NOTES AND NUGGETS

NEW (AND OLD) KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- Omaha added 2 hitters to the team's offense ahead of this week's series with Indy.
- Outfielder **Dairon Blanco** joined Omaha Tuesday, on a Major League rehab assignment ... he landed on Kansas City's 10-Day Injured list on March 31 with *right Achilles tendinopathy* ... Blanco previously played 194 games with the Storm Chasers previously, between 2021 and 2023.
 - Additionally, infielder **Peyton Wilson** was promoted to Omaha from Double-A Northwest Arkansas ... the 66th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Alabama, Wilson has been in Double-A since the start of the 2023 season and racked up 267 games with the Naturals, where he's slashed .268/.365/.418 with NWA ... Wilson currently ranks Top-10 among qualified Minor League hitters in on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS.

DON'T LEAD ME ON

Omaha has had a lead in just 1 of the team's last 8 games, with a long stretch recently of not leading at all.

- In the last 8 games (since April 24), Omaha has led for 5 of 68 innings (7%), while the Chasers have played from behind for 53 of 68 innings (78%).
- On Wednesday, Omaha snapped a streak of 50 innings without having a lead in a game, a stretch that dated back to last Wednesday, April 23 in Toledo ... after taking a 1-0 lead in the 1st inning in Toledo on April 23, Omaha played from behind or tied with its opponents from the 2nd inning of the game until taking a lead in the 2nd inning Wednesday.
- The Storm Chasers only led for 6 innings in last week's series with the Mud Hens ... over the final 4 games of the series, Omaha led for 0 of the 32 innings played, with Toledo leading for 25 of the 32 innings (78%) ... in the series as a whole, the Mud Hens led for 34 of 54 innings (63%).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff ranks near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 293 strikeouts this season.

- Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.41 K/9, which ranks 3rd at the Triple-A level.
- With 293 strikeouts through 29 games, an average of 10.1 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,505 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

DOWN, BUT NOT OUT

Comeback games have been a common theme through the first 25 games of Omaha's 2025 season, with 13 of the 29 games Omaha has played in this year being games where the winning team trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in 9 of 11 wins this year, with 4 wins where they trailed for at least half the game before coming back to win.
- Additionally, the Chasers have had a lead for at least an inning in 4 of the team's 18 losses ... in the 18 losses, Omaha has had a lead for a total of 13 innings.

NO-NO NOAH

Left-hander **Noah Cameron** made his Major League debut Wednesday night for the Royals against the Tampa Bay Rays, the 4th Storm Chaser alum to debut in the Majors this year ... he is the 339th Triple-A Omaha player to reach MLB after playing in Omaha.

- Cameron took a no-hitter into the 7th inning Wednesday ... he opened the game with 6.1 hitless and scoreless innings before a **Curtis Mead** single broke up his no-hit bid and ended the start ... Cameron struck out 3, with his first MLB strikeout coming against **Chandler Simpson** to end the third inning.

- Additional debutants this year include right-handed pitcher **Noah Murdock** (2024 Omaha), who made his MLB debut with the Athletics on March 29 at Seattle ... utility player **Tyler Tolbert** (2024-25 Omaha) made his MLB debut with the Royals on March 31 at Milwaukee ... left-handed pitcher **Evan Sisk** (2023-25) made his MLB debut with the Royals on April 15 at New York (AL).

MASHIN' MERV

While his first week in Triple-A was slow, outfielder **MJ Melendez** has picked up the pace offensively this week against Indianapolis.

- Melendez has gone 4-for-15 (.267) against the Indians this week, with a pair of doubles, 3 RBI and a walk ... he drove in a run in the first 3 games of this series.
- Last week, Melendez was just 2-for-24 (.083 average) with 1 double, 2 walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Overall with Omaha, MJ has an average exit velocity of 91.0mph ... that's the 3rd-best average exit velo on batted balls, among 15 Omaha hitters this year ... his RBI double in the 4th inning Thursday rocked off his bat at 112.0mph, the hardest hit ball of the season by an Omaha player and his 3rd-hardest batted ball recorded by Statcast (since 2022).

CAREER REVIEW

- Anthony Michael Simonelli is entering his 5th year in the Kansas City Royals organization, after being drafted in 2021 out of Virginia Tech ... Simonelli reached Triple-A for the first time in 2024 and ended the season in Omaha.
- Primarily a starting pitcher in college, Simonelli has largely pitched in relief in the Minor Leagues, with just 8 starts of his 124 career appearances ... however, across the last two seasons, 84 of his 85 outings have come in relief.
- Since the start of the 2022 season, Simonelli's 114 appearances rank 4th-most among Royals Minor League pitchers ... among those in the system with at least 175.0 innings across the last three seasons, he ranks 6th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.12 K/BB) and WHIP (1.25).

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Opened the season at NW Arkansas (AA) and pitched 33 games over two stints in Double-A ... also appeared in 10 games (1 start) across two stints with Omaha ... between the two levels, he combined to go 5-3 with a 2.93 ERA (24 ER in 73.2 IP) with 87 strikeouts.
- Among Royals Minor Leagues that threw at least 70.0 innings, ranked 1st in opponents' average (.172), 2nd in WHIP (1.00), 2nd in strikeout rate (29.6% K%) and 4th in ERA.
- Assigned to Omaha on June 2, with 3 of his 4 appearances scoreless, including 3.0 innings June 15 at Toledo ... transferred back to NW Arkansas June 17 and made 19 additional appearances for the Naturals ... assigned to Omaha again on August 29 and finished the season in Triple-A.
- Pitched 6 games for Omaha in September, including 1 opener start ... 4 of 6 outings were scoreless, including a pair of perfect outings.
- Got the final out of the 4th inning in Game 3 of the IL Championship Series for Omaha, allowing a single and walk before a groundout ended the frame with 0.1 inning pitched.
- Following the season, threw 8.0 innings without allowing an earned run for the Surprise Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League, striking out 8 batters and earning 1 save.

2023

- Spent much of the year with Quad Cities (A+), promoted to NW Arkansas (AA) on August 22, where he ended the season ... between the two levels, combined to go 3-4 with 5 saves (in 5 tries) and a 3.99 ERA (22 ER in 49.2 IP).
- Took two streaks from the end of 2022 into the beginning of 2023 ... did not allow a homer until May 30, for a career-best 26.0-inning homerless streak dating back to August 2022 ... did not allow a run until May 2, for the second 9.1-inning scoreless streak of his career.
- Overall, opened his year at Quad Cities with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER in 14.2 IP) across his first 13 games, with 17 strikeouts through May 28.
