## "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS SPLIT THURSDAY TWIN BILL WITH TIDES: Matt Wallner touched off for two home runs in his first game of major league rehab, an 8-3 loss for the Saints to Norfolk, before St. Paul bounced back for a 3-2 win, frontlined by a dominant outing from Simeon Woods Richardson in the nightcap. In game one, Orioles top prospect Samuel Basallo crushed two of the Tides' four home runs in the first-ever meeting between St. Paul and Norfolk. The 20-year-old's two-run shot in the fourth was the second-longest home run at CHS Field this year, carrying 438 feet over the right field porch. The Tides had a 5-0 lead before Wallner got the Saints on the board with an oppo shot in the third. His second of the game came in the seventh, a two-run fly that carried 409 feet, tied for the fifth-longest round-tripper by a Saint this year. In game two, Woods Richardson took the ball in his first game with St. Paul since being optioned and was dialed in from the jump. He struck out five of the first seven he faced and K'd eight across 6.0 innings of one-run ball. Emmanuel Rodriguez's fourth homer of the year gave the Saints a 1-0 lead in the 2nd and they took it back when Will Holland doubled to lead off the fifth, eventually scoring on a wild pitch.

BACK, TRACK, WALLNER: In his first game of major league rehab with the Saints on Thursday, Forest Lake native Matt Wallner clubbed two home runs with the Saints, running his career total to 38 in a St. Paul uniform, the third-most in franchise history (see below). Yesterday's two-homer game was Wallner's fourth in 185 games of his Saints career. In the past five seasons of Triple-A affiliation, only Michael Helman (2022-24) has more games with multiple homers, accumulating five in 195 games in his St. Paul tenure.

PITCHING PARTICULARS: Despite a pair of strong performances Sunday in Iowa and Thursday vs Norfolk, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 48 runs across their last 54.1 innings of baseball going back to the start of their last series in Iowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.30 ERA (101 ER, 144.1 IP), the 5th-worst mark in Minor League Baseball and 2nd-worst in the International League, only ahead of the Rochester Red Wings (6.54) since the turn of the calendar page. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .862 as an offense is the third-highest in MiLB in May.

CHICKS DIG THE LONGBALL: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 46 round-trippers in their last 32 games since April 14, which ranks third in the minors in that stretch, trailing only the Greensboro Grasshoppers (52). & Charlotte Knights (49). St. Paul had left the yard at least once in eight straight games, a season-long streak for the club, until going homerless on Tuesday and Wednesday last week in lowa. They have left the yard at least once in 14 of their past 17 games.

HEY MICKEY, YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .351 (20-57) with four doubles, 5 HR, and 12 RBI in 14 games. His OPS of 1.123 in that stretch ranks 6th in the International League (min 40 AB) while his nine extra-base hits ranks 3rd, trailing only Lehigh Valley's Buddy Kennedy & Iowa's Carlos Perez (10 each). The New Hampshire native now has seven homers in 18 games in a Saints uniform this year, more than halfway to his career-high 12 set last season in the Boston organization. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure) & 3rd in OPS in MiLB:

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (27-22) were off yesterday after they saw their 10-game home winning streak, the longest in Target Field's history, snapped on Wednesday against Cleveland. Minnesota welcomes in division rivals Kansas City (28-23) and throw Pablo Lopez (4-2, 2.40) tonight at Target Field. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (23-19) have lost 2-of-3 in San Antonio (SDP) this week after falling 2-1 yesterday. INF Tanner Schobel extended his hit streak to 11 straight games after going 1-4 yesterday. High-A Cedar Rapids (24-16) won 3-1 at Fort Wayne (SDP) yesterday. Twins No. 4 prospect Kaelen Culpepper has hit safely in 12 straight & ranks top-10 in the MWL in hitting (.307) & OPS (.902) for the Kernels. LAST APPEARANCE: Started 17 days ago in the series opener vs the Bisons. Lobbied to stay in the ball game, but came one batter shy of turning in his second straight quality start since being optioned to St. Paul. Retired 15 of the last 17 hitters he faced to the end night (and 17/20 overall). His lone extra-base hit allowed, a one-out double to Jonatan Clase, was charged earned to him when Travis Adams came in and gave up a two-out RBI hit to Joey Loperfido. Threw 28 sliders (32%), 23 sinkers (32%), 16 changeups (2%), and five four-seamers (7%). Generated 16 swings-and-misses after inducing 18 in the start prior, led by seven on the slider and six on the changeup. Struck out four on the slider & three on the changeup.

LATE-BLOOMER: A late-adopter to pitching. Festa did not start toeing the slab until his senior year of high school at Seton Hall Prep. He was initially committed as a shortstop to a Division 3 school entering his final prep season, but when his high school ran out of pitchers during a tournament, Festa was handed the ball for the first time and never looked back. He continued to play shortstop for the rest of the year, but also went 4-0 with a 1.50 ERA while striking out 44 over 30 innings on the mound. He chose to walk-on to nearby Seton Hall University as a pitcher instead, getting a good recommendation from his high school head coach Mike Sheppard Jr, who's brother was the head coach of the nearby Big East program. Festa was mostly a fastball-changeup pitcher in college, mixing in an occasional slurve, and credits the Twins development program for helping him develop a slider, which as become his bread-and-butter out pitch, accounting for 65 of his 166 (39%) strikeouts between the Majors and Triple-A last year.

A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES: In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

**ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!:** On July 24, 2022 with Single-A Cedar Rapids, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other

THE SLIM REAPER IDOLIZING THE deGROMINATOR: While he's worn the No. 58 jersey for both the Twins and Saints so far in his career, Festa came up through baseball wearing number 48, a tribute to his favorite player growing up, Jacob DeGrom. The two-time Cy Young award winner had his most dominant seasons in 2018-19, the summers before Festa's first two years of college ball at Seton Hall University, located about 35 miles West of Citi Field in Flushing.

你好: While attending Seton Hall Prep in New Jersey, Festa was a member of the National Chinese Honor Society... The National Chinese Honor Society (NCHS) was established in 1993 to recognize those accomplished high school students who study Chinese as a world language. The National Chinese Honor Society is a scholastic organization that promotes and recognizes students who demonstrate citizenship, leadership, and community service. A member must be a full time high school student (grades 9-12) who has studied Chinese for four semesters in high school with an average of B or higher.

**BIGGER, FASTER, STRONGER:** Festa's goal in the offseason leading up to 2024 was to add some muscle, so he can be prepared to go an entire season. He said it's sort of tough for him to do certain exercises given his height and narrowness. Last season he was listed at 185 pounds and came into Spring Training in 2024 10 pounds heavier at 195.

NOT ALL HEROES WEAR CAPES: Travis helped save the life of a stranger from a burning house in Fort Myers in March of 2024 during Spring Training. He heard a loud bang from the house across the street from where he was staying. He and another man ran out, and saw that the hosue was on fire. They started to bang on the door to see if anyone was inside. Three other people came out who knew the man inside and started yelling, "Howard, your house is on fire, get out!" Gaining entrance to the house was difficult because of so many objects around the outside of the house, but Travis went around the side of the house, tearing up a part of the fence down to get back to the area where another door was. He ended up opening the door, and safely escorting the man out of the burning building.

SIGHT-SEERS: Adams traveled through Kyoto, Osaka and the outskirts of Japan with fellow Twins minor leaguer Jaylen Nowlin following the 2024 season. It was a leisure trip, but the duo took time away from their vacation to travel two hours from Shibuya (on the outskirts of Tokyo) to meet their old coach in the Twins organization, Takashi Miyoshi (now a Minor League instructor with the Reds) at his youth clinic. Adams and Nowlin spoke to a group of 8-16 year olds about their journey through American baseball and the mental side of the game.

HORNET PRIDE: Adams played his college baseball at Cal-State Sacramento in the Western Athletic Conference. He was a three-year starter for the Hornets, regularly pitching as their Saturday night guy as a junior and forming a dynamic 1-2 punch atop the rotation with Scott Randall, who went nine picks after Adams in that summer's June 2021 Amateur Draft to the Pirates (the two have yet to face each other in a professional game entering the season). While at Cal-State Sacramento, Adams was known for his pinpoint control, issuing just 25 walks in 151.0 career innings, the lowest BB/9 rate in program history (min. 100 IP). The program has produced nine Major Leaguers entering the 2025 season, headlined by Rhys Hoskins and James Outman.
