LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox fell to the Akron RubberDucks by a 9-2 final on Wednesday afternoon. Austin Hays homered again for a second consecutive game in his rehab assignment but Bowie collected just one run on four hits against Akron starting right-hander Aaron Davenport, who threw six innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts. Akron scored six of its nine runs in the first three innings as five RubberDucks recorded two or more hits on the afternoon and Aaron Bracho drove in a game-high three RBI to even up the series.

REVIEWING THE RUBBERDUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best record in the Eastern League at 18-9. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians has won 12 of their last 13, including at one point winning 10 in a row. A league-low 2.38 ERA has helped the RubberDucks win their last two series against Altoona and Richmond. Four of the Guardians' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- IF Kahilil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and IF Dayan Fries (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Ryan Webb makes his sixth start of the season tonight. In his most recent start on May 3 vs Richmond, Webb threw a season-high six innings but gave up four runs on nine hits with two walks and four strikeouts, receiving the loss. The southpaw finished the month of April with a 2.45 ERA in 18.1 innings pitched. This is Webb's first season in Akron after spending much of last year in High-A Lake County. He made 17 starts and pitched a career-high 82 innings with 83 strikeouts over 34 walks. Webb was drafted in the fourth round of the 2021 Draft by the Guardians out of Georgia.

HAYS IS HERE

Orioles outfielder **Austin Hays** has homered in both games of his rehab assignment after going deep in the eighth inning yesterday. The 2023 AL All Star is 4-for-7 at the dish with two homers, a double and three RBI in his rehab assignment. The 28-year-old has been on the injured list since April 22 after suffering a left calf strain. Hays slashed .275/.325/.444 with 36 doubles, two triples, 16 home runs, 76 runs scored and 67 RBI last season, was named to his first career All Star Game and started in center field. The former Baysox outfielder and No. 1 Orioles prospect played in Bowie from 2017-2019.

ON-BASE BOWENS

After going 0-for-4 yesterday, 1B **TT Bowens** had his nine-game hit and on-base streak come to an end. During the hit streak, Bowens batted .387 (12-for-31) with a .474 OBP and a 1.055 OPS. The nine-game hit streak is the longest by a Baysox player so far this season. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is sixth in the Eastern League in batting average (.329), is tied for second in RBI (22), is fifth in slugging percentage (.570) and sixth in OPS (.970).

SERVIN' IT UP

IF **Anthony Servideo** is on a six-game hit streak and has served as a stable bottom of the order presence for the Baysox. Over the last six games, he is batting .474 (9-for-19) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBI. The 25-year-old has collected an RBI in his last four consecutive games. His longest hit streak last year was seven consecutive games from June 23 - July 1. Servideo has bumped his batting average up from .194 on April 30 to now .253.

TIME FOR TRACE

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his sixth start of the season and the ninth of his Double-A career. The 23-year-old most recently pitched last Thursday against Erie and threw 4.2 innings, allowed four runs on five hits (including two homers), walked two and struck out six to receive the loss. Bright has punched out six or more batters in four of his five starts but has also given up the fifth-most hits in the Eastern League (28). This will be Bright's second career outing against Akron. He made his second Double-A start on September 1, 2023 at Canal Park and pitched five innings of two-run ball with a season-high six strikeouts in a no decision.

HOME SWEET HOME

Tuesday was Bowie's 11th win at home this season, the most by any team in the Eastern League so far. The Baysox are one of just four teams across all of Double-A to have won at least 11 games at home and have won seven of their last 10 here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (109), first in home runs (25), and first in OPS (.842). Bowie clinched its third consecutive home series win after taking three of five against Erie.

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. **Struck out six batters on 5/2 vs ERI but gave up five hits and four runs, including back-to-back home runs in 2nd inning, in 4.2 innings to take the loss. Previously had gone five innings in three straight starts....Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts.**

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26 at Erie. Struck out five over four scoreless innings on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
