TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Albuquerque will play in game four of the series on Friday night. Express RHP Zak Kent is slated to start against Isotopes RHP Phillips Valdez. Tonight's first pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. CT.

LET'S RECAP

Round Rock won 15-1 over Albuquerque on Thursday night. The E-Train got on the board in the first after SS Davis Wendzel hit a solo home run and made it 1-0. In the third, Express 1B Blaine Crim knocked an RBI-single and it was 2-0. Round Rock LF Sandro Fabian hit a solo shot to open the fourth and a bases-clearing double from CF Bubba Thompson made it a 6-0 game. DH Justin Foscoe knocked in the final run after grounding into a double play and Round Rock was up 8-0. The Express had a four-run sixth inning behind three hits, one hit batter, two wild pitches and one error, which extended the lead to 12. The Isotopes scored in the seventh as DH Daniel Montano led off with a double then advanced and scored on two groundouts. In the home half of the seventh, Foscoe had the bases loaded and was hit by a pitch to put another run on the board. Fabian knocked in two more with a double and the score was 15-1, which stood final.

KENT BACK AT HOME

Round Rock RHP Zak Kent is scheduled to play in his first home game this season on Friday after spending nearly four months on the Injured List. He made his first start back on the road against Oklahoma City last week. Tonight will be his first game at Dell Diamond since September 8, 2022.

DUGGER, THE STRIKEOUT KING

Round Rock RHP Robert Dugger secured his 100th strikeout of the season in the second inning on Thursday against Albuquerque DH Daniel Montano. Dugger is now one of just four pitchers in the Pacific Coast League with over 100 punchouts (102). It is the first time since 2019 that he has reached 100 Ks on the season and is the fourth time in his career.

QUITE A WAY TO START A SERIES

Round Rock has scored 35 runs through the first three games of the series against Albuquerque, which is the most scored in the first three games of a series this season for the club. The previous high of 34 runs came against Sacramento, spanning June 17-20. Thursday night also marked the first time that the Express has put up double-digit runs in three consecutive games this season.

SANDRO IS SCORCHING

Express LF Sandro Fabian kept his bat alive last night after going 3-for-6 with two doubles, one home run, three RBI and one run scored. Fabian has homered in back-to-back games for the fourth time this season, all of which came after June 1. In his last six games, Fabian is 11-for-25 with four home runs and 14 RBI and has not struck out once.

HERNANDEZ DOES IT ALL

After making the start in right field on Thursday night for the E-Train, Elier Hernandez appeared in his 100th game of the season, a mark just two other Pacific Coast League players have reached. Hernandez helped lead the offense last night, going 3-for-6 with a double, RBI and three runs scored while extending his active hitting streak to a league-leading 15 games.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW, J.P.!

Round Rock OF J.P. Martinez, who has been in the Rangers organization since 2018, had his contract selected by the Texas Rangers on Friday and will be active for tonight's game in San Francisco. Martinez is hitting .311 (83-267) this season over 72 games between three levels, which is a career-best mark during full-season play for the lefty. To open a spot on the 40-man roster, OF Bubba Thompson was designated for assignment.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

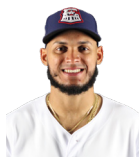
