FOUR-RUN EIGHTH VAULTS JAX BY NORFOLK

Troy Johnston lashed three extra-base hits and the Jumbo Shrimp scored four runs in the eighth to beat the Tides 6-4. Samuel Basallo mashed two home runs - a three-run shot in the first and a solo homer in the third - to put Norfolk in front. Heriberto Hernandez's RBI single in the fourth put Jacksonville in front. The score remained 4-1 until the eighth. Deyvison De Los Santos notched an RBI single and Johnston added an RBI double to pull Jacksonville within one. Jack Winkler's two-run single put the Shrimp in front. Joe Mack added an RBI double in the ninth to make it 6-4.

THE CARDIAC SHRIMP

Prior to Tuesday's victory, Jacksonville's biggest come-from-behind win this season was from two runs down, which they had accomplished on four different occasions. The Jumbo Shrimp rallied from a 4-0 deficit Tuesday to knock off the Tides, their biggest come-from-behind win since also overcoming a four-run deficit in a 9-8 victory on September 8, 2024 at Louisville. Jacksonville notched three wins from at least four runs down in 2024.

BULLPEN BOUNCEBACK

Jacksonville relievers came into their series at Durham on April 29 leading Triple-A in ERA by more than a full run at 2.40. Against the Bulls, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen combined to surrender 30 runs, all earned, on 37 hits in 26.0 innings for an 10.38 ERA (12 BB, 31 K), seeing their season ERA rise all the way to 3.75. However, over the last seven games, the club's bullpen has bounced back to their old ways. During this stretch, Jacksonville relief pitchers have combined to work 36.1 innings, yielding just 12 runs, nine earned, on 17 hits for a 2.23 ERA. They have combined to total 38 strikeouts against 12 walks.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 31 games, a whopping 24 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 17-7 (.708) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 19-8 (.704) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-4 (.733) mark in one-run games. Those 11 one-run victories are tied for the most in the International League and tied for second in the minor leagues.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 19-5 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a 102-71 margin at VyStar Ballpark and claiming the Minor League Baseball lead for home wins. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 6-10 on the road, getting outscored by an 92-65 margin. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .719 (22nd in Triple-A) at home compared to .669 on the road (26th). Their team ERA is 2.30 at home (1st, also 2nd in MiLB) and 5.53 on the road (25th).

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 23 of their last 39 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have six games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank fifth in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 92 stolen bases.

PEAKS & VALLEYS

After beginning the season leading Minor League Baseball in wins with a 21-6 record through their first 27 contests, Jacksonville has lost nine of their last 13 games. The Jumbo Shrimp have been shut out twice during this 13-game stretch, and their 42 runs scored (3.2 per game) are the second-fewest in Triple-A. Jacksonville's offense has totaled 139 strikeouts, the most at the level during this 13-game run, with the club hitting a measly .224/.282/.327/.609, all figures that rank in the bottom three at Triple-A. On the other side, the Jumbo Shrimp's 77 runs allowed (5.9 per game) during this stretch is tied for seventh-most in Triple-A.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a season-high run of six straight games with an error by playing a miscue-free game on Tuesday... The Jumbo Shrimp have taken the extra base on 47.7 percent of their opportunities this season. The MLB average is 42.6 percent... Jacksonville relief pitchers have combined to throw 11.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to Saturday. They've yielded just two hits during that span.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeting.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourth-most in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
