FISHER CATS RIDE EIGHT-RUN THIRD INNING TO VICTORY: The Fisher Cats exploded for 12 runs on 10 hits as they outscored Portland 12-0 after the first inning en route to their largest victory of the year. LJ Talley homered twice and Samad Taylor drove in three while scoring thrice to power the Fisher Cats to their first win in the last seven games against the Sea Dogs.

YOU OTTO KNOW BETTER: Otto Lopez hustled out an infield single to extend his hitting streak to a Double-A Northeast-leading thirteen games. His .375 batting average is good for fourth in the league, and he also leads the league in hits (24) and doubles (9).

RE-TALLEY-ATION: Just one day after LJ Talley was slighted of his first Double-A home run, the recent Georgia graduate hit a grand slam and a two-run shot to make amends. It was the first multi-home run game of his professional career, and the six RBI performance was also a career high.

EARLY STREAKS: Otto López's 13-game hit streak isn't the only Fisher Cats streak. Gabriel Moreno, who was recently added to *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list, also carries a 10-game hitting streak into tonight's contest. Moreno got the night off for Tuesday's contest, and his .415 average is third in the league to Erie's Jacob Robson (.442) and Binghamton's Yoel Romero (.438).

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats welcome the Portland Sea Dogs (Red Sox Double-A affiliate) to Delta Dental Stadium this week. It is be the first of three trips to New Hampshire for the Sea. New Hampshire lost five of six at Hadlock Field to open the season. Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to New Jersey to wrap up the season series with the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees Double-A affiliate).

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 21, 2019 – The Fisher Cats opened a three-game series with the Altoona Curve with a 5-0 win at Delta Dental Stadium. Yennsy Diaz worked seven innings of scoreless ball, allowing only two hits, in the win. Christian Williams hit a three-run homer.

FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays carried a lead into the ninth, but a J.D. Martinez home run secured the 8-7 comeback win for the first-place Red Sox. Worcester beat Buffalo by a final score of 4 to 1. Dunedin shut out Clearwater for eight innings, eventually winning 6-2 on the back of a 12-hit performance. Vancouver won their eighth straight game in nail-biting fashion, defeating Hillsboro 2-1 courtesy of a ninth inning run.

ON THE HILL: LHP Zach Logue is coming off the longest start of the year by a New Hampshire starter, going five and two-thirds in a no decision effort against Somerset. Opposite Logue will be RHP A.J. Politi, who lost his first game of the year to the Fisher Cats on opening day.

Tomorrow's starter

Simeon Woods Richardson takes the mound on Saturday night. He went five scoreless innings on Sunday afternoon in New Hampshire's first shutout of the season, 6-0. He allowed four hits, walked four and struck out seven.

Woods Richardson was drafted by the Mets in the 2nd round (48th overall) in the 2018 draft out of Kempner HS (Sugar Land, TX.). He was part of the trade on 7/28/19 when the Blue Jays sent RHP Marcus Stroman and cash to the NY Mets for LHP Anthony Kay and Richardson. Pitched only at the Adv. A level in 2019 with Columbia (Mets) and Dunedin.

Richardson is the #4 prospect in the organization according to MLB.com's Prospect Ratings.
