Today: It's a Capital City Market Kids Day, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Lugnuts have won each of the last two games, giving the Nuts a 4-3 record during their eight-game homestand vs. Fort Wayne (1-1) and Great Lakes (3-2). A win today would clinch a series victory over the division-leading Loons.

Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Loons 5. On Christmas in July, the Lugs scored three runs in the 1st and 2nd innings against debuting Loons starter Brady Smith, coasting to victory in front of 6,896 fans at Jackson Field. Second baseman **Jared Sprague-Lott** went 2-for-4 with his 4th home run of the year, a walk and three runs scored, and **Jake Reinisch** lined a two-run double and an RBI single to lead an 11-hit attack.

On Deck: The Lugnuts head off to Appleton for their final West Division road trip of the year, next returning home on August 4 to welcome in Lake County.

Induction Day: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** will be inducted today into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. Beltrán was drafted 49th overall in 1995 from Fernando Callejo High School in Manati, Puerto Rico. After debuting in the Gulf Coast League, Carlos opened the 1996 season at age 18 as the Lugnuts' starting center fielder, batting 8th in the lineup. But in his 11th game with the Lugnuts (off to a slow offensive start, batting .143/.163/.190, 6-for-42 with two doubles, one steal, one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán was injured in a collision. He was sent back to Baseball City, Florida, to rehab, and returned to action with the Short-Season A Spokane Indians, skipping over Lansing to Wilmington in 1997. He struggled with the Blue Rocks, too, batting .229 in 120 games, but broke out in 1998 with a .352 avg. at Double-A Wichita en route to making his MLB debut on September 14 against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, he was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, and a .279 avg. as a member of the Royals, Mets, Yankees, Cardinals, Astros, Rangers and Giants. In total, Beltrán was a nine-time All-Star and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series.

Welcome Back, Jack: Expect to see southpaw **Jack "the Beanstalk" Mahoney** pitching out of the Lugnuts' bullpen today. Mahoney was on the Injured List from July 1-25, but returns right on time to return to his home of Appleton, Wisconsin, for the upcoming six-game road trip against the Timber Rattlers. Mahoney's most recent appearance came on June 30 vs. Dayton, allowing three unearned runs in 2/3 IP. The Wisconsin-Milwaukee product is limiting lefties to a .200 average this year (2 walks, 11 strikeouts), while right-handers are batting .294 against him (12 walks, 10 strikeouts).

A Lott Better: Infielder **Jared Sprague-Lott** opened the season on the Lugnuts' roster, but was batting just .189/.317/.283 (10-for-53 in 16 games) when he was transferred to Class-A Stockton on April 27. He returned June 9 after winning the California League Player of the Week award, and the difference in Sprague-Lott's production has been significant. In July alone, the Arkansas product is batting .329/.442/.457 (23-for-70, 14 walks), and has reached base at least twice in each of his last nine games (13 hits, 8 walks).

Gig 'Em: Infielder **Ali Camarillo** has also been sensational as of late, batting .343 with a .420 OBP in July (24-for-70, 8 walks), with 11 hits in his last seven games. Ali has nine multi-hit games (out of 18 total) this month and 32 multi-hit games total in 2026: three 4-hit games, five 3-hit games, and 24 2-hit games.

Lugnut All-Stars: In the 2026 Major League All-Star Game, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was voted to started at first base for the A.L., but took the game off; 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve) went 1-for-2 with a single and a strikeout; and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer) struck out the only batter he faced, the White Sox' Munetaka Murakami.

JULY 26 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Facing the Clinton LumberKings on Summer Fun Day, Brad Glenn became the fifth Lugnut in team history, and the first since Travis Snider in 2007, to hit for the cycle, leading the way in a 9-5 victory. The Oklahoman singled in the 1st, homered in the 3rd, doubled (sun-aided) in the 5th, and snapped a 4-4 tie with a two-run triple in the 7th inning.

2018: Graham Spraker twirled seven scoreless innings en route to a 2-1 Lugnuts win at the South Bend Cubs. Combined with gems from Jordan Barrett (7 innings) and Maximo Castillo (6 innings), Lugnuts starters had worked 21 consecutive scoreless innings, a streak stretched to 23 innings by Kyle Weatherly before it ended on July 27th.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom homered twice and drove in four runs and Jake Walkinshaw struck out seven Great Lakes Loons in five scoreless innings in a 6-0 win at Dow Diamond.

MLB Pipeline's No. 15 A's prospect / No. 8 pitcher (behind Jamie Arnold, Gage Jump, Wei-En Lin, Braden Nett, Kade Morris, Shotaro Morii, Henry Baez); Fastball 55, Curve 45, Slider 55, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... topped the 2025 Lugnuts in starts (25)... closed A's 2026 Spring Breakout win, tossing the final two innings vs. Brewers prospects.

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... limited opposition to .195 avg. with 3.86 ERA in April, but allowed .260 avg. with 7.23 ERA in May. .263 avg. with 6.93 ERA in June, and .206 avg., 3.65 ERA (in 12 1/3 IP) in July... limiting lefties to .218 avg., righties to .274 (and .457 SLG)... allowing .342 avg. / .998 OPS in 1st inning... .228 avg. with bases empty, .271 with runners on base.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
