LAST TIME OUT

Worcester, MA (Aug. 19) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell 14-12 to the Worcester WooSox in an eventful Saturday contest. The Yankees top prospects combined for eleven hits, including five home runs in the loss.

Everson Pereira smoked a 476-foot solo homer in the first inning for an early lead. The WooSox battled back in the second inning. Bobby Dalbec walked to reach and trotted home on Yu Chang's home run. Worcester added to their lead in the next frame. Back-to-back singles from Ceddone Rafaela and Enmanuel Valdez put two on. Wilyer Abreu drew a walk to load the bases. Dalbec followed with his second free pass of the game to drive in a run. Then Ronaldo Hernandez launched a grand slam for a 7-1 advantage.

The RailRiders began to chip away with a run in the fourth. Andres Chaparro led off with a solo homer driving the ball 441-feet. In the fifth, the visitors added four more runs to their total. After Oswald Peraza was hit by a pitch, Austin Wells hit his second home run of the series. Pereira worked a walk and scored on a wild pitch, while Franchy Cordero reached on a fielder's choice and scored on an error. The RailRiders trailed just 7-6. The WooSox got one right back in the bottom half. Abreu walked, moved over on a balk and stolen base, and scored on a passed ball. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was right there again in the sixth. Peraza hit by pitch to begin the frame and crossed the plate on an RBI double from Wells, trailing just 8-7. Worcester put on two more without a hit in the seventh. An error allowed Abreu to score and Chang trotted home on an wild pitch to increase the lead 10-7. Pereira's bat was hot again, hitting his second home run of the game in the eighth. This time it traveled 436-feet to make it 10-8. In the eighth inning, the Red Sox added some insurance. A wild pitch plated one and Abreu's three-run long ball made it 14-8. The RailRiders did not go down quietly in the ninth inning. Cordero led off with a walk and Jamie Westbrook doubled to put them both in scoring position. Jake Lamb laced a base hit up the middle to drive them both in. Then, Peraza stepped to the plate and crushed the team's fifth home run of the day. It traveled 445-feet to bring the RailRiders within two. SWB fell 14-12.

Edgar Barclay (L, 0-2) got the start giving up seven runs in three innings of work. Michael Gomez, Ron Marinaccio, and Matt Bowman all pitched out of the bullpen. Wilmer Difo took the mound to finish the game for the third time this season. The WooSox utilized five pitchers in the contest with Ryan Fernandez being awarded the win.

NEWS & NOTES

CHAPPY HAPPY - Andres Chaparro smoked his 23rd home run of the season last night with a solid line drive to left field. It was his third consecutive night with a long ball. He has now hit fifteen at PNC Field and eight total on the road. This sets a career-high for him over last season when he had nineteen with Somerset and one with Tampa. The righty also has recorded 19 doubles which is two away from his career high from 2021.

THERE'S A WILL -Starter Will Warren will get the nod for the second time this series to face off against southpaw Shane Drohan. In Tuesday's contest, he pitched five innings of work on 91 offerings. The righty let up two earned runs. Warren struck out eight to tie his season-high for the sixth time

SWIPING STEALS-The RailRiders have kept pace with the WooSox this week in terms of extra bases taken. SWB has nine compared to Worcester's ten. This ups the RailRiders total bases taken on the season to 128 with Estevan Florial leading the way at 19. Last summer, SWB set a new franchise record with 172 taken.

AUGUST SLIPPED AWAY -The International League is in the final third of its season with just 33 games left to be played for the RailRiders. They have had one cancelled contest due to smoky conditions. They are set to make up two games as a part of doubleheaders in the coming months. With 116 games down, SWB has played over 1000 innings of baseball this summer.

HITTING HOMERS- The RailRiders are now second in the International League in home runs with 187 to Worcester who has 190. The Atlanta Braves lead all of baseball with 234 smashed. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial and Andres Chaparro lead the team with twenty-three, while seven total players are in double digits.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - The RailRiders three August birthdays on the calendar. Josh Maciejewski turned 28 years old on August 14th. On the very next day, reliever Michael Gomez celebrates his 27th birthday. His teammate Zach Greene will as well on August 25th.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb being the latest. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner, Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospects, catcher, Austin Wells (#8 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) and outfielder Everson Periera (#3) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#10), Randy Vasquez (#14), Clayton Beeter (#16), and Edgar Barclay (#28) are all essential parts of the starting rotation for the majority of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's season.
