Used Our Bug Spray... The Bowling Green Hot Rods clinched their 15th series win of the season, taking down the Greensboro Grasshoppers at First National Bank Field in North Carolina. The Hot Rods plated a season-high 15 runs on Friday night in a 10-run victory.

Hujsak Makes History... Outfielder Connor Hujsak struck his 25th homer of the season on Sunday, setting the most single-season home runs in Bowling Green franchise history. Hujsak surpassed 2022 Hot Rods player Heriberto Hernandez with a solo shot in the top of the seventh inning.

Power Play... Bowling Green blasted 15 home runs in their last series against Greensboro. The Hot Rods are up to 54 home runs during the South Atlantic League's second half, third-most in the league.

Setting the (Ay)bar High... Infielder Nicandro Aybar went 2-for-2 with two RBI as a pinch-hitter in Sunday's win. The 21-year-old starred in his debut series with the Hot Rods, going 11-for-19 (.579 AVG) with five RBI and six runs scored against the Grasshoppers.

Double Trouble... First baseman Ryan McCoy's 22 doubles is tied for the most by any SAL hitter this season, level with Greenville Drive infielder Yoelín Cespedes. McCoy leads active SAL qualified bats with a .435 OBP and a 1.010 OPS.

Battling the 'Burgers... The Hot Rods begin a six-game series against the Hub City Spartanburgers on Tuesday. Bowling Green took five out of six games against Hub City at Fifth Third Ballpark in Spartanburg, South Carolina during July. The Hot Rods were defeated by the Spartanburgers in the 2025 South Atlantic League Division Series.

Dominant Dominic... Left-hander Dominic Niman starts Tuesday night's series opener. The southpaw holds a 4-1 record at Bowling Green Ballpark. Niman posted a career-high 7.0 innings pitched in his last home start on July 23rd against the Asheville Tourists.
