Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It is the fifth matchup of the season between the teams, as Reading won last year's season-series 11-8. New Hampshire has the 3-1 edge in the 2023 season series. Reading goes to New Hampshire from May 30-June 4 and again from August 8-13. The Fisher Cats return to Reading from August 29-September 3.

Slide Continues

Last night, the R-Phils fell 14-6 after multiple crooked numbers were put up by New Hampshire. After the Fisher Cats opened the game with four runs in the first, Reading responded with three thanks to a two-run home run from Carlos De La Cruz. The Fightin Phils tacked on three more in the third, helped by an Oliver Dunn home run, his second in as many days. But pitching struggled hampered the R-Phils the rest of the night.

Carlos De La Crushed

Carlos De La Cruz continued his hot streak with another home run last night, his second of the series. De La Cruz is hitting .326 over his last ten games and 5-19 this week. De La Cruz has seven home runs this season in 28 games and 115 at bats. That is good for a home run every 16.4 at bats. In 2022, De La Cruz hit 17 home runs over 365 at bats, which was good for a homer every 21.5 at bats. He's on pace for 34.5 homers this year.

A Look at the Pitching

Last night, the pitching for Reading struggled again. Mick Abel lasted just 3.2 innings and allowed nine earned runs. Adam Leverett shined though, picking up a season-high six strikeouts over 2.1 innings pitched. Reading's staff combined to strikeout 13 batters, which is a new season high mark. On the offense, they struck out 17 times, which also is a season high.

Chasing 1K

R-Phils Manager Al Pedrique is closing in on a couple of milestones in his storied managerial career. Including winter ball, Wednesday night's win gave Pedrique 1,000 wins in his career. But, when including just minor and major league wins, Pedrique needs to get to 46 wins this season to achieve the mark of 1,000 professional wins in affiliated baseball.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies opened up a three-game series at Colorado with a 6-3 win over the Rockies. Lehigh Valley fell back to .500 at 18-18 with a 7-4 loss to Memphis. Jersey Shore fells to Greensboro 6-4, while Clearwater won 9-3 in a rain-shortened game over Dunedin. The Treshers sit at a Florida State League-best 23-8 on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 13, 1955: At Elmira, Reading wins via shutout for the third consecutive game, blanking the Pioneers, 2-0. Nineteen-year old George Aitken fires a complete game five-hitter and Clell Hobson extends his hitting streak to 11 straight games.

New Opponent

For the first time this season, Reading and New Hampshire meet. The Fisher Cats are 16-14 this season and won four-of-six games at home against Harrisburg last week. After dropping the first two of the series, New Hampshire was won four straight. After this week, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Binghamton.

Report on Nick Fraze

Righty Nick Fraze gets the start tonight for New Hampshire. He started the season with New Hampshire and made a couple of appearences at triple-A Buffalo, before being sent back down. He's 1-2 with a 5.65 ERA over seven games and one start. Over 14.1 innings pitches, he's allowed 14 hits, 11 runs (nine earned), 11 walks and 12 strikeouts. He spent 2022 in New Hampshire, going 2-4 with a 4.85 ERA over 13 games (11 starts).

They found a bargain later on in the period, in January of 2018, when they inked Rojas for just \$10K. In each of his two years of full season ball, he's started slowly but finished well offensively, showing off his plus speed and defense at all stops. He made it to Double-A for the first time in 2022 and then finished with a strong performance in the Arizona Fall League before getting added to the 40-man roster. Rojas has shown he can be an impact player on both sides of the ball thanks to his near-top-of-the-scale speed. He's an elite baserunner, one who stole 62 bases in 67 tries last season and then went 13-for-13 in the AFL. His speed is an obvious asset in the outfield, where he is a premium defender in center field, one who could be a Gold Glov.
