#### **CAPTAINS LOG**

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County took 4 out of 6 games at South Bend but fell in the series finale 10-3 on Sunday. The Cubs scored 8 of the last 9 runs against the Captains bullpen.

SERIES WIN STREAK STAYS ALIVE AT FIVE: The Captains have won 5 series in a row. The Captains have not lost a series in 67 days, dating back to April 14-19 at Lansing.

BE LIKE MAICK: 1B Maick Collado gave Lake County a 1-0 lead on an RBI single in the top of the 1st inning, extending his hit streak to a teamhigh 6 games.

FASCIA SHOW: After South Bend took a 2-1 lead, C Zac Fascia tied the game with a solo home run, his 1st long ball since May 11 versus Dayton. ascia went 2-for-3, recording his 1st multi-hit game since April 21 versus

HIP HIP, JORGE!: Captains OF Jorge Burgos was named Midwest League Player of the Week, the 1st Captain to earn that honor since Dayan Frías on 6/24/2023. Burgos led qualifying MWL batters in OPS (1.305), SLG (.850), XBH (5) and TB (17) during the week.

MOVIN' ON UP: RHP Austin Peterson was promoted to Double-A Akron on Monday, joining LHP Parker Messick as the newest RubberDucks to set sail from Lake County since June 22. Peterson will make his debut on Friday at Altoona while Messick pitched 5 no-hit nnings last Sunday versus Binghamton. RHP Rorik Maltrud, who was signed to a Minor League contract the same day as RHP Carter Spivey, vas assigned to Lake County on Sunday. RHP Matt Jachec, an 18th round pick in 2023 out of Indiana State, was assigned to LC on June 21 after posting a 3.82 ERA in 18 appearances at Single-A Lynchburg,

2-OUT HITTING: Zac Fascia's solo homer in the top of the 2nd on Sunday marked Lake County's 17th home run with 2 outs. The Captains rank 4th in High-A with a .257 AVG with 2 outs this season.

LITTLE DEUCE COOP: Lake County C Cooper Ingle leads MWL catchers (min. 100 AB) in: AVG (.331), 2B (16), RBI (33), OBP (.422), SLG (.506), and PS (.928). Since May 17, Ingle is 5th in MiLB in OBP (.482), and 8th in AVG (.374).

THIS IS 40: The Captains won their 40th game of the season in their 65th contest, becoming the fastest team in franchise history to win 40 games since the 2010 Midwest League Championship Team won 40 in 61 games.

1st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they vere moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,803 egular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,415-1,388

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last 4 campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

#### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

FEELS LIKE 2010: Lake County clinched its 4th First Half title in franchise history on Saturday, its first since winning the 2010 Midwest eague East First Half crown. When they were previously in the South Atlantic League from 2003-09, the Captains won in 2003 and 2008. The 2010 Captains went 44-25 in the First Half and 77-62 overall, winning the Midwest League Championship in their first year

HE COULD THROW THAT SPEEDBALL BY YOU: RHP Austin Peterson recorded his High-A-best 8th quality start on Saturday night. He went a career-high 8.2 innings, allowing 2 earned runs on 4 hits while fanning 5 and walking none. He is the only pitcher in Minor and Major League Baseball with 85+ strikeouts and 6-or-fewer

STEAL AWAY: The Captains have stolen 114 bases through their first 69 games, their most through their first 69 games since at least 2005. Lake County ranks 2nd in MiLB with an 88.4% stolen base percentage.

TO THE MOON: INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, is 1 of 10 MiLB players with 65+ hits, 20+ extra-base hits, and 20+ stolen bases in 2024. After reaching 20 stolen bases in 58 team games, Mooney is the fastest Captain to steal 20 bases in a single season since **Delvi Cid** in 2010 (50 team games).

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson has struck out 8+ batters in 3 of his first 4 High-A starts. Wilkinson ranks 3rd in MiLB with 99 strikeouts in 59.1

TOP QUALITY: Through 69 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 23 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the 3rd-most in High-A, and tied for 8th-most in MiLB. RHPs Austin Peterson (8), Trenton Denholm (6), Carter Spivey (5), and LHP Parker Messick (4) have all recorded quality starts for the Captains this year.

CAN'T START A FIRE WITHOUT A SPARK: The Lake County starting rotation is among the best in the Midwest League, leading the MWL in: wins (26), innings pitched (353.1), strikeouts (342), and WHIP (1.18), while ranking 2<sup>nd</sup> in fewest walks (94) and 3rd in ERA (3.69).

#### By the Numbers

OF Guy Lipscomb ranks 4th in the Midwest League with a .303 batting average, the highest qualifying .303 average on the Captains. Since May 1, Lipscomb is batting .317 (45-for-142) with an .808 OPS and 12 stolen bases.

> Captains manager Omir Santos secured his 2nd career First Half title in 4 seasons as a manager in the Cleveland organization. He led the 2022 Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats to the Carolina League First Half title. Jorge Burgos, Trenton Denholm, Jake Fox, Angel Genao, Jake Miller, and Juan Zapata all played on that team.

Lake County owns a +82 run differential, the 2nd-highest +82 at the High-A level and tied for the 8th highest in Minor League Baseball.


Managerial/Coaching Highlights: Erminio enters his fifth season with the Guardians organization after spending 13 seasons as a coach with Kennesaw

**LAST TIME OUT:** On June 13 versus Fort Wayne, LHP **Matt Wilkinson** got the no decision, pitching 4 innings while allowing 3 runs on 4 hits, striking out 3 and walking 1. After retiring 9 of his 1<sup>st</sup> 10 batters faced, Wilkinson allowed a 2-run home run and a solo home run, exiting the game after 68 pitches (40 strikes) in the 13-6 win.

**MINOR LEAGUE RANKS: Wilkinson** has been one of the premier pitchers in Minor League Baseball so far this season. The 21-year-old leads all of MiLB with a 44% strikeout rate, 15.09 strikeouts per 9 innings, while also ranking 3<sup>rd</sup> with 96 strikeouts and 4<sup>th</sup> with a 0.86 WHIP.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "I love it, I love being called Tugboat," he said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

**TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson** is Cleveland's No. 30 prospect according to Baseball America. Per Baseball America, "Wilkinson gets bushels of whiffs thanks to a flat-plane fastball that has solid life, even if it sits 89-90 mph regularly, making it well below average in velocity. He also spots a fringe-average high-70s slider and mid-70s changeup. Everything plays up thanks to his plus control." <u>His scouting grades are as follows: Fastball = 40.</u> Slider = 45, Changeup = 45, and Control = 60.

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit. The MLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. <u>In 4 starts</u>, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing batting average. Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO). In 2 seasons, the left-hander went 15-4 with a 1.38 ERA, 221 strikeouts, and just 34 walks in 35 appearances (17 starts). In 2023, the Ladner, British Columbia native went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts). Wilkinson was named the 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year. He was also part of the 2022 Central Arizona squad that won the 2022 NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentine's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, LHP Raymond Burgos made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. He started at 2<sup>nd</sup> base and batted 8<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

**1B/OF Trenton Brooks**: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

**OF Johnathan Rodríguez:** On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.

#### The Captains are 5-2 as Los Picantes de Lake County this season.

On Tuesday, June 11, Los Picantes defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps at home by a score of 1-0. **3B Jose Devers** broke a scoreless tie in the bottom of the 7<sup>th</sup> inning with his 5<sup>th</sup> home run of the season, a 2-out solo shot on an 0-2 pitch. **RHP Austin Peterson** (ND) allowed 4 hits and no walks, while striking out 6 in 5.2 scoreless innings of work. **RHP Jake Miller** (W, 3-2), **RHP Jay Driver** (H, 3), and **RHP Zane Morehouse** (S, 5) combined to pitch 3.1 scoreless frames of relief out of the Lake County bullpen.

On Sunday, June 9, Los Picantes defeated the Beloit Sky Carp (Las Paletas de Beloit) on the road by a score of 5-3. **SS Angel Genao** hit his 1<sup>st</sup> career High-A home run on the first pitch of the game for his first career High-A RBI. 4 innings later, **Genao** recorded the 2<sup>nd</sup> RBI of his High-A career with a 2-out RBI infield single, which tied the game at 2-2. **RHP Trenton Denholm** earned his 7<sup>th</sup> win of the season, allowing 2 hits, 2 earned runs, and 3 walks, while striking out 6 in 5 innings of work.

On Tuesday, May 7, Los Picantes defeated the Dayton Dragons at home by a score of 9-5. **LHP Parker Messick** earned his 2<sup>nd</sup> win of the season, allowing 4 hits, 3 runs (1 earned), and 4 walks, while throwing 4 strikeouts in 5 innings of work. Lake County scored in each of its final 7 innings at the plate, including 2 runs in both the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> innings. 7 of 9 Picantes hitters recorded at least 1 RBI, with **1B C.J. Kayfus** and **C Cooper Ingle** leading the way with 2 RBI each.

On Sunday, May 5, the team defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps (Las Manzanas Luchadoras de Fort Wayne) at home by a score of 6-0. **RHP Austin Peterson** earned his 4<sup>th</sup> victory of the season, allowing just 3 hits and throwing 3 strikeouts in 6 scoreless innings of work. **LF Guy Lipscomb** (2-run single), **CF Jake Fox** (RBI double), and **DH Nate Furman** (RBI single) each drove in runs for Lake County.

On Tuesday, April 30, Los Picantes also defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps (Las Manzanas Luchadoras de Fort Wayne) at home by a score of 1-0 in 10 innings. In the bottom of the 10<sup>th</sup> inning, Lake County **SS Jose Devers** scored the game's only run on a throwing error after **OF Justin Boyd** hit a single. On the mound, **RHP Austin Peterson** (ND) pitched a then-season-high 7.2 innings, allowing just 4 hits, no runs, and 1 walk, while throwing 6 strikeouts.

The Captains went 4-3 as Los Picantes de Lake County last season, and a perfect 7-0 in 2022.
