FOUR-RUN NINTH LIFTS CARDINALS TO WIN IN TULSA: Jacob Buchberger hit a go-ahead 2-run homer in the top of the 9th inning to start a four-run frame as the Cardinals came back from 2-1 deficit to defeat the Tulsa Drillers 5-2 on Wednesday night at ONEOK Field. **Nathan Church** had two hits including an RBI single in the 9th, while **Jimmy Crooks** and **Matt Lloyd** also drove in runs for Springfield. Starter **Quinn Mathews** made his best Double-A start to date, striking out 9 over 6.0 innings of one-run ball, and **Matt Svanson** pitched a scoreless bottom of the 9th for the Cardinals and is now 17-for-17 in save opportunities.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Chris Campos** makes his 6th start of the season for Tulsa... Last pitched on Friday, July 26 at Frisco and fired 4.1 shutout innings allowing 5 H while striking out 6 RoughRiders...Allowed 9 ER over his previous 2 starts (9.1 IP)...Has allowed 0 ER in 3 of his 5 Double-A starts, but has also surrendered 4 HR in 25.2 IP with the Drillers...Added to the Tulsa roster June 25... Began the season at High-A Great Lakes where he went 3-2 with a 3.15 ERA over 12 appearances (5 starts)...Struck out 50 Midwest League hitters while walking just 10 in 45.2 IP...Opponents were batting .213 against him at the time of his promotion...Spent his first full season at Low-A Rancho Cucamonga in 2023 going 5-6 with a 5.06 ERA in 25 appearances (16 starts), striking out 85 batters in 69.1 IP...Made 6 appearances in the ACL and Rancho Cucamonga after signing...Selected by the Dodgers in the 7th round of the 2022 draft out of Saint Mary's...Served as a two-way player with the Gaels, as did Dodgers All-Star **Tony Gonsolin**...LA's 4th pick out of Saint Mary's since 2016 and was college teammates with **Michael Hobbs**...23 years old

CARDINALS VISIT T-TOWN FOR FINAL TIME IN REGULAR SEASON: The Cardinals head west to pay their final visit of the 2024 regular season to Tulsa, OK for a six-game series against the Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) this week. Springfield won 4 of 5 in Tulsa in a rain-shortened series from April 30-May 5.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

CLASSIC ROCK 106.7 For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ROAD WARRIORS: A quality team away from home all season long, the Cardinals have the best road record in the Texas League at 29-17 (.630). Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland, and tops in the North Division. Springfield has not lost three straight road games during the 2024 season.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After a 1-4 start to the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals have bounced back and come into play Tuesday as one of the hottest teams in the Texas League. Over their last 24 games since June 30 the Cards are 17-7, tied with the Midland RockHounds for the best record in the Texas League during that time.

THANKS FOR THE MEMORIES, JULY: In a season that's featured plenty of peaks, the Cardinals put together their best month yet in July. With a 16-7 record in the month, Springfield set a season-high for wins in a calendar month surpassing the 15 wins the Cards accumulated in April. The Birds finished July with a 4.30 ERA (4th in the Texas League), and batted .272 for the month while averaging 5.3 runs per game (2nd). The Cardinals lost back-to-back games just once in the month (July 28 & 30). Springfield's quality July follows back-to-back under .500 months in May and June.

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in power numbers this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles during that same stretch. The Cardinals have clubbed 26 homers over their last 24 games, 4th-most in the Texas League, and have homered in 15 of their last 18 games. Springfield is 2nd in the league with a .429 SLG and OPS of .792 during that time. During the same stretch the Cards have scored 131 runs (5.5/game), 2nd in the league behind Midland (149).

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: Despite seeing their power numbers tick up, the Cardinals have struggled with runners in scoring position of late. Over their last 7 games, the Birds are just 5-for-49 (.102) with runners in scoring position, and are 0-for-15 over their last two games. Since coming out of the All-Star Break, Springfield is batting .195 (16-for-82) with RISP. On Wednesday night, the Cardinals went 2-for-8 in a 5-2 win.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 24 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd in the circuit among qualified hitters with a .341 average while adding 6 of his 7 HR this season with 19 RBIs with 4 doubles and a triple. **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging .624 and has a 1.022 OPS. Among qualified Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks'** .875 OPS and .401 OBP tops in the circuit. He is also 2nd in batting average (.303) behind **Bryan Torres** and SLG (.476) behind **Tim Tawa** of Amarillo.

REDMOND'S JULY: After breaking the Springfield career home run mark with his 60th on July 12 vs Wichita, **Chandler Redmond** kept hitting and put together his best month of the season in July. The Cardinals' slugger batted .347 for the month with 2 HR and 10 RBIs while adding 3 2B. His .949 OPS for the month led the club. A leadoff walk in the Cardinals' 4-run 9th extended **Redmond's** on-base streak to a season-high 10 games.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: During his current 16-game on base streak, Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** is batting .310 with 3 HR and 12 RBIs while adding 2 2B and is 6-for-6 in stolen bases. The hot streak is a welcome sign for the Cardinals after Church struggled to the tune of a .174 batting average in June.

MATTY TWO-BAGS: In the month of July, Cardinals INF/OF **Matt Lloyd** tied for the Texas League lead with **Carson McCusker** of Wichita and **Damon Keith** of Tulsa with 8 2B. **Lloyd** for the month of July batted .266 with 2 HR and 9 RBIs with a .851 OPS, and for the season is 3rd in the league with 55 RBIs.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 17-for-17 and his 16 saves and 38 appearances lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 13.0 IP (0.64 ERA) and is 7-for-7 in save opportunities.
