NOTES AND NUGGETS

DON'T STOP ME NOW

This week, the Storm Chasers won their 4th series of the season, just the team's 2nd 6-game series win of the year ... they've also come up short a few times.

✦ Omaha took 3 of 5 from Norfolk in April, won all 6 at Toledo in June and won 2 of 3 at Buffalo in July ... last year, Omaha won 15 of 27 regular season series, including 11 6-game series.

✦ In addition to the 4 series wins, Omaha has 8 series splits ... of the 7 series splits that were 6-game series, the Storm Chasers have lost the final 2 games 3 times.

✦ In April, Omaha won 3 of the first 4 against Louisville, before losing the last 2 ... in May, the Chasers won 3 of the first 4 against Columbus and lost the last 2 ... last week against Louisville, Omaha won 3 of the first 4 and lost the last 2.

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

✦ **MJ Melendez** is hitting .280 (30-for-107) in the 2nd half and leads the team with 30 hits and 10 doubles ... he is 2nd on the team with 59 total bases and tied 2nd with 5 homers, 16 RBI and 12 walks in the 2nd half as well.

✦ **Carter Jensen** joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he leads the club with 9 homers, 66 total bases and 26 RBI since arriving ... 18 of his 29 hits going for extra-bases (8 doubles, 1 triple & 9 homers) ... his 19 walks lead the team, while batting .264 (29-for-110) with the Storm Chasers.

✦ **Dairon Blanco** is hitting .277 (26-for-94) since June 24 ... 13 of his 26 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 8 doubles, 1 triple and 4 home run, for 48 total bases.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 136 bases this year, and only been caught 27 times ... 136 steals rank 6th in the International League and 10th in Triple-A.

✦ 135-for-162 in steal attempts is a 83.4% success rate, the 3rd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 8th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 87.3%, 103-for-118).

VICTORY FIELD SCREECH

Omaha has won 6 of 11 games this year at Victory Field, a stadium where Omaha has played exceptionally ... since 2021, Omaha has won 25 of 38 games in Indy.

✦ Going back to 2023, the Storm Chasers have won 20 of their last 26 games at Victory Field (.769 winning percentage), the most wins Omaha has at any opposing venue in the last 3 years.

✦ In 2023, Omaha won all 8 games it played in Indy, sweeping a 3-game series March 31 to April 2, then winning all 5 from June 6 to 10 ... in 2024, the Chasers lost to the Indians on May 27, before winning 6 straight between May 29 and June 2.

✦ Since 2021, Omaha's 4.07 ERA (145 ER in 320.1 IP) is the club's best among the 7 ballparks where the Chasers have played 20+ games over the last 5 seasons.

✦ **Dairon Blanco**'s 31 hits are the most of any visiting player at Victory Field since 2021 ... he is 31-for-76 on the road against the Indians, a .408 average, while his 1.037 OPS is the best among those with at least 80 plate appearances as a visitor in Indy ... **Tyler Gentry**'s 17 RBI's as a visitor at Victory Field rank as the 3rd-most.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

✦ With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing only **Rich Hill** (14 years, 141 days MLB service), who made 9 Omaha starts ... Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024).

✦ **Bobby Dalbec**'s Omaha debut yesterday makes him the 16th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... by comparison, Omaha had 18 players in their 30's appear between the last two years (2023 & 2024).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has played many close games this season ... with mixed success.

✦ Friday marked the Storm Chasers' 6th 1-run win this year, ... Omaha is 6-19 in 1-run games this year, with 6 wins in 1-run games ranking as the fewest among full-season Minor League teams ... the other 119 full-season clubs have at least 7.

✦ Tuesday's win was Omaha's first 1-run win since June 10 @ Toledo, a 9-8 win over the Mud Hens ... the Storm Chasers had lost their previous 10 1-run games.

✦ Wednesday was the team's 24th "comeback" win of the year, a win after trailing at some point in the game ... Tuesday was the 2nd time Omaha overcame multiple deficits to win, the 10th time winning while trailing for more than 2.0 innings.

- Keuchel is making his **6th start with Omaha** this season ... he signed a Minor League contract with Kansas City on July 9, 2025 and was assigned to Omaha on July 12.
- Playing his **17th professional season this year** ... **Royals are Keuchel's 9th MLB organization**, has previously spent time with the Astros, Braves, White Sox, Diamondbacks, Rangers, Twins, Mariners and Brewers, as well as time in Japan ... he has pitched in the big leagues for HOU, ATL, CWS, AZ, TEX, MIN and MIL.
- Omaha is the 5th Triple-A club Keuchel has pitched for, following Oklahoma City, Round Rock, St. Paul and Tacoma ... he has pitched against Omaha 3 times - twice in 2012 with Oklahoma City and in 2023 with St. Paul.
- Keuchel has appeared in 282 MLB games (267 starts) across the last 13 seasons ... since making his MLB Debut with the Astros in June 2012, he has made at least 2 starts every season (not including this year).
- Among 104 MLB pitchers with at least 1000.0 innings pitched since 2012, Keuchel's 57.6% ground ball rate ranks 2nd-highest (1st: **Framber Valdez**, 62.3%) ... ranks 1st among 32 pitchers with at least 1500.0 IP since 2012.
- Is a **2-time MLB All-Star (2015 & 2017)**, the **2015 American League Cy Young Award winner**, a **5-time Gold Glove Award winner (2014, 2015, 2016, 2018, 2021)** and a **2017 World Series Champion with the Astros**.

Made his 5th start with Omaha, throwing his 1st quality start with the Storm Chasers ... worked scoreless innings in the 1st and 2nd, pitching around a single and walk ... back-to-back singles plated a run in the 3rd, unearned due to a throwing error by Keuchel ... a walk, double and RBI single scored a run in the 4th for the Indians ... worked around a walk for a scoreless 5th inning ... pitched into the 6th for the first time with the Chasers, a fielding error opened the inning and led to 2 unearned runs scoring on an RBI single ... only allowed 3 earned runs.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed a Minor League contract with the Royals on July 9, assigned to Omaha July 12.
- His 55.4% ground ball rate ranks 3rd among 31 Storm Chasers pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched this year (1st: **Noah Murdock**, 71.0%), but he ranks 1st among Omaha's starting pitchers (min. 1 start).
- Of the 396 pitches he's thrown for the Storm Chasers, has only thrown 1 harder than 89.0MPH, has not touched 90MPH ... his hardest pitch of the season was an 89.1MPH sinker to **Ji Hwan Bae** in the 1st inning of his most recent start on August 5 ... his fastest pitch over his first 4 starts was 88.6MPH.

2024

- Signed a Minor League contract with the Seattle Mariners on April 2 ... made 13 starts for the Tacoma Rainiers (AAA), going 7-4 with a 3.93 ERA (31 ER in 71.0 IP) ... pitched at least 5.0 innings all 13 times, with 4 quality starts.
- Released by the Mariners on May 20 after 7 starts with Tacoma ... re-signed with the organization on a new minor league contract three days later and made 6 additional starts for the Rainiers ... traded to Milwaukee on June 25 in exchange for cash considerations, had his contract selected by the Brewers June 26.
- Between June 26 and Jul 13, made 4 Major League starts for the Brewers and pitched to a 5.40 ERA (10 ER in 16.2 IP) ... designated for assignment on July 14, elected free agency on July 17.
- Signed a contract with the Chiba Lotte Marines of Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball on July 30 ... pitched in 8 games with a 3.60 ERA (16 ER in 40.0 IP) ... became a free agent after the season.

2023

- Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on June 22 ... made 6 starts for the St. Paul Saints (AAA) and went 1-0 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER in 32.0 IP) and 28 strikeouts ... named the IL's Pitcher of the Month in July, with a 0.96 ERA (3 ER in 28.0 IP), featuring 6.0 scoreless innings at Omaha on July 22 ... was the first Saints pitcher to win the award since the franchise joined the International League in 2021.
- Had his contact selected by the Twins on August 3, making 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Majors for Minnesota, going 2-0 with a 5.97 ERA (25 ER in 37.2 IP).
- Placed on 15-day Injured list on final day of season, October 1, with right calf strain ... became a free agent after the season.

- Won the American League Cy Young Award in 2015 with Houston, the third Cy Young Award winner in Astros history (also, **Roger Clemens** - 2004 and **Mike Scott** - 1986) ... also finished fifth in the Most Valuable Player voting ... went 20-8 with a 2.48 ERA and 216 strikeouts over 33 starts with Houston.
- A two-time AL All-Star (2015, 2017) with the Astros and a five time AL Rawlings Gold Glove Award® winner, doing so with Houston in 2014-16 and 2018 and with Chicago-AL in 2021.
- Finished fifth in AL Cy Young Award voting in 2020 with the White Sox ... went 6-2 with a 1.99 ERA (14 ER in 63.1 IP) and 42 strikeouts over 11 starts for the White Sox.
- Started the 2015 MLB All-Star Game at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati, allowing one run on two hits in 2.0 innings pitched in the AL's 6-3 victory.
- Has won AL Pitcher of the Month four times, all with Houston, including three times during the 2015 season (April, May and August).
- Named the Astros Pitcher of the Year three times (2014, 2015, 2017).
- Has 13 games of postseason experience (12 starts) with the Astros and White Sox ... is 4-3 in the postseason with a 3.71 ERA (26 ER in 63.0 IP) and 56 strikeouts ... in 2 starts during the 2017 World Series, pitched to a 5.23 ERA (6 ER in 10.1 IP), starting Games 1 and 5.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
