olivares as the doubleheader-sweep clinching run.

TRIP TRIP TRIPLES: Jack Suwinski and Andrés Alvarez each drove in runs with triples in the first and second games last night, respectively, en route to the doubleheader sweep. The pair of triples were Indy's first since Aug. 13 and were the second and third in 25 August games. The Indians have roped just 23 triples in 125 games this season, eighth most in the International League, after leading the league with 42 in 2023 and 44 in 2022.

VICTORY FIELD: The Indians have now won nine consecutive games at Victory Field dating back to Aug. 13, a stretch which is tied for the longest home win streak in ballpark history. The previous two nine-game win streaks at The Vic came from April 25-May 12, 2013, and June 9-20, 1997. Game 2 of last night's doubleheader, despite being played at Victory Field, will be logged as a road victory for the Indians since they played as the away team in a makeup of a July 3 postponement in Louisville.

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians and Louisville Bats, Triple-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, continue their seven-game series tonight at 7:05 PM at Victory Field. It is the final meeting between the two teams this season and second at Victory Field after the Indians took two of three games from the Bats from July 4-6. Continuing the set for the Indians tonight is RHP Thomas Harrington (2-1, 3.09), who is making his fifth start with the Indians and first career start against Louisville. Countering for the Bats is former Indians reliever RHP Connor Overton (0-1, 7.80), who made one career appearance against Louisville as an Indian on Sept. 9, 2021.

PERFECT: Thomas Harrington, who was named the International League Pitcher of the Week last Monday, stunned for his second Triple-A win last night with 6.0 one-run innings and six strikeouts last Friday at Columbus. After tossing 5.0 perfect frames en route to 7.0 shutout with just two baserunners allowed in his last start on Aug. 17 vs. St. Paul, Harrington again took a perfect game into the sixth inning. He exited with just two baserunners allowed on a pair of base hits in his final frame. Harrington is currently rated as the Pirates No. 5 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and is 2-1 with a 3.09 ERA (8er/23.1ip), 17 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP and .171 batting average against (14-for-82) in four starts with Indianapolis since making his Triple-A debut on Aug. 4.

THIS DATE IN 1949: Trailing 4-3 through four innings in Game 6 of the American Association finals, the Indians scored the game's next six runs to run away with a series-clinching 9-5 victory in Milwaukee. Frank Kalin went 2-for-4 with a home run, double and two RBI, and Indians hurler Mel Queen went the distance while going 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI of his own to help Indy punch its ticket to the Junior World Series.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Thomas Harrington: Right-hander Thomas Harrington is set to make his third home start in Triple-A against Louisville. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after going 2-2 with a 2.24 ERA (17er/68.1ip) with the Curve.

Last Outing: Harrington took a perfect game into the sixth inning with six strikeouts in his second Triple-A road start at Columbus on August 23.

Against the Bats: Harrington has never faced Louisville.

Punch 'Em Out, Tommy: Harrington fanned double-digit batters in back-to-back starts with the Curve on July 10 vs. Bowie and July 20 at Somerset. The prior featured 11 strikeouts across 7.0 one-run innings, tying his career-high in both innings and punchouts.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Harrington was named the International League Pitcher of the Week, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, two strikeouts and only allowed two baserunners on August 17 vs. St. Paul.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Campbell (Buies Creek, N.C.) University.

2024 Highlights

- » Began the season with Double-A Altoona and hit .281 (56-for-199) with 19 runs, 13 extra-base hits and 21 RBI before being promoted to Indianapolis on June 18.
