YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost for the third straight game, falling to the RubberDucks, 6-3. John Michael Bertrand started and threw five scoreless innings. Victor Bericoto opened a 1-0 lead with a solo homer in the first, his first of the season. In the fourth, Grant McCray singled in a run to open a 2-0 lead, his first Double-A hit. Hunter Bishop extended the lead to 3-0 with an RBI single in the seventh. Kahlil Watson broke the shutout with a groundout in the eighth. Dayan Frias hit a solo homer later in the inning to move the RubberDucks ahead, 5-3. Watson singled in a run in the ninth to extend Akron's lead to three. Nick Garcia struck out five over two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series marks the first of two trips to Richmond for Akron. The RubberDucks will return to The Diamond for a six-game series from September 3-8. The Flying Squirrels make two trips to Canal Park this year. They will play a six-game series in Akron from April 30-May 5 and a three-game series from July 19-21 following the All-Star Break. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 11-7 against the RubberDucks, including an 8-4 record in Richmond and a 3-3 record in Akron.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Tuesday night marked the 14th consecutive season the Flying Squirrels have sold out their home opener. Last year, the Flying Squirrels drew 428,541 fans at The Diamond for an average of 6,396 per game, leading all 30 Double-A teams. The average attendance was 14th in Minor League Baseball. The total and average attendances were the highest for Richmond since the 2013 season. 2024 marked the second straight season the Flying Squirrels led Double-A in total and average attendance, a feat that was accomplished for the first time in 2022. This year, the Flying Squirrels are leading all of MiLB in average attendance (8.656).

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556).

THE RUBBERDUCKS went 65-73 last season, which was fifth place in the Southwest Division. They finished in second place in the division in the first-half standings with a 35-34 record before going 30-39 in the second half, which was fifth-best. Akron's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects, including OF Chase DeLauter (No. 1), INF Kahlil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 29). Akron starting pitchers did not allow a run there with the tearly first four garges this covery goars and 32 Japaines (No. 29). through the team's first four games this season, spanning 16.2 innings.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Ragsdale makes his home debut and his second Double-A start. He made his Double-A debut on Saturday at Somerset and allowed two runs over four innings with seven strikeouts. Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. For more on Ragsdale, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Doug Nikhazy makes his second start of the season. He was the Opening Day starter on Friday right against Altoona and threw five hitless, scoreless innings with five strikeouts and two walks. Tonight's outing is his 31st with Akron and his 27th start at Double-A. He first joined the RubberDucks in 2022 for three starts to close the year. Nikhazy spent the entire 2023 season with Akron and went 4-8 with a 4.94 ERA in 26 games (22 starts). In his career, he has made three starts against the Flying Squirrels, going 2-0 with a 3.21 ERA (5 ER/14.0 IP). He last faced the Flying Squirrels on September 7, 2023 at The Diamond and allowed five runs over four innings, including three homers by **Brandon Martorano, Will Wilson** and Carter Aldrete.

HEY, NEW GUY: Christian Koss joined the Giants organization in a trade from the Red Sox on March 27. In his first four games with the Flying Squirrels, he is batting .625 (5-for-8) with a homer, a triple, a double four RBIs, three runs scored and two stolen bases. Koss was originally drafted by the Rockies out of UC Irvine in 2019 before being traded to the Red Sox in December 2020. He has spent parts of two seasons in the Eastern League with Portland and was their team MVP in 2022.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke picked up four hits on Saturday night, going 4-for-5 with a double and two RBIs. He is batting 250 (4-for-15) through the first four games of the season. He joined the Flying Squirrels last May. After hitting .155 (11-for-71) in his first 21 Double-A games from May 31-June 30, he hit .290 (51-for-176) with seven homers, 10 doubles and 28 RBIs over his final 54 regular-season games from July 1-September 17. At Double-A last year, he hit .323 (42-for-130) with seven homers and 28 RBIs in 38 road games compared to .171 (20-for-117) with no homers and two RBIs in 37 home games at The Diamond. Glowenke finished the season ranked fourth among full-season Giants minor leaguers in OBP (.371).

BERICOTO BOMBS: Victor Bericoto hit his first homer of the 2024 season on Wednesday night, a solo shot in the first inning that traveled an estimated 388 feet to left. He has now homered 12 times in his 56 games since joining the Flying Squirrels last July. In 2023, Bericoto led the Giants organization in homers (27) and RBIs (86) while playing the season at age 21. This year, he is batting .318 (7-for-22) with one homer and two RBIs through his first five games.

FAMILIAR FACES: Seventeen players return from last year's Flying Squirrels team, including Brett Auerbach, Victor Bericoto, John Michael Bertrand, Hayden Birdsong, Vaun Brown, Matt Frisbee, Evan Gates, Jimmy Glowenke, Clay Helvey, Wil Jensen, Ryan Murphy, Tyler Myrick, Mat Olsen, Nick Swiney, Andy Thomas, Will Wilson and Logan Wyatt. Of those players, six are beginning their third season with Richmond, including Auerbach, Brown, Gates, Helvey, Jensen and Murphy. Two players, Frisbee and Wilson, are with the Flying Squirrels for a fourth season.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Of the 28 players on the active roster to begin the season, 23 of them were originally signed or drafted When the season, 23 of them were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Fourteen players were selected in the draft, five signed as non-drafted free agents and three were signed as international free agents. Four players, Will Wilson, Christian Koss, Carson Ragsdale and Andy Thomas, were acquired in trades. Tanner Kiest was signed as a minor-league free agent last year from independent baseball and Nick Garcia was selected in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft last December. There are 25 players who were born in the United States, including seven from California, four from North Carolina and three from Florida. Three players were born outside the United States, including Luis Toribio (Dominican Republic), Adrián Sugastey (Panama) and Victor Bericoto (Venezuela).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: Dennis Pelfrey returns for a third season, tying **Dave Machemer** for the longest tenure by a Flying Squirrels manager in franchise history. He is 74 wins shy of matching Machemer's record for the most victories by a Flying Squirrels manager in team history. He is already the first manager in franchise history to lead the club to multiple postseason appearances with the team reaching the playoffs in back-to-back years for the time in 2022 and 2023.

PECT WATCH: Six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25) and Ryan Murphy (No. 28). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Five players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 7), McCray (No. 14), Brown (No. 16), Victor Bericoto (No. 21) and Sugastey (No. 25).

Dennis Pelfrey on the 2024 Richmond roster:

And a couple infielders like Christian Koss, who we just got from the Red Sox, and Will Wilson, who has been here, a fantastic shortstop. Damon Dues and Jimmy Glownke can play short. Really every infielder is a shortstop with the exception of Logan Wyatt and Luis Toribio. Having those skill sets, being able to play all over the field, where I talk about the dynamic players we have, we can do a lot of different things. Any given night if our offense isn't doing well, our defense is going to step up. Pitching is going to step up. Baserunning is going to win games for us. If our pitching isn't doing great, our offense is going to step up. We're going to have a great chance to win every single night. That's a nice feeling to have.
