Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds bounced back with a 7-5 win over the Fredericksburg Nationals on Wednesday afternoon. The Shorebirds got on the board first with back-to-back RBI base hits by **Raylin Ramos** and **Jordan Sanchez** in the third inning, making it 2-0. A successful squeeze bunt by Juan Ortega scored **Luis Almeyda** in the fourth, putting the Shorebirds in front 3-0. **Jack Moroknek** got the Fred Nats on the board in the bottom half with an RBI single, making it a 3-1 game. In the sixth, **Felix Amparo** put Delmarva back up three with a sacrifice fly, pushing the advantage to 4-1. The Fred Nats made their move, scoring four unanswered runs, with one in the sixth and three in the seventh, to take their first lead at 5-4. However, the Shorebirds had one final answer in the top of the eighth, as **Juan Ortega** put the Shorebirds up for good with a three-run home run, giving Delmarva a 7-5 lead. They'd hold on from there to even the series at one game apiece.

Hits in Bunches: The Delmarva Shorebirds have started the season strong offensively, scoring 60 runs on 93 hits through the first 11 games. The team is currently second in the league in batting average at .258, led by **Cobb Hightower**, who owns a .406 average, the second-best mark among all hitters in the league. He has at least one hit in seven of his first eight games, including four multi-hit games.

Self Inflicted Wounds: The Shorebirds' defense has struggled to start the year, committing 20 errors that have led to 16 unearned runs—both the most in the league. Delmarva pitchers have also struggled to control the zone early in the season, allowing the most walks (75) and leading the league in hit-by-pitchers (21).

Praise the Lord: Kiefer Lord put together the best start of his young career on April 9 against Augusta, striking out a career-high 10 batters in 3.2 innings while walking none. He followed that up by throwing a career-high five innings on April 15 at Fredericksburg, with eight more strikeouts. His 21 strikeouts are currently tied for the most in the league.

Listen to the DJ: It's been a great start to the season for **DJ Layton** in his first stint with the Shorebirds. The 19-year-old utility man has reached base at least once in all nine of his starts, collecting a hit in eight of those nine, including four multi-hit games. He has reached base in 19 of his first 38 plate appearances and owns a .647 batting average on balls in play. He is currently tied with **Joshua Liranzo** for the team lead with 7 RBIs.

Quick Whit: Braylon Whitaker has quietly found his groove at the plate, currently riding a six-game hitting streak and recording RBIs in three of those games. He is also on an eight-game on-base streak and has been on base safely in all but one game this season.

Sloan and Steady: LHP Braeden Sloan has started the season as one of Delmarva's dominant arms out of the bullpen. The 17th-round pick from last season's draft out of TCU has retired 12 of the first 13 batters he's faced and has struck out 10 of them. That includes a perfect two-innings of relief against Augusta on April 8, where he struck out five of six batters he faced, thanks to his dominant change-up.

About the Nationals: The Shorebirds face the rival Fred Nats for the first time this season, in what will be the first of four series against them. Fredericksburg narrowly won the season series a year ago, 10-8, and has one of the most talented rosters in the league, with eight top-30 prospects for Washington on the team, headlined by **Eli Willits**, the No. 1 overall pick from the 2025 draft and the No. 12 overall pick **Gavin Fien** who was acquired by the Nationals from the Texas Rangers in the offseason.
