Looking to Split

Today, Reading plays the final game on the road at the Portland Sea Dogs as the R-Phils look to salvage a series split. Looking ahead, Portland comes to Reading July 14-16 and again from September 5-10. The R-Phils return to Portland from June 20-25. Last season, Reading won the season series over the Sea Dogs 10-8. The teams split the one series at Hadlock Field in 2022.

Kept it Close

Reading suffered a tight 3-2 loss to Portland yesterday afternoon. Portland struck first with two runs in the third off of R-Phils starter Josh Hendrickson. After 4.1 no-hit innings from Wyatt Olds, Reading got a hit off Jacob Webb from Johan Rojas to tie the game at two. But, a throwing error from catcher Hebert Iser on a stolen base of third gave Portland the lead back for good in the bottom of the seventh inning for a Saturday afternoon win for the Sea Dogs.

Oliver Getting it Dunn

Oliver Dunn reached base five times Friday night, which included a season-high three hits. Dunn now has six multi-hit games on the young season so far. The three-hit affair was Dunn's first since Apr. 9, 2022, when he played for Somerset, and it came against the Reading Fightin Phils.

Fielding Finding its Footing

After a struggle in the field to open the season, Reading's defense has been a bright spot these last few games. After ranking at the bottom of the league in fielding percentage, the R-Phils now rank 8th in the Eastern League. The R-Phils went five-straight games without a defensive error, before two errors in yesterday's game.

Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies had a 4-3 win over the Colorado Rockies yesterday to grab a 2-1 series edge. The two teams are back in action this afternoon a little after 12 p.m. to close the four-game set. Lehigh Valley and Worcester were postponned last night and will play a doubleheader today. Jersey Shore and Aberdeen were also postponned last night, while Clearwater fell in a tight 7-6 game at Tampa last night.

Looking Ahead

After today, Reading will travel back to Pennsylvania and welcome fellow PA team the Altoona Curve. The Curve and Bowie Baysox were postponned yesterday and Altoona enters today's matchup 6-7 on the season. Altoona has taken three-of-four games from Bowie so far entering today's series finale.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 23, 2016: At Reading, the Fightin Phils score two runs on an error in the 9th inning to tie the game at three, then beat New Hampshire, 4-3, when Rhys Hoskins leads off the bottom of the 11th with a homer.

Watching The Dogs

After three of five so far in the series, Portland enters today's matchup 10-4 on the season and leads the Eastern League Northeast Divison by two games. The Sea Dogs are coming off a series win over New Hampshire, where Portland took four-of-six games on the road. After this series, the Sea Dogs take the long trip south and west for six games at Erie and then immediately six games at Akron.

Looking "Sharp" on the Mound

Tonight's Sea Dogs starter is righty Sterling Sharp. Some would say Sterling was "sharp" against the R-Phils to open the series on Tuesday. He went six-strong innings, allowing just two hits and no runs, while sending three Fightin Phils down on strikes. Overall this season, Sharp owns a 0.75 ERA over 12 innings pitched, with seven punchouts.
