NOTES AND NUGGETS

CLIPPING COLUMBUS

Games at Werner Park between the Storm Chasers and Clippers have heavily favored Omaha since the Chasers joined the International League in 2021.

Since 2021, Omaha has a 23-12 record in the regular season over Columbus at Werner Park, 25-13 including 2024's International League Championship Series.

Over the last 21 games at Werner Park (since June 26, 2022), the Storm Chasers are 17-4 against the Clippers ... the Chasers won the final meeting between the two teams in 2022, then swept the 6-game series in 2023, June 13-23 ... Omaha won 5 of 6 over Columbus during the regular season last year, then took 2 out of 3 in the playoffs and have won 3 of 5 games this week.

In the 20-game span where Omaha is 17-4 against Columbus, the Chasers have outscored the Clippers 151 to 108 (+43) while outpitching them 201 to 185.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 57 bases this year, and only been caught 9 times ... 57 steals rank 5th in the International League and 6th among Triple-A teams.

57-for-66 in steal attempts is a 86.4% success rate, the 2nd-highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 4th-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 93.5%, 29-for-31).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 419 strikeouts this season ... that is 3rd in the league and 4th at the Triple-A level, 16 strikeouts behind the top Triple-A team (Iowa, 435).

Over 368.0 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.25 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 419 strikeouts through 42 games, an average of 9.98 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,486 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

John enters today on a career-best 13-game hitting streak ... the 3rd-longest active streak in the league, Rave has hit .400 (20-for-50) with a 1.300 OPS since May 3 ... his previous career-best hitting streak was 10 games from June 11-25, 2023, from his final game in Double-A to his first 9 games with Omaha that year, a stretch where he hit .417 (15-for-36) with a 1.238 OPS.

Rave has also scored a run in all 13 games of his hitting streak, with 20 runs scored in the stretch since May 3 ... Rave holds the modern Omaha scoring streak record, when he scored a run in 14 straight games, from June 17 to July 6, 2023.

Rave leads Minor League Baseball in run scored (39) ... he leads the league in triples (4), is 5th in total bases (77), tied 6th in steals (14), tied 7th in extra-base hits (17), 10th in slugging percentage (.531) ... additionally, he leads Omaha in hits (42).

Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 36 of 42 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 15 of 36 games (.417 OBP leading off the 1st inning), including 2 straight and 6 of his last 10 games ... that includes 9 hits (3 singles, 3 doubles, 3 homers), 5 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 3 leadoff homers this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues.

SLAM DEVANNEY

Over the first 5 seasons (536 games) of **Cam Devanney's** pro career, he hit 69 homers, but no grand slam ... he's hit 3 in May, all coming in a span of 22 plate appearances.

He is one of 9 players with multiple grand slams, and one of just 3 players to hit 3 grand slams this season (also: **Cole Carriag** and **Jose Rojas**) ... like Devanney, all 3 of Rojas' grand slams have come in the month of May.

Angelo Castellano holds the modern Omaha record for grand slams, with 4 since 2005 ... 3 of them came in the 2021 season, which set the modern Omaha record for grand slams in a season.

In the last 5 years (since 2021), 4 professional baseball players have hit 4 grand slams in a season ... the last player to do so at the Triple-A level was **Pete Laforest**, who hit 5 grand slams in 2007 for the Portland Beavers.

Without a grand slam last year, Devanney tied for the league lead with 20 RBI when hitting with the bases loaded, tied 2nd with 13 total bases with the bases loaded, going 9-for-17 (.529) ... this year, Cam has nearly matched those numbers, going 4-for-5 with 13 total bases and 15 RBI when hitting with the bases loaded.

The last time an MLB player hit 3 grand slams in 1 month was **Alex Bregman**, with 3 for the Houston Astros in June 2023 ... prior to Devanney and Rojas this month, the last Minor League player to do so was **Nick Gonzales**, with 3 in August 2021 for the Greensboro Grasshoppers.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 40

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 100 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.

In his 8th start of the season, earned his first win, allowing just 1 run over 5.0 innings ... opened the game with 3.0 scoreless innings, including a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd ... allowed 2 hits in the 1st and 3rd innings, but did not allow a run ... 3 singles in the 4th inning scored a run, with a 2-out RBI single from Yordys Valdes ... worked around a walk for a scoreless 5th inning ... did not come out for the 6th inning, with 4 runs of support.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Over his first 3 starts, walked 10 batters and allowed 19 hits over 12.1 innings, for a 2.35 WHIP.
- Over his last 5 starts (Since April 17), has issued exactly 1 walk in each start ... in this stretch, has allowed 23 hits and 5 walks in 22.0 innings, for a 1.27 WHIP.

- Led Storm Chasers pitchers in home runs allowed (17), runs allowed (68), walks allowed (68) and tied for the most hits allowed (117) ... ranked 2nd among Omaha pitchers in regular season starts (20) and innings (104.1).

- Ranked 1st among Royals Minor Leaguers in starts (27) and innings (140.1) ... 120 strikeouts were the 4th-most among Royals farmhands behind Noah Cameron (149), Tyson Guerrero (123) and Steven Zobac (123).

- Made 9 quality starts, 3 in Double-A and 6 in Triple-A ... 4 of 9 quality starts came in a 5-start outing between May 9 and June 5, his final 2 with NWA and 2 of his first 3 with Omaha.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
