Last Time Out: Biloxi scored two in the first, two in the second and put the game away early with an eight-run third en route to a 13-1 victory... Ethan Small shut down the Trash Pandas, tossing a career-high seven shutout innings while striking out nine... Luis Castro led the offense with four RBI, coming up a triple shy of the cycle.

At the Plate: Brice is Nice: Since May 15, Turang is slashing .317/.366/.458, 7 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 19 RBI, 19 R, 6-10 SB... He has also hit safely in 23 of his last 26 games and has 12 multi-hit games in his last 23 played.... The Brewers 2018 first-round pick was on an 15 game hitting streak, which was broken on 6/12 by MIS... It tied the longest hitting streak in Shuckers history, and is the longest streak recorded in the AA-South this season

Oh What A Night: Biloxi scored 12 runs in the first three innings against the Trash Pandas on Friday night, scoring two in the 1st and 2nd before cranking out 8 runs in the 3rd... The Shuckers scored their eight-run frame with six singles, two walks and an error... Every player in the Shuckers lineup scored at least one run in the game, and eight of the nine batters recorded at least one hit, with six of the nine hitters registering multi-hit games.

Hitting Henry: Payton Henry went 2-for-5 with a double, a walk and a run scored on Friday night after he went 2-for-4 with a double on Wednesday night and recorded three RBI on Tuesday night... Henry now has 12 multi-hit games including four straight multi-hit efforts... Henry has also reached base safely in his last 15 games... In the month of June, Henry is hitting .389 (21-of-54), 4 2B, 3B, 7 RBI, 8 R

ThreexThree: Luis Castro went 3-for-5, 2B, HR, 4 RBI, R on Friday night... It was the third game in which Castro has recorded three hits in the series against Rocket City... For the series, Castro is now 9-19 (474), 2 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 4 R and has homered in three of the four contests... During Castro's 2019 Cal League Co-MVP season, the first baseman had 15 three-hit games and one four-hit outing.

On the Mound: It's a Small World: Lefty Ethan Small turned in a third straight career-best night on Friday, tossing seven scoreless innings to set a new career longest outing... The former Mississipi State Bulldog allowed just three hits and one walk while striking out nine... Over four starts in the month of June, Small has allowed one earned run in 24.1 innings while striking out 40 batters... Small set a new career-high with 12 strikeouts on 6/12 against Mississippi, which tied the franchise record for strikeouts in a game (Alec Bettinger and Bowden Francis - '19, Freddy Peralta - '17, Taylor Jungmann - '16).

Otero Comes To Town: Andy Otero turned in another scoreless long relief appearance for the Shuckers on Thursday night, pitching 3.0 innings while picking up his first Double-A win... Since joining the Shuckers on May 20, Otero has made 7 scoreless appearances and pitched at least two innings in each of his last five outings.

Long Ball Blues: Biloxi has allowed 65 home runs this year, the 4th most in all of Minor League Baseball (1st - Las Vegas: 79) and the most in Double-A... Biloxi did not allow a home run on Friday night, the ninth game this season that they did not allow a homer and the second consecutive game... In those contests, the Shuckers are 7-2.

What's Shuckin: Home Theft: Ryan Aguilar successfully stole home as part of a double steal in the second inning on Friday night... it was the fourth steal of home in Biloxi Shuckers history and the first time a Shuckers runner has stolen home since Trent Grisham on September 3, 2018 against Birmingham.

But That Late Rally Tho: Over their last 11 games, the Shuckers have outscored their opponents 18-5 in the eighth and ninth inning.
