**WON A SERIES:** After splitting three series in a row, the FredNats won a series last week in Columbia to kick off this two-week road trip. The second leg of the trip brings the team to Kannapolis, N.C. to face the Chicago White Sox-affiliated Cannon Ballers squad that was the first half champions in the South Division. Kannapolis beat Fredericksburg in five out of six games in the team's only matchup of the year back in June in Fredericksburg, outscoring FXBG 40-15 across the six games. Both rosters look significantly different now, and FXBG sends LHP Alex Clemmey to the mound tonight to make the first of two scheduled starts this week against Kannapolis. This is just the second trip to Atrium Health Ballpark in franchise history. FXBG took five out of six from Kannapolis in April of 2022 in their only previous trip.

**ABOUT LAST GAME:** In one of the games of the year, the FredNats held off Columbia 7-6 in 10 innings to secure a series victory over the Fireflies. Down by one in the 9th, Nick Peoples blasted a game-tying solo homer to send the game to extras, and FXBG got RBIs in the 10th from Caleb Lomavita and Brandon Pimentel to lead 7-5. Matt Bollenbacher had the bottom of the 10th and allowed one run to score with the bases loaded and nobody out. Bollenbacher got up a popout, popout and then struck out Carter Frederick to end the game.

**STANDINGS WATCH**: With 12 games remaining in the regular season, the playoff race is officially on in the Carolina League North. Fredericksburg leads the division by 2.5 games heading into play today over Carolina, but the Mudcats are a non-factor in the second half standings due to them winning the first half, so FXBG could theoretically finish second to Carolina and still make the playoffs. The FredNats lead Salem by 3.0 games heading into play today, and Lynchburg is 5.0 back and Down East is 6.5 back with 12 to play.

**GREEN IS HOT**: Since the All-Star break, Elijah Green is having the best offensive stretch of his young career. Since July 19, Green is slashing .297/.388/.505 for OPS of .893, which is the best stretch of his professional career at the plate. His wRC+ - which measures a player's contribution to run creation - since the ASB is 159 (100 is average), and his wOBA - which measures not only if a player reached base, but how he reached base and the impact it has on scoring on runs - is .420 (.320 is average).

**HE'S SOMETHING ELSE**: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. Since beginning his professional career that day, he ranks first in all of MiLB in strikeouts per nine (13.5), 1st in opponent average (.157), 3rd in WHIP (0.85), and is tied for 9th with 116 strikeouts. In his last seven starts, he's struck out at least 10 hitters in three of them, and has an ERA of 1.08 in that time frame. In MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of prospects, Sykora shot up the list to Washington's third overall prospect, and entered the Top 100 prospects in baseball as well.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 209-172 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Alex Clemmey makes his fifth start as a FredNat tonight, taking on the Kannapolis Cannonballers. It's the lefty's 24th start overall, having made his first 19 starts with Lynchburg.

Alex was acquired as a key piece in the Nationals' return for Lane Thomas from Cleveland. Coincidentally, the trade was made right before the FredNats and Hillcats were scheduled to start a series, so Clemmey simply had to switch dugouts.

**WELCOME TO PRO BALL:** Clemmey faced a rude introduction to the Carolina league, as the southpaw struggled mightily in his first month playing professionally. Alex sported a 12.60 ERA over five starts (15.0 IP), as opponents hit .306 against him.

**QUICK CHANGE:** Once the calendar flipped to May, Alex almost insantly figured out his April issues. Since his first start of May (5/5), Clemey has posted a 2.75 ERA in 18 starts (68.2 IP), with a 2.11 K:BB ratio, and hasn't allowed more than three earned runs in any outing.

**AGAINST COLUMBIA:** Alex has made one start this year against the 'Ballers, turning in four innings of one-run ball back on May 5th with Lynchburg, in a no-decision.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Clemmey spun his best FredNat start last week against Columbia, covering five shutout, one-hit frames.
