YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a three-game losing streak, topping the Curve, 5-3. Altoona struck first with a solo homer by Mason Martin. Sandro Fabian tied the score with an RBI single in the second and Bryan Torres gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead with an RBI single. In the fourth, Fabian hit a two-run homer, his third of the season, to extend the lead to 4-1. Shane Matheny opened the lead to 5-1 with a sac fly in the seventh. In the eighth, Josh Bissonette hit an RBI single in the eighth for the Curve and Canaan Smith-Njigba closed the gap to two with an RBI single in the ninth, but Jose Marte picked up a pair of strikeouts to strand the bases loaded and end the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, at The Diamond. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Curve. The Flying Squirrels play six games at Altoona's Peoples Natural Gas Field from August 24-29.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS ended a three-game losing streak with yesterday's win. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 6.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked seventh in the league with a .238 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked second in the league with a 3.34 ERA for the season so far.

THE CURVE have won six of the last nine games. They are currently in fourth place in the Double-A Northeast, 4.5 games behind first-place Bowie. The Altoona offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .235 batting average. The Curve pitching staff is ranked sixth in the league with a 3.71 ERA. Altoona's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects, including Oneil Cruz (4), Ji-hwan Bae (14), Mason Martin (15), Cal Mitchell (18), Roansy Contreras (20) and Canaan Smith-Njigba

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Phil Pfeifer makes his first start for the Flying Squirrels and his first start of 2021. He began the year with Triple-A Sacramento, going 0-3 with an 11.25 ERA in five relief appearances. He signed with the Giants as a minor league free agent in March. Pfeifer was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the third round in 2015 out of Vanderbilt before being traded to the Atlanta Braves in 2016.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Osvaldo Bido makes his fifth start of the season. Last time out, he worked 4.0 innings and allowed one run in a no-decision against Erie last Saturday. In his last three starts since May 15, Bido has a 1.29 ERA. He split the 2019 season between Low-A Greensboro and High-A Bradenton, going 12-8 with a 3.32 ERA in 25 starts. Bido signed with the Pirates as a free agent on May 14, 2017.

ADDING IT UP: Over his last 11 games since May 23, **Shane Matheny** has hit .273 (9-for-33) with four doubles, a homer and seven RBIs. On Saturday at Reading, Matheny went on a 16-game on-base streak from May 15-June 3, during which he hit .255 (12-for-47) with 13 walks. For the season, Matheny is ranked tied for seventh in the league with 17 walks.

RAMOS RAKING: On Wednesday, **Heliot Ramos** went hitless and his 12-game on-base streak ended. However, over his last 15 games since May 18, he is batting .322 (19-for-59) with one homer, three doubles and seven RBIs. For the season, Ramos is currently ranked ninth in the league in batting average (.297) and tied for third in hits (30).

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank second in the Double-A Northeast with a 3.34 ERA, which is third in Double-A overall. The pitching staff also ranks second in the league in WHIP (1.19) and opponents' batting average (.211).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the fourth-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 2.74 on the season, which is second-best in Double-A. The bullpen is second in Double-A with 11 saves. Richmond relievers have allowed the second-fewest runs (40), second-fewest hits (70) and have the best BAA (.177) in Double-A. **Patrick Ruotolo** is third in the Double-A Northeast with four saves and **Norwith Gudino** is tied for fourth with three.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 16-12 record is tied for the second-best start in team history through 28 games, matching the starts of the season in 2014 and 2018. It trails only a 17-11 start in the 2010 season. The team's best start through 29 games is a 18-11 record in 2010. The Flying Squirrels went 17-12 in 2014.

GETTING ON THE BOARD: Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 37 consecutive games. That streak includes all 28 games of the 2021 season. The only team in the Double-A Northeast with a longer streak is Portland, which has scored at least one run in 40 straight games. Richmond and Portland are the only two teams in the Double-A Northeast that have not been shut out this year.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12), Sean Hjelle (13) and Jose Marte (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and Caleb Kilian (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

GOING FOR GOLD: Flying Squirrels manager José Alguacil is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela is playing in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. Venezuela picked up a 6-5 win over Cuba on Monday and beat Colombia, 3-2, on Tuesday. They improved to 3-0 with a 5-0 win against Canada on Wednesday. The top two teams from each group are playing in a super round this weekend, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. Venezuela lost its first game of the super round, 14-4, to the Dominican Republic. They are scheduled to play Team USA today. Tony Diggs managed the team for its six-game series in Reading from May 25-30, going 5-1. Jason Wood is managing the Flying Squirrels during this week's series. He spent the last 10 seasons as a manager in the Texas Rangers organization. He was with High-A Myrtle Beach from 2011-2013, Double-A Frisco in 2014, Triple-A Round Rock from 2015-2018 and Triple-A Nashville in 2019. Wood is currently the Giants' Coordinator of Infield Instruction. Catcher Andres Angulo was also away from the team while down to Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier. Colombia was eliminated in the opening round.

MOVIN' UP: Right-handed pitcher Matt Frisbee was been promoted to Triple-A Sacramento this week, one day after being named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Month for May. During his time with the Flying Squirrels, Frisbee went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA. For the month of May, he led all of MiLB in WHIP (0.41), ranked second in BAA (.112) and second in innings pitched (29.0). He also ranked fourth in Double-A in ERA (1.24), tied for first in wins (4) and led the level in innings pitched, BAA and WHIP. In the Double-A Northeast, Frisbee led the circuit in ERA, wins, inning pitched, BAA and WHIP. He also ranked seventh in strike-outs (32) and ninth in winning percentage (.800). The Asheville, N.C. native opened the season with 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings across his first two starts. On May 13, Frisbee combined with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo to hold the Harrisburg Senators hitless, the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels history. On Sunday at Reading, Frisbee cout the month setting a season high in innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8). After allowing a single in the first inning, Frisbee retired the next 21 batters in order to earn his fourth win.
