Junior Santos and David Griffin had solid starts, with Griffin tossing five scoreless frames in the second game.

Double Trouble: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have found success in doubleheaders this season. The Ponies have swept three of their six double dips this season, while splitting the other three. The Ponies are coming off a sweep of a doubleheader at Reading two weeks ago and on Thursday against Portland. They have split both doubleheaders against Akron this season.

Starting Strong: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have sent Luis Moreno, Christian Scott, Dom Hamel, Junior Santos, and David Griffin to the mound to start the first five games of this series at Akron. The five starters this series have combined to throw 27.2 IP and have allowed just seven runs and six walks, with 31 strikeouts. Moreno, Scott, and Hamel all earned the win in their respective starts. The Ponies have outscored the RubberDucks 23-13 in this series.

Out With the Old, In With the Young: Infielder **Wyatt Young** is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak, which marks his longest of the season. Young had a 15-game hitting streak last year for Binghamton, which spanned from July 13 to August 7. Young's 11-game hitting streak marks the Ponies' third hitting streak of 10+ games this year, with Brandon McIlwain having a 13-game hitting streak and Matt Rudick having an 11-game hitting streak earlier in the year.

Mets Trade Eduardo Escobar to Angels: The New York Mets traded infielder Eduardo Escobar to the Los Angeles Angels for two right-handed pitching prospects, **Landon Marceaux** and **Coleman Crow**. Marceaux is now ranked the Mets' No. 18 overall prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, and has been assigned to Binghamton. The 23-year-old was drafted by the Angles in the 3rd round in 2021 out of LSU. He made 12 starts for Double-A Rocket City this season. Crow is now ranked the No. 11 overall prospect in the Mets top 30. The 22-year old was a 28th round pick in 2019 out of Pike County High School (GA). In four starts for Double-A Rocket City this season, he went 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA, 31 K, and a 0.63 WHIP.

Last Start: Chacin allowed four runs on three hits in the first inning in the series opener against Portland last Tuesday. It was his shortest start of the season.

2022: Began the season with Brooklyn (A+) and made four starts before being assigned to Binghamton (AA) on May 2. Chacin had a strong Double-A debut last year on May 4 at Hartford. He went seven innings and struck-out three batters, while allowing two runs on four hits. Chacin led the Rumble Ponies in innings pitched (101.2) and starts (20) in 2022. He finished third in strikeouts (94) for Binghamton. Chacin pitched to a 4-9 record with a 5.67 ERA at the Double-A level in 23 appearances.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career.
