NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, won 3 straight series and then lost back-to-back series, but are trending up, coming off a series split in Indianapolis.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games to open a stretch from April 22 to May 8 where the team went 3-11 ... however, the Chasers have won 4 of their last 6.

Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Storm Chasers are 4-7 in one-run games and have especially struggled in close games with Toledo this season.

Walk-off games represent many of the 1-run games this season ... Omaha's 3 walk-off wins this season represent 3 of the team's 4 one-run victories this season ... the 3 walk-off losses the Storm Chasers suffer represent 3 of the 7 one-run losses this season.

The Chasers have gone 3-7 against the Mud Hens this season and would need to win 7 of the final 8 meetings between the two teams to win the season series ... of the 10 games played between Omaha and Toledo this season, 6 have been decided by 2 runs or less, including 4 of 7 losses.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

Omaha's 82.5% success rate (47-for-57) ranks 5th in the International League and 10th at the Triple-A level.

John Rave leads Omaha in steals (11) ... Gavin Cross and Tyler Tolbert both have 8 steals in as many tries, while Kameron Misner has 7 stolen bases ... Cross and Tolbert are 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.988 pitches per plate appearance, 6th-most in the International League and 9th at the Triple-A level.

Among 105 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, Kameron Misner is 8th in pitches seen/PA (4.391) while John Rave ranks 9th (4.357).

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

Omaha is tied for the 8th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .980 mark (1st: Louisville & Rochester, .987), committing just 29 errors in 42 games.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - 5 of the Storm Chasers' 16 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, while another 6 of those 16 have committed just 1 error on the season.

Omaha's 38 double plays turned are tied for the 8th-most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by Abraham Toro's 24, tied for the 9th-most of any Minor League player ... after turning 34 double plays in the first 30 games between March and April, Omaha has turned 4 double plays in 13 March games.

GENTRY GIANT

This week, former Storm Chasers outfielder Tyler Gentry returns to Werner Park for his first games as a visitor, after playing the last 3 seasons with Omaha.

Released by the Royals in March, Gentry signed with the Tigers on April 11 ... his 336 games with Omaha between 2023 and 2025 rank 5th-most in the club's Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... since 2011, he ranks 3rd for Omaha in walks (162), 6th in homers (41), 7th in doubles (69), 7th in RBI (164) and 8th in total bases (490).

PITCH, PLEASE

Of recent, Omaha's pitching staff has seen success, including last week in Indianapolis and specifically from the starting rotation.

Omaha's pitching staff held Indians hitters to a .150 average (24-for-160), the best by a Storm Chasers pitching staff since 2021 ... last week's 1.98 ERA (10 ER in 47.1 IP) and 0.96 WHIP (17 BB + 26 H) were the 2nd-best.

Across the Storm Chasers' first 34 games of the 2026 season, the starting pitchers did not throw a quality start, only finishing 5.0 innings 5 times ... the Chasers have gotten 3 quality starts in the last 8 games, the most of any Triple-A team in that stretch ... however, none of the 3 quality starts have been games won by Omaha.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Aaron Sanchez is making his **9th start** with the Storm Chasers this year, also his **9th overall appearance** of the season ... is one of 13 players (6 pitchers) that has been active with Omaha all year.
- ✓ Playing his **17th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 7th MLB organization ... has played parts of 8 Major League seasons with Toronto (2014-19), Houston (2019), San Francisco (2021), Washington (2022) and Minnesota (2022) ... has played parts of 7 years in Triple-A, Omaha is his 6th Triple-A team.
- ✓ Sanchez has faced Toledo 6 times in his career, including in April of this year ... he also saw the Mud Hens in 2014 with Buffalo, in 2022 with Rochester and St. Paul and twice in 2023 with St. Paul ... his 42.1 career innings in the Majors against Detroit are the 5th-most of the 26 MLB teams he has pitched against.

THE SANCH FACTOR

- ✓ **AARON'S AWARD:** Sanchez is the reigning International League Pitcher of the Week ... in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader in Indianapolis, he fired 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing 1 hit and striking out 8 ... he earned the honor despite Indians starter José Uruquidy throwing 5.0 no-hit innings with 7 strikeouts ... it was his second time earning a weekly pitching award in the Minor Leagues, also winning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors with the Lansing Lugnuts for the week of July 2, 2012.
- ✓ **FINDING HIS FOOTING:** Pitched to a 9.68 ERA (19 ER in 17.2 IP) with 15 walks to 14 strikeouts over his first 5 starts (March 29 to April 22) ... in his last 3 starts (since April 28), has a 3.86 ERA (6 ER in 14.0 IP) with 4 walks to 15 strikeouts (3.75 K/BB).
- ✓ **BATTERY POWERED:** Luke Maile caught 17 of Sanchez's starts with the Toronto Blue Jays between 2017 and 2019, and the two are reunited in Omaha after more than 6 years apart ... across their careers, Maile has caught Sanchez for 92.0 innings (including 9.0 innings and 2 starts in Omaha this year), 2nd-most among any catcher behind only Russell Martin (339.0 innings).
- ✓ **ROAD BACK TO THE SHOW:** Sanchez last appeared in the Major Leagues 1,320 days ago on October 4, 2022 with the Minnesota Twins, as he worked 1.2 innings of relief ... he has since pitched 44 games (42 starts) in the Minor Leagues, but has not pitched in the Majors the last 3 years.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, MAY 9 @ INDIANAPOLIS

- ✓ Made his first quality start of the season, just his 2nd time throwing 5.0+ innings in 2026 ... carried a no-hitter into the 6th, allowing only a walk and hit batter over his first 5.0 frames, with 1-2-3 innings in the 1st, 4th and 5th ... retired 9 consecutive batters between the 3rd and 6th ... in the 6th, gave up a 1-out triple to Tyler Callihan – the first hit of the game for either team – then struck out the next batter before throwing out Callihan attempting to steal home to end the inning and his start.

- ✓ Appeared in 5 Cactus League games (1 start) with the Royals ... pitched to a 4.50 ERA (5 ER in 10.0 IP) with 7 strikeouts ... worked 2.0 innings or more or 4 of 5 spring appearances.

- ✓ His most recent action came for the Toros del Este in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM) during the 2025/26 season ... after more than a full calendar year away from baseball, he returned to the mound with 8 starts and was named the LIDOM Pitcher of the Year ... between October 19 and November 30, 2025, he went 4-2 with a 1.55 ERA (8 ER in 46.1 IP) with 34 strikeouts to just 9 walks (3.8 K/BB).
- ✓ The last time Sanchez pitched in affiliated ball was in 2024, when he spent the year in the Blue Jays organization after signing as a free agent on May 6 ... he made 14 starts and posted a 7.92 ERA (54 ER in 61.1 IP) for the Buffalo Bisons (AAA), released on August 4 of that year.

MAJOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Most recently pitched at the Major League level in 2022, splitting the season between the Twins and Nationals ... opened the season in the Nationals organization and pitched to an 8.33 ERA (29 ER in 31.1 IP) in 7 starts before his release ... posted a 4.71 ERA (15 ER in 28.2 IP) across 8 appearances (3 starts) with the Nationals ... split the second half of the year between Triple-A and the Majors with the Twins organization.
- ✓ Pitched 9 games (7 starts) in the MLB in 2021 for the Giants and worked a 3.06 ERA (12 ER in 35.1 IP).
- ✓ Made 20 MLB appearances for the 5th time in his career in 2019, most coming with the Blue Jays before his trade to the Astros ... combined for a 5.89 ERA (86 ER in 131.1 IP) in 27 combined starts.
- ✓ Battled injuries between 2017 and 2018, limiting him to 28 starts for the Blue Jays between the two years ... managed a 4.72 ERA (74 ER in 141.0 IP).
- ✓ Named an American League All-Star in 2016 and finished 7th in AL Cy Young voting ... had an AL-leading 3.00 ERA (64 ER in 192.0 IP) and 15-2 record with 161 strikeouts to 63 walks (2.56 K/BB) across 30 starts for the Blue Jays ... also named the Blue Jays Pitcher of the Year and Most Improved Player.
- ✓ Made his MLB debut out of the bullpen July 23, 2014 ... pitched in 65 MLB games (11 starts) between 2014 and 2015 and worked a 2.66 ERA (37 ER in 125.1 IP) with a 1.13 WHIP.

- ✓ Pitched parts of 4 seasons in the Minor Leagues before his Major League call-up in July 2014 ... made 14 starts at Double-A and appeared in 8 games (6 starts) at Triple-A in 2014 after spending all of 2013 at High-A.
