**MC GEE-BERRR:** Right-hander Easton McGee will make his first start of the season for the Sounds Saturday night against the WooSox. McGee has posted a 1-1 record with a 9.53 ERA for the Sounds in four relief appearances. He was recalled to the Brewers on April 10 and recorded a scoreless inning on one hit before he was optioned back down to the Sounds on April 17. The 28-year-old will be making his 32nd career Triple-A start and just the third of his career with the Sounds. His last start came against the Durham Bulls on August 17 of last season and posted 3.0 scoreless innings on two hits and had one punchout in a no decision.

**A LOT OF WINS:** With a pair of wins on Friday, Nashville reached 3,500 wins in franchise history. The two wins also gave the Sounds their second series win of the year and a winning streak of four games, their longest of the season so far. After dropping five-of-six games to Gwinnett last week, the Sounds have responded with four straight wins over Worcester who began the week 10-4 and in second place in the International League.

**BROCK AND ROLLIN NOW:** In the continuation of Thursday's game, Brewers no. 22-rated prospect Brock Wilken collected his first Triple-A multi-hit game, finishing the game 3-for-3 with a double and two RBI. Wilken had entered the game 3-for-50 through his first 15 games of the season and ended a three-game hitless streak with his performance against Worcester. It was his first multi-hit game since September 3 of last season with Double-A Biloxi, ending a 23-game span between multi-hit games. With his double, half of Wilken's hits this season have now gone for extra bases (2 2B, HR) and he has 10 RBI on the season to lead the team.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** Luis Lara ended the continuation game with a hit, a walk, and two runs scored to extend his hitting streak to seven games which later came to an end in the seven-inning game that followed. His seven-game hitting streak was tied for the second-longest of his professional career behind an eight-game streak he had with High-A Wisconsin from August 27-September 4, during the 2024 season. He was the first Nashville player to reach a seven-game hit streak since Ernesto Martinez Jr. had one August 22-September 9, 2025.

**WAGS TO RICHES:** Jacob Waguespack earned his first save of the season by closing out the top of the seventh in game two Friday night at First Horizon Park. It was the first save for Waguespack since September 7, 2021, against the Syracuse Mets when he was with Triple-A Buffalo. Waguespack has now converted on 11-of-14 save opportunities for his professional career and 3-of-4 in his Triple-A Career. Friday night was his fourth scoreless appearance in five games in the month of April and his fifth overall in seven appearances this season.

**DO THE DREW:** Left-hander Drew Rom earned his first win of the season and his first win since September 13, 2023, on the road in Baltimore when he was with the St. Louis Cardinals. Rom carries a 3.12 ERA through his first eight appearances of the season. After not allowing an earned run in any of his first five games of the season, Rom has allowed one earned run in each of his last three games. In two appearances against the WooSox this week, Rom has struck out four batters over 2.0 IP and leads all Nashville relievers with 13 strikeouts on the season. He added two more on Friday night to get him out of a bases-loaded jam with just the one run allowed in the top of the sixth inning.

**IN A PINCH:** Freddy Zamora provided the first pinch hit opportunity of the season for Nashville in the eighth inning of the continuation game from Thursday. After his lineup, the Sounds are hitting just .188 (6-for-33) in pinch hit opportunities since the start of the 2022 season.

**DOZEN'T STOP:** Eddys Leonard and Jett Williams both extended their current on-base streaks to 12 games after reaching base in both games on Friday. The pair represent two of the four different on-base streaks of 10+ games for Nashville this season behind current clubhouse leader Greg Jones (13 G). Cooper Pratt held the other with his 10-game on-base streak that came to an end on Wednesday of this week.
