### "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

**SAINTS STUNNED IN DOUBLEHEADER SWEEP BY I-CUBS:** With steady wind gusts of 25 mph all night long, occasionally reaching as high as 40 mph, the St. Paul Saints and Iowa Cubs played an offensive slugfest. The two teams combined for 19 runs, 29 hits, and seven home runs, but the Saints came up short 12-7. The Saints scored two in the first on a leadoff homer by Edouard Julien and an RBI single by Carson McCusker only to see the I-Cubs put up four in the bottom of the inning that was started with a leadoff homer by Matt Shaw. With the Saints down 7-3 in the fourth, they got two, two-run homers by Mickey Gasper, his seventh, and Emmanuel Rodriguez, his third, to tie the game at seven. The I-Cubs, however, scored five runs over their final four at bats, including a second home run by Shaw (2-run HR in the fifth), and homers by Chase Strumpf (solo in the 6th), and Joanthon Long (solo in the 7th). The Saints didn't collect a hit over the final five innings.

**AND I SHALL LEAD YOU:** Edouard Julien led off the game on Friday night with a home run, the first leadoff home run for the Saints this year. It should come as no surprise that Julien started the game off on the right foot. It was his fifth leadoff home run for the Saints, tying him with Michael Helman for most in franchise history. Julien's last leadoff homer for the Saints was on June 16, 2024 @ Louisville. The last leadoff home run for the Saints was Payton Eeles on September 19, 2024 vs. Indianapolis.

**A BEAR OF A LINEUP:** The St. Paul Saints will be ecstatic when they can put the I-Cubs in their rearview mirror after this week. The Saints have faced five different teams this season and their ERA is dramatically higher against the I-Cubs than any of the other four teams. Below is the Saints ERA against all five teams they have faced:

**PITCHING PARTICULARS:** The Saints recent struggles on the mound continued as they've yielded 27 runs across the last 23 innings of baseball in Des Moines. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.69 ERA (84 ER, 113.0 IP), the second-worst mark in Minor League Baseball only ahead of the Rochester Red Wings (7.04) since the turn of the calendar page. Since the start of May, the Saints' opponents have produced an OPS of .948, the highest allowed by a pitching staff in minor league baseball among all 120 full-season teams since the beginning of May. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .884 is the tied for the third-highest in MiLB in May.

**CHICKS DIG THE LONGBALL:** After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 41 round-trippers in their last 28 games, which ranked tied for the most in the minors in that stretch, with the Charlotte Knights. St. Paul had left the yard at least once in eight straight games, a season-long streak for the club, until going homerless on Tuesday and Wednesday this week in Iowa.

**HEY MICKEY, YOU'RE SO FINE:** Saints utility man Mickey Gasper was named the International League Player of the Week for the previous week. After being optioned by the Twins for the second time this year on May 5, Gasper hit .478 (11-23) with two doubles, four homers, and six RBI in six games last week vs Buffalo. His 11 total hits and 4 homers were both tied for the most in minor league baseball last week and his .571 OBP, 1.087 SLG%, and 1.658 OPS were all the highest among hitters with at least 20 AB in MiLB last week. The New Hampshire native now has seven homers in 15 games in a Saints uniform this year, more than halfway to his career-high total set last season in the Boston organization between Double-A and Triple-A. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in MiLB by both OPS and wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure):

**MCCUSKER MCCRUSHING:** Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and is currently tied with eight others for 3rd in the minors in home runs (Sugar Land's Shay Whitcomb leads w/ 13 & Greensboro's Esmerlyn Valdez has 11) and ranks 2nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). On Sunday afternoon, he drilled a 115.0 mph laser over the left field wall, recording the fifth-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history. McCusker now has the three hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and six of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is the first batter in St. Paul Saints franchise history with double-digit homers before the end of May. The Sparks, Nevada also saw a career-long 12-game hitting streak come to an end on Saturday, the longest by a St. Paul batter so far this year, and a span in which he hit .423 (11-26) with 2 HR, 2 doubles, and 6 RBI.

**TWINS REPORT:** The Minnesota Twins (25-20) have won 12 straight, MLB's longest win streak of the season, after topping the Brewers 3-0 yesterday. Joe Ryan tossed 6.0 shutout innings and struck out nine. Three relievers: Brock Stewart, Griffin Jax, and Cole Sands, each tossed 1.0 shutout inning. Kody Clemens collected two hits and an RBI. Ryan Fitzgerald made his Major League debut and went 0-3. Wichita (20-17) fell 10-4 to Arkansas, Cedar Rapids (22-14) pummeled Peoria 13-2, while Fort Myers (17-20) took down Jupiter 9-4. t

**BASEBALL BLOODLINES:** Christian's dad, Kevin, played baseball at the University of Toledo and was a 10th round pick by the Oakland Athletics in 1987. He played from 1987-90 as a pitcher and reached as high as the Double-A level, playing for AA-Huntsville in his final professional season in 1990. His dad had a career record of 14-10 with a 3.40 ERA, including going 9-1 with a sparkling 2.89 ERA and striking out 99 in 84.0 innings in his first season as a pro.

**DIAMOND DAWGS:** MacLeod spent three years on campus at Mississippi State University from 2019-21, first redshirting his freshman year in 2019 due to pneumonia. He bounced back in 2020 and was named the Co-National Freshman of the Year & a Freshman All-American by the Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. MacLeod burst onto the scene in his debut season, striking out 11 in his debut start on February 15, 2020, the most for an MSU Bulldog in their debut since at least 1985. He'd go on to fan 12 in a start vs Quinnipiac on March 6, which ranked fourth all-time in program history in single-game strikeouts for a Mississippi State freshman.

**CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE:** As a RS sophomore, MacLeod would go on to help the Bulldogs win the College World Series in 2021. MacLeod pitched in Game 1 of the CWS Finals vs Vanderbilt, but recorded just two outs while allowing 6 runs in an 8-2 loss. The Bulldogs stormed back to win the next two games to capture their first national title in program history. It was the Bulldogs' 12 trip to Omaha in program history. As of May 16, 2025, neither MacLeod nor any of his 2021 National title teammates have reached the major leagues.
