SUNDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats came back from a three-run deficit to win 8-7 over the Somerset Patriots on Sunday at TD Bank Ballpark. The series concludes in a split for the Fisher Cats against the Patriots, the 2023 Northeast Division first-half champions. Trailing 3-0 entering the fifth, New Hampshire scored four to take the lead with **PK Morris** breaking an 0-for-12 skid at the plate with a two-run double to right field. Somerset would grab the lead back 7-5 with four runs in the sixth and a two-run triple from shortstop Trey Sweeney, who was a homer shy of the cycle. In the seventh, **Damiano Palmegiani's** RBI double down the right-field line, his second RBI of the game, trimmed the deficit to one before **Leo Jimenez** gave the Fisher Cats the lead for good in the eighth with a two-run double down the right-field line off Somerset right-hander Zac Houston. It was Jimenez's 15th and 16th RBIs in the month of June, which leads the team. Palmegiani, Jimenez and Morris all recorded multi-RBI performances with **Rainer Nunez** and Morris collecting multi-hit performances. Right-hander **T.J. Brock** picked up his first Double-A win after throwing 1.1 innings of shutout relief beginning in the seventh with three strikeouts. After giving up four earned runs in his Double-A debut, Brock has now allowed just one earned run over his last 7.1 innings pitched. Left-hander **Mason Fluharty** recorded his second Double-A save, his first on the road, with a scoreless ninth and two strikeouts.

FIRST HALF HIGHLIGHTS: In the first half, New Hampshire's pitching staff posted the fourth-lowest ERA in the league at 3.94, behind Somerset, Richmond and Akron. The Fisher Cats struck out the second-most hitters in the league, averaging 9.8 strikeouts a game while allowing the second-fewest home runs in the league (58). New Hampshire lost just one road series out of six, putting up a 19-14 record at opposing ballparks. **Orelvis Martinez** hit 17 home runs, one shy of the league lead, and put up the third-most RBIs in the circuit. **Steward Berroa** swiped 27 bases, second-most in the league and **Adam Kloffenstein** posted the fifth-best ERA, struck out the third-most hitters, and threw the fourth-most innings in the league in a breakout first-half.

NOT A VIRGO BUT A LEO: In 20 games this month of June, **Leo Jimenez** leads the team with 12 extra base hits and 16 RBIs. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect has a .295 average to go along with nine doubles and three home runs this month. Before being activated off the injured list on May 23, the Blue Jays No. 19 prospect had just one extra base hit all season.

1, 2, 3...CHEESE! : Right-hander **Chad Dallas** gets the starting nod for the Fisher Cats in the series opener. Dallas is coming off one of his best road starts last week at Somerset, going 6.2 innings and allowing just one run on two hits and one walk while striking out seven. Last time against Portland on May 26, the 23-year-old threw five innings, allowing four hits, one unearned run, no walks and four strikeouts in a no-decision at Hadlock Field.

FUTURES GAME BOUND: On Monday, right-handed pitcher **Sem Robberse** was named to the American League roster for the 2023 All-Star Futures Game to be held in Seattle at T-Mobile Park on July 8. He and former Fisher Cat **Yosver Zulueta** will represent the Blue Jays for the seven-inning game. Robberse, the Blue Jays No. 7 prospect, ranks fifth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (67.1) and 11th in strikeouts (66). The 21-year-old Netherlands native is the 15th Fisher Cat to be selected for the Futures Game in team history.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 28, 2004) - After Maikel Jova hit the first walk-off homer in team history to give the Fisher Cats a 5-4 win over New Britain, Jamie Vermilyea followed it up with a perfect game in a 2-0 win at Gill Stadium. Vermilyea was making his first start for the Fisher Cats. It's still the only perfect game in team history.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (43-37) fell in the series opener to San Francisco 3-0. Kevin Gausman struck out 12 in six innings but received no run support in the loss...Triple-A Buffalo (34-41) split the series at Scranton/Wilkes Barre. The Bisons will host Worcester this week...High-A Vancouver (40-29) took the series opener yesterday vs Spokane 2-1. Michael Dominguez threw six scoreless innings to pick up the win...Class A Dunedin (32-37) lost five of six to Clearwater. They will host St. Lucie this week.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue the home stand this week against Portland – which will feature four Fireworks Nights, including July 3. Promotions also include Pride Night Wednesday, Star Wars Night Thursday with postgame Atlas Fireworks and Italian Plumbers Appreciation Night Friday.
