Rochester Red Wings LHP DJ Herz (3-2, 3.75) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Brad Keller (1-1, 9.00)

Series Finale To Take Us To Break – The Worcester Red Sox and the 1st-place Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Washington Nationals) play their series finale and the final game before the All-Star break when they tangle this afternoon at 1:05 pm at Polar Park. The WooSox will be bidding for a split of the 6-game set after Rochester took a 3 games to 2 lead thanks to their 4-3 victory yesterday. The Red Wings have won games one, three, and five of this series while the WooSox won games two and four. Game 6 will determine the series outcome today. This afternoon's game can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

Series Matters - Worcester is 6-6-4 in their first 16 series this season (6 wins, 6 losses, and 4 splits). The Sox did not split any of their first nine series until splitting a 6-game set in Charlotte at the end of May/early June. That started a stretch of four straight series splits until the WooSox won 3 of 5 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at the end of June. Worcester most recently lost 2 of 3 in a series vs. Syracuse over the 4th of July weekend at Polar Park. That came after the Sox won 2 of 3 in Syracuse to begin the month of July.

Breaking Point - After today, all teams will be off for the next four days (Monday – Thursday) for the Major League All-Star break. Worcester will resume action after the break on Friday with the opener of a 3-game series at Lehigh Valley that begins a 10-game roadtrip that continues with a 7-game series at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre the following week from July 23-28 (including a make-up doubleheader on July 24 at 5:05 pm. After today, the WooSox will not play again at Polar Park for the next 16 days until they host Buffalo for a 6-game series beginning on July 30 through August 4. Including today's series finale, Worcester has just 25 home games remaining this season (compared to 34 road games) as the WooSox have had 50 of their 75 scheduled home openings already.

This Series & Homestand – Worcester and Rochester traded victories the first four days of this 6-game series before the Red Wings gained the upper hand yesterday with their 4-3 win. The Wings won the series-opener on Tuesday, 5-1, but Worcester won on Wednesday, 7-6. Rochester prevailed on Thursday, 6-3, but Worcester evened matters with their 12-5 triumph on Friday night. The WooSox are 3-5 during this 9-game homestand (3-4 thus far) that began on July 4th with the Sox dropping 2 of 3 to Syracuse that weekend.

What Have You Done For Me Lately – The WooSox won three straight from June 30 – July 2 and then lost three in a row from July 3-5. Since then they have gone...win, loss, win, loss, win, loss between July 6-13. They hope to keep that pattern going today.

One Loss Too Many – The WooSox lost another 1-run decision yesterday, 4-3 although they did come out on top in a 1-run affair on Wednesday, 7-6 for only the fourth time all season. So, the Sox are 4-13 in 1-run games this season (the worst mark in the league). Every other IL club has at least six 1-run wins while Rochester is 14-7 in 1-run games on the year. The first three WooSox 1-run wins this year came against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on May 16 (13-12) and May 17 (9-8) both at home vs. the RailRiders and June 25 (6-5) in Moosic, PA. Worcester is 7-11 in 2-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games and they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

Wingstop – The Red Wings currently own the best record in the league in the 2^{nd} half at 13-4 and lead the 5th-place WooSox (8-8) by $4\frac{1}{2}$ games. The clubs have played 11 games against each other (all here at Polar Park) this season and Rochester has a 6-5 advantage. Worcester will finally make their first and only trip to Rochester all season from September 2-8 for another 6-game set vs. the Wings.

NEXT ON TAP - The probable pitching match-ups for the next WooSox series after the All-Star break from July 19-21 at Lehigh Valley are TBD.

Stats vs. the Wings – Worcester is 5-6 vs. Rochester this season. Sox batters are hitting .259 (86-for-332) with 16 HR vs. the Red Wings while WooSox pitchers have posted a 4.80 ERA (48 ER in 90 IP) with 15 HRA. Worcester has out-scored Rochester, 69-64.

Worcester/Pawtucket vs. Rochester– Worcester is once again even with Rochester at 39 victories apiece in the all-time series against each other (since 2021). The Red Wings are 27-19 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 20-12 in Rochester winning 19 of their last 26 games at the Rock. Furthermore, Worcester is just one game up on Rochester with 363 wins to 362 in the remarkably close last 44½ years of facing each other since the 1979 season. These two clubs went 12-12 during their season-series against each other last year as the teams finished 6-6 here at Polar Park and 6-6 in Rochester as well.

Leading the Way – Worcester is 1^{st} in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs with their .370 on-base pct. The Sox are also tops in the league with 471 walks (most in all of Triple-A in fact) and they are 1^{st} with 67 hit batsmen (with Buffalo has 65). It all adds up to an impressive .370 OBP. Furthermore, the WooSox are 2^{nd} in the league with 522 runs scored behind only Norfolk (540).

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 8-8 to begin the 2^{nd} half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1^{st} half good for 7^{th} -place in the IL East and $11\frac{1}{2}$ -games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

July Well Underway – Worcester is 5-6 in July. They are batting .250 (91-for-364) with 17 HR along with a 4.50 ERA (49 ER in 98 IP) this month while out-scoring the opposition, 60-54. The Sox are in the midst of playing 18 of 27 games on the road between June 25 and July 28. Starting July 30th, the WooSox will play 18 of 30 games at Polar Park through September 1.

June Over – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3rd highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June. Worcester went 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, and 14-14 in May.

Home Goods – Worcester is back below the .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 24-25 record in Worcester (compared to 19-23 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, were recently 0-7 from May 22 – June 5, then went 3-0 from June 6-8, before currently going 6-9 in their last 15 games at home.

Five Below – The WooSox are 43-48 overall. Three times this season (all in June), Worcester had fallen to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500. Those dates came most recently on June 14 (30-37) as well as on June 12 at 29-36 and on June 5 at 26-33. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Left at the Altar – Worcester is 2nd in the league with 712 runners left on base this season. Gwinnett is 1st with 725 LOB.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – WooSox batters are 1^{st} in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 67 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

Rankings – Worcester is 10^{th} in the IL in team batting with a .259 average while Rochester is 9^{th} at .259. On the pitching side, the Sox are 10^{th} in team ERA (4.99) while the Red Wings are 19^{th} with a 5.39 ERA.

Daydream Believers - Worcester has had more success this season in day games (22-20) than at night (21-28).

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

Series Math – Worcester is 6-6-4 in their first 16 series of 2024 (6 wins, 6 losses, and 4 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester has 20 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 11 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7^{th} -place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1^{st} half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2^{nd} half.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (9-5)/(45-38) defeated Hartford last night, 5-2. Isaac Coffey improved to 6-2 on the season hurling 5 shutout innings with 6 strikeouts. Tyler Miller (2-run double) and Blaze Jordan (2-run single) had the key hits while Tyler McDonough added 2 hits and 2 runs scored.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of late this morning. Worcester has already used 61 players this season (27 position players and 34 pitchers). RHP Trey Wingenter will be #62 when he debuts for the WooSox.

RHP **Trey Wingenter**, 30, was optioned from Boston on Friday. He was acquired by Boston in a minor league trade with the Detroit Tigers on July 6 and made his Red Sox debut on July 9, allowing three runs in 1.0 inning against the Oakland Athletics. Wingenter (WING-enter) has also posted a 3.31 ERA (12 ER/32.2 IP) with 48 strikeouts in 26 games this season for Triple-A Toledo. Originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the 17th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft, the Alabama native owns a 5.52 ERA (54 ER/88.0 IP) in 91 career Major League games (one start) with the Padres (2018-19), Tigers (2023), and Red Sox (2024).

The WooSox have sent 15 players to Boston since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, and LHP Bailey Horn. Those 15 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, and OF Wilyer Abreu who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa (DFA), Dalbec, Heineman, Campbell, and Valdez are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
