YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Patriots, 7-6. Jace Avina opened the scoring with a solo homer in the first. In the second, Jackson Castillo hit an RBI double to open a 2-0 lead for Somerset. **Scott Bandura** tied the score, 2-2, with a two-run homer in the bottom of the fifth. The Patriots moved back ahead, 4-2, in the top of the sixth with a two-run single by Castillo. In the bottom of the sixth, **Aeverson Arteaga** tied the game with a two-run triple and scored on a single by **Adrian Sugastey** to give the Flying Squirrels a 5-4 lead. Somerset took a 6-5 lead in the top of the eighth with solo homers by Avina and Coby Morales. In the bottom of the ninth, **Parks Harber** reached with a two-out double, his first Double-A hit. **Drew Cavanaugh**, pinch-hitting, drove a two-strike homer to win the game, 7-6.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, in their second home series at CarMax Park. Richmond is 8-1 at home.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 15-3 start is the best in team history through 18 games, passing the 12-6 start in 2018 and 2023. Richmond has won all three series it has played so far this year.

RELENTLESS: In their 15 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 10 of them. In six of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. On April 4, they scored two in the ninth for an 11-9 win at Erie. In the April 7 home opener, they never trailed but jumped ahead in the bottom of the eighth for a 3-2 win over the Curve. On April 9, they scored two in the eighth for another 3-2 win against Altoona. On April 11, the Curve scored two in the top of the 10th before the Flying Squirrels walked off with three in the bottom of the 10th. On April 15 in Hartford, the Flying Squirrels scored five runs with two outs in the ninth to win 13-11. On Friday, **Drew Cavanaugh** hit a walk-off, two-run homer for a 7-6 win over the Patriots.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have the best record of all 150 teams across Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball, ahead of a 15-4 record for Double-A Chattanooga (Reds) and High-A Eugene (Giants). The Richmond offense leads the Double-A level in batting average (.296), runs (133), hits (186), total bases (306), RBIs (121), SLG (.487) and OPS (.876). In eight road games this year, the Flying Squirrels are batting .323 (100-for-310) and have scored 72 runs (9.0 runs per game). In 10 home games at CarMax Park, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .270 (86-for-318) and have scored 61 runs (6.1 runs per game).

THE PATRIOTS are 7-11 on the season, tied for fifth in the Northeast Division. Somerset split two games in a weather-shortened series against Portland to open the season before dropping four-of-six in Binghamton. Last week, the Patriots split a six-game home series against Reading. Somerset's roster features six players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS George Lombard (No. 1), RHP Ben Hess (No. 5), RHP Cade Smith (No. 10), LHP Kyle Carr (No. 13), LHP Xavier Rivas (No. 22) and OF Jace Avina (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list features seven Somerset players, including Lombard (No. 1), Hess (No. 5), Carr (No. 11), Cade Smith (No. 16), Avina (No. 19), Rivas (No. 21) and RHP Eric Reyzelman (No. 28). Somerset's roster also includes former Richmond shortstop Marco Luciano.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Darien Smith** makes his second Double-A start and his fourth appearance. He last pitched last Saturday at Hartford out of the bullpen and threw a career-high 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing three hits with no walks and three strikeouts. He made his Double-A debut in a relief outing on April 7 in the Flying Squirrels' inaugural game at CarMax Park and picked up a win, allowing one run over four innings. Smith pitched collegiately at Jacksonville University (2019), JUCO Eastern Florida State College (2020-21), Florida Gulf Coast (2022) and NAIA Southeastern (2023-24). At Southeastern in 2024, he was named the ABCA/Rawlings NAIA Pitcher of the Year, going 12-0 with a 1.87 ERA in 17 games (16 starts). Smith signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent that summer. In his first professional season in 2025, Smith went 8-0 with a 1.91 ERA in 20 outings (three starts). **For more on Smith, see page two.**

FOR SOMERSET: Left-hander Kyle Carr makes his fourth start of the year and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Carr last pitched on Sunday against Reading and allowed seven runs over 3.2 innings in a loss. In his first two starts this year, he combined to go 1-1 with a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP). Carr spent most of last season with High-A Hudson Valley, going 8-6 with 1.96 ERA in 22 starts. He was promoted to Double-A Somerset on September 3 and made three starts, going 0-1 with a 8.56 ERA. Carr was selected by the Yankees in the third round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Palomar College. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 13 Yankees prospect and No. 11 by MLB.com.

SABIN SOARING: **Sabin Ceballos** homered in back-to-back games on Tuesday and Wednesday and now has four home runs for the year. Over his last nine games since April 14, he is batting .353 (12-for-34) with two doubles, four homers and eight RBIs with eight walks. He homered twice in last Wednesday's win at Hartford and finished the night 3-for-4 with four RBIs and four runs scored. Prior to this stretch, he opened the season batting .160 (4-for-25) in his first seven games from April 3-12. Last season, Ceballos hit .311 (46-for-148) with five homers, 11 doubles and 27 RBIs over final 43 games from July 3-September 6.

GREAT SCOTT: **Scott Bandura** has 16 RBIs over his last 10 games since April 12, including 10 in last week's series at Hartford and four so far this week against Somerset. Last Tuesday night in Hartford, Bandura went 3-for-4 with two doubles and drove in five runs, the most by a Richmond batter this season. Last Wednesday, he hit a solo homer before clubbing a go-ahead, three-run double in the ninth. He added an RBI in Saturday night's win at Hartford. On Friday, Bandura hit a two-run homer. His 17 RBIs this season are tied for third in the Eastern League. He is tied for first in the league in extra-base hits (12).

JUST HOW WE DREW IT UP: **Drew Cavanaugh** has reached base multiple times in nine-of-his-11 games started this season and ranks second in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.509). He has at least one hit and one walk in nine starts. On Friday, he entered as a pinch-hitter in the ninth and hit the first walk-off home run in CarMax Park history, a two-out, two-run shot for a 7-6 win.

COX ROCKS: **Jonah Cox** has reached base in all 16 games he has played this season to begin his Double-A career. The streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this year. He opened the season on a 12-game hit streak and has at least one hit in 15-of-16 games he has played. For the year, he is second in the EL in batting average (.415) and third in OBP (.508). He is also tied for second in the league with 12 steals are swiping 58 bases each of the last two seasons.

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 275 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PACKING THE HOUSE: In 2025, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in total (446,679) and average (6,768) attendance for the fourth consecutive season. The average attendance was the highest in the franchise's history. April 7's inaugural game at CarMax Park had been sold out for more than a month, marking the 16th consecutive home-opener to sell out for the Flying Squirrels. This season, the Flying Squirrels rank second among the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance (7,444).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Jonah Cox** is second in batting average (.415), tied for second in stolen bases (12), third in OBP (.508), sixth in OPS (1.131), seventh in SLG (.623) and tied for eighth in hits (22). **Drew Cavanaugh** is second in OBP (.509), fourth in SLG (.650), fourth in OPS (1.159), eighth in batting average (.350) and tied for ninth in runs (16). **Scott Bandura** is tied for first in extra-base hits (12), second in runs (18), tied for second in hits (26), tied for third in RBIs (17), tied for third in doubles (8), tied for third in triples (2), tied for third in total bases (44) and ninth in batting average (.347). **Turner Hill** is tied for third in triples (2). **Jack Choate** is first in wins (5). **Joe Whitman** is fourth in strikeouts (25) and 10th in innings pitched (19.0). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (5) and tied for third in games pitched (8). **Mitch White** is tied for third in saves (3).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features three players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Parks Harber** (No. 16), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 24) and **Joe Whitman** (No. 25). **Adrián Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization and **Jonah Cox** is rated as the top defensive outfielder. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 7), Harber (No. 14), **Maui Ahuna** (No. 20) and Whitman (No. 26).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

2008: The Richmond Braves beat the Norfolk Tides, 8-6, at The Diamond. Mike Hampton made a rehab start for the R-Braves and threw three scoreless innings on 48 pitches. It was his first outing in nearly three years due to a series of injuries. Norfolk scored five runs in the top of the eighth to take a 6-5 lead. In the bottom of the eighth, Brent Lillebridge hit a go-ahead, two-run single and Brandon Jones brought him in to score for an 8-6 lead. **2017:** In 2017, the Flying Squirrels beat the Hartford Yard Goats, 2-1, at The Diamond. Down, 1-0, entering the bottom of the ninth, Hunter Cole tied the game with an RBI double. Later in the inning with two outs, Carlos Garcia brought Cole in to score with a walk-off single for a 2-1 win. Matt Gage allowed one run over 4.1 innings despite surrendering 10 hits. Jordan Johnson pitched four scoreless relief innings and struck out five.

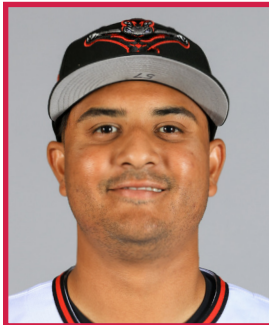
