YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 6-4. Akron took a 2-0 lead with an RBI double by Bryan Lavastida in the first and a sac fly by Jose Tena in the third. In the bottom of the third, **Vaun Brown** hit a three-run homer, his first at Double-A, to give Richmond a 3-2 lead. The RubberDucks took a 4-3 lead with solo homers in the fourth by Johnathan Rodriguez and Gabriel Rodriguez. **Riley Mahan** tied the game with a sac fly in the fourth. In the seventh, **Wade Meckler** moved Richmond into the lead with an RBI single and **Marco Luciano** added a bases-loaded walk to extend the lead to 6-4. **Matt Frisbee** pitched 2.2 scoreless innings and **Blake Rivera** covered two innings without allowing a run. **Evan Gates** picked up his fourth save with a scoreless ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the first set between these two teams this year. They will play 18 total games against each other this season. Richmond will travel to Akron for a six-game series from July 18-23. The RubberDucks return to The Diamond for the Flying Squirrels' final regular-season homestand from September 5-10. The Flying Squirrels have not lost a series at home this season, but they have dropped three-of-five in this week's series.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are tied for second place in the Southwest Division, even with Akron and a half-game behind Erie. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 11-of-their-last 16 falling to .500 for the first time this season before picking up a win on Saturday night. The Richmond pitching staff is second in the Eastern League in ERA (3.62). The Flying Squirrels have a 2.89 bullpen ERA this year, which is the best in the minors.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won eight-of-their-last-12 games, including taking four-of-six in last week's series in Altoona and three-of-five so far this week. Akron's pitching staff is ranked fifth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.85) and tied for first in saves (13). The RubberDucks have the third-lowest team batting average (.223) in the EL. Akron's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including SS Angel Martinez (No. 8), INF Jose Tena (No. 14), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 18), INF Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 21), OF Petey Halpin (No. 25), LHP Doug Ninkhazy (No. 27), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 29) and C Bryan Lavastida (No. 30). There are seven Akron players on MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects list, including Martinez (No. 9), Halpin (No. 15), Cantillo (No. 17), Burns (No. 20), Tena (No. 21), Ninkhazy (No. 28) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Mason Black** makes eighth Double-A start and second against Akron. He started the series opener on Tuesday and allowed two runs over 3.2 innings with six strikeouts. In his previous outing on May 10 at Erie, he threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit with six strikeouts. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Tanner Burns makes his seventh start of the season and his second against Richmond. He took the mound to open the series on Tuesday and tied a season high with five innings pitched, allowing one run in his second straight win. The Alabama native was selected with the 36th pick in the 2020 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Auburn. Burns spent the entire 2022 season with Akron, going 3-7 with a 3.55 ERA in 21 starts. He made three starts against the Flying Squirrels last year, going 1-1 with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/111 IP). He last faced the Flying Squirrels on August 24 at Canal Park and threw 5.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Burns is rated by MLB.com as the No. 20 Guardians prospect and No. 29 by Baseball America.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels' sold out crowd of 9,810 fans on Wednesday was the largest crowd in the Eastern League this year. It was the first sellout of the 2023 season (Opening Day was sold out but rained out). For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead all 30 Double-A teams in average attendance (6,558) and total attendance (124,598). Last year, they led Double-A in average (6,160) and total (406,560) fans for the first time in franchise history. On Saturday night, the Flying Squirrels surpassed five million fans in the franchise's history.

SEARCHING FOR HITS: The Flying Squirrels opened the season 14-7 through May 2 but have gone 5-11 over their last 16 games since May 3. Through the first 21 games of the year, the Flying Squirrels led the league in batting average (.253), runs (118), RBIs (104), OBP (.349) and OPS (.743) while ranking second in hits (171) and SLG (.394). Since then, the Richmond offense is last in batting average (.220) and second-to-last in runs (61), total bases (182), RBIs (56), SLG (.360) and OPS (.673). The Flying Squirrels averaged 5.6 runs per game through the first 21 games but are averaging 3.6 runs per game over their last 15.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On May 4, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. Luciano added a homer in Sunday's win over the SeaWolves and hit his third home run on Wednesday, tying a career high with four RBIs. He has reached base in 10-of-his-13 games started this season.

VOUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night and added his first Double-A homer on Saturday night, a three-run shot to center.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated **Wade Meckler** on Wednesday and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Among batters with at least 80 plate appearances this year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.439). Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 regular-season games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Luis Matos** is ranked seventh in batting average (.304) and eighth in OBP (.398). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for eighth in batting average (.300) and tied for seventh in hits (39). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (3). **Riley Mahan** is tied for fifth in RBIs (22). **Hayden Cantrelle** is sixth in OBP (.408). **Carson Seymour** is 10th in ERA (3.34). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (42). **Evan Gates** is tied for sixth in saves (4).

WHERE THE RUBBERDUCKS RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Aaron Bracho is tied for seventh in homers (7). Julian Escobedo is tied for fifth in doubles (9). Cade Smith is first in saves (11) and tied for second in games pitched (13). Trey Benton is tied for third in games pitched (13).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: With his MLB debut on Friday night for the San Francisco Giants, catcher **Patrick Bailey** became the 87th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. Bailey began this season with the Flying Squirrels, playing 14 games. During his time in Richmond, Bailey hit .333 with two homers, two doubles and 10 RBIs. On April 18, Bailey recorded the 10th five-hit game in Flying Squirrels history. He made his first MLB start on Saturday and picked up his first hit.
