## CARDS OUTLAST DRILLERS IN EXTRAS, WIN THIRD STRAIGHT: Matt

Lloyd singled to right center to score Chris Rotondo with one out in the top of the 10th inning and Andre Granillo slammed the door in the bottom of the inning with the help of a double play started by Jeremy Rivas as the Cardinals defeated the Drillers 6-5 in 10 innings on Saturday night. Noah Mendlinger had two hits and drove in 3 runs and Mike Antico also had a pair of hits with 2 RBIs for Springfield. With Lloyd's single he extended his hitting streak ti 7 games while Byran Torres reached twice to run his on-base streak to 21 to start the season. Matt Carpenter went 0-for-4 in his second rehab start.

It is the first meeting of the season between the two North Divsion rivals. The Naturals finished 64-74 in 2023, the worst record in the Texas League by a half-game.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

## CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 26 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 15 of them. Of those 15 games, the Cards have won nine, making them 9-6 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 11 of 12 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals hold an 8-4 record at home this season.

BIRDS BOAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE: Despite being shut out for the first time this season and only managing three hits on Wednesday, Springfield's lineup still sits atop the Double-A level in several offensive categories. Through 26 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .269 batting average; the Birmingham Barons are next at .264. The Cards also lead the the level in runs scored (154) and RBIs (143). Springfield is 2nd in hits (232) and OBP (.359), and has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally with 15 sacrifice flies this season, three more than any other team in Double-A.

The Cardinals have reached double-digit hits in 8 of their 25 games so far, and have 8 or more knocks in 19 games.

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 187 times in 26 games, the 2nd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals trail only the Spokane Indians (175 K's) for fewest whiffs in the minor leagues. The Indians, however, have played four fewer games than the Cardinals (22). The Birds are averaging just 7.2 K's per game.

STAFF LOOKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK: Since the Cardinals' franchise-record nine-game winning streak to start the season, Springfield has struggled to prevent runs the way they did at the outset. Over their last 16 games since April 16, the Cards have a 6.12 ERA, the highest mark in the Texas League by nearly a run (Amarillo Sod Poodles, 5.30). Springfield's WHIP (1.59) and opponents batting average (.272) are also last in the league since that time. Additionally, the 22 home runs the Redbirds have allowed over their last 17 games is most in the circuit during that time. The Birds have allowed 32 longballs this season, tied for the highest total in the league with the Sod Poodles.

Excluding the 11-run outburst by the Drillers on Wednesday, however, Cardinal pitching sports a 3.82 ERA in the other four games this week.

**TAKE ME TO CHURCH:** Despite having a 13-game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday afternoon, Cardinals outfielder Nathan Church ranks in the top-5 among qualified hitters in the Texas League in 4 different categories: RBIs (t1st; 21), hits (3rd; 34), total bases (4th; 51), and runs (t5th; 19). Church has hit safely in 22 of his 24 games played and has struck out just 8 times in 114 plate appearances (7.01%).

On Monday, Church was named Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month for April when he slashed .349/.402/.512 with 3 HR and 18 RBIs. He led all Cardinals minor leaguers in OPS (.914), hits (30), total bases (44), and runs (17). He hit safely in 19 of 20 games for the month.

BRYAN TORRES, ON-BASE MACHINE: Springfield leadoff man Bryan Torres has set the tone atop the Cardinals potent lineup, ranking among the leaders in the Texas League in 5 offensive categories: batting average (3rd; .346), OBP (5th; .433), hits (t6th; 28), doubles (t8th; 7), and is tied atop the league with 12 stolen bases. Torres has reached base safely in all 21 games in which he has played this season, the longest streak in the league.

YEAGER BOMBS: Cardinals infielder RJ Yeager has been a top run producer for Springifeld this season, leading the club and ranking top-10 in the Texas League in home runs (5th; 5), RBIs (t3rd; 19), and total bases (t9th, 42)

**REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With** 

his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning last Tuesday against Arkansas. Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.
