LAST GAME

The Baysox faltered down the stretch on Thursday night, losing their seventh-consecutive game as Hartford pulled away 5-4. Each side attacked early as Bowie lead 3-2 after the first inning. Hartford jumped back ahead after the early opening on a two-run home run by Brenton Doyle in the fourth inning. Bowie, capitalizing on an error in the seventh inning, plated a game-tying run, as Jordan Westburg went 2-for-5 with two doubles, two RBI, and a run scored. Bowie got four innings out of Conner Loeprich, and eventually four innings of relief from Noah Denoyer. Each pitcher was stretched, as Loeprich allowed the go-ahead home run to Doyle in the fourth inning, and Denoyer allowed a go-ahead solo home run to Daniel Cope in the ninth inning.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Hartford and Bowie have settled to some very similar numbers over the first six weeks of the season. Entering the series, both teams have scored exactly 155 runs, while Bowie does have a slightly higher ERA, compared to Hartford's 4.40. Hartford has relied plenty on their speed, as they lead the league with 62 stolen bases, despite only having two players with double-digit steals so far this year. Hartford has had to coast on their early offense this season, as their starting pitchers have the third-highest ERA in the league, while their bullpen arms have the second-lowest ERA in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Michael Baird is a late change into the rotation for Hartford today, after making four relief appearances for the Goats so far this season. Baird has not thrown more than three innings in any of his outings this season, and comes off of a 1-3 record and a 7.27 ERA in the Hartford bullpen last season. Baird made three spot starts at the end of 2021 with Hartford, and allowed nine earned runs in 9.1 innings. The Colorado native spent one season in the Cardinals organization before being released and picked up by the Rockies.

HUDDLED UP

Bowie outfielder Hudson Haskin has been trying to find consistency at the plate this month. Haskin is only slashing .170/.290/.245 in May, with 17 strikeouts and one walk. Haskin has been notable for attacking the first pitch this season, putting the first pitch into play 17 times this season. This season, Haskin has gone 5-for-15 at the plate when he puts the first pitch into play this season.

DIDN'T SEE IT COMING

Bowie's current seven-game losing streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this season. Binghamton also lost seven-consecutive games at the end of April. This is actually the fourth losing streak of seven games for Bowie in their last three seasons. The Baysox lost seven-consecutive games in June of 2021, and "accomplished" the feat twice in 2019. The last time Bowie had a losing streak longer than seven games was in 2017, when they lost nine-consecutive games in June of 2017.

SETTLING OUT WEST

Infielder Jordan Westburg got a quick reset with a short vacation out of the top four slots in the lineup. In a 16-game stretch from 4/20-5/10, Westburg was only able to manage a 6-for-59 mark at the plate (.102) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, three runs scored, eight walks, and 23 strikeouts, all while batting among the first four spots in the lineup. On 5/11, Westburg shifted the fifth spot in the lineup for three games, and has hit 10-for-30 since, with seven doubles, one home run, eight runs driven in, and five runs scored.

STARTER SHORTAGES

Behind a handful of factors, Bowie has been having to rely on many of their bullpen arms for spot starts recently. While Conner Loeprich and Griffin McLarty each have starting experience in their careers, both have shifted into full-time relief roles before being called upon in the last two weeks to start. Since the start of Bowie's series with Harrisburg on May 3rd, Baysox starters have only accumulated 51.1 innings of work, an average of just over 3.1 innings per start, and the ERA from starting pitchers has risen from 3.70 to 4.53.

Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
