## JUMBO SHIRMP CRUSH TIDES, 16-4

Jonah Bride smashed two home runs and Jacksonville hit five as a team on Wednesday to pound Norfolk 16-4. The Jumbo Shrimp batted around in the first inning, plating five runs with help from Bride and Victor Mesa Jr. home runs. After the Tides scored three in the second, Mesa Jr. collected a two-run single in the fourth to make it 7-3. Jacksonville batted around again during a seven-run fifth inning that featured long balls from Marty Costes and Bride. Norfolk scored one in the seventh and José Devers hit a two-run shot in the eighth to cap the scoring at 16-4.

## SO, ABOUT LAST NIGHT...

Jacksonville blitzed Norfolk on Wednesday in a 16-4 romp. The 16 runs scored for the Jumbo Shrimp were the club's most since pouring on 20 on May 27, 2023 against Charlotte. Jacksonville registered 22 hits, their most in a game since also collecting 22 on August 5, 2023 at Memphis. It was the club's most in a home game since at least 2005. Meanwhile, the Jumbo Shrimp's five home runs were their most in a game since blasting six during that May 27, 2023 contest against the Knights. Jacksonville's sevenrun fifth inning on Wednesday was their biggest inning since a nine-run eighth also during that contest against Charlotte.

## ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jacksonville infielder Jonah Bride blasted two home runs on Wednesday, his second multi-homer game in five days. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 15 -for- 38 (.395/.531/.816/1.347) with four doubles, four home runs, seven RBIs, eight walks and six runs scored. Bride leads the International League in OBP, SLG and OPS while ranking second in average and tied for ninth in home runs.

## SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 40 of their 151 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 40 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in nearly half of those, a total of 19 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a seven-run fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings, five frames of three runs and 11 two-run innings.

## YES WAY, JOSÉ

Jumbo Shrimp infielder José Devers has reached base in 13 consecutive games entering play on Thursday, tied for the third-longest active streak in the International League. Over this stretch, Devers is 16 -for- 48 , batting .333/.385/.625/1.010 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBIs, three walks and 10 runs scored. Thus far in 2024, the native of Samana in the Dominican Republic has increased his line drive rate to 22.7 percent from 20.1 percent with Double-A Pensacola in 2023, while dropping his ground ball rate from 41.1 percent to 34.1 percent.

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 11 of Jacksonville's 17 games ( 64.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 9-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games ( 57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going $39-46$ (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over . 500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

## SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 17 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 75 runs ( 4.4 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 30-for-145 (.207/.322/.352/.674, ranking 28th, 28th, 27th and 27th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 109 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

## SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has just three stolen base attempts and two stolen bases in the 11 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are the only professional baseball teams (MLB \& MiLB) to not steal a base since April 11... Jacksonville has won nine of its last 14 games, but they've outscored their opponents by a narrow 69-66 margin during this span... Tristan Gray is tied for second in the IL with six home runs.

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for $\$ 10,000$ as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.
-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first $142 / 3$ innings without allowing an earned run.
-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 152 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a l-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.
-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.
