Looking Back

Six no-hit innings from Tyler Phillips was spoiled as Reading fell 7-2 last night in ten innings. Reading took the no hitter into the eighth, but the Yard Goats scored seven unanswered runs in the 8th, 9th and 10th to secure the win. Matthew Kroon had two hits and Casey Martin registered his first home run since being called up to double-A on Tuesday.

Carlos De La Cruz has been red-hot for the Fightin Phils. He currently holds a 29-game on-streak and is hitting .293 over that stretch, which dates back to May 12. Overall, De La Cruz is hitting .292 on the season, which ranks 10th in the Eastern League.

Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he hit .423 last week and is .459 against Hartford so far. Rojas also leads all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks fifth in the Eastern League with a .305 average.

Consistent Kroon

Matthew Kroon has established himself as one of the most consistent bats in the Reading lineup. After missing all, but two games, in 2022 with an injury, Kroon has played in nearly every game this season and leads the team with a .308 average; which also ranks fourth in the Eastern League. Kroon also has played third base and all the outfield positions this season.

Bullpen Blues

Reading's bullpen struggled in the final-two frames last night. After seven no-hit innings from Phillips and Brett Schulze, the bullpen combined to allow six-earned runs in the final three innings. In wins this season, Reading's bullpen has a 2.31 ERA, but in losses it's a 7.43

Around the Organization

Last night, the Phillies beat the Diamondbacks 4-3 in ten innings. They'll look to win the four-game series this afternoon in Arizona. Lehigh Valley dominated Toledo 8-0 last night as Darick Hall added a long home runs for the Iron Pigs. Jersey Shore blew out Wilmington 16-5 as Rixon Wingrove had two homers. Finally, Clearwater fell 11-6 to Tampa while Williams Bergolla went four-for-five at the plate.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 15, 1987: At Reading, in the longest game in Municipal Stadium history, Shane Turner hits a game-winning homer off the right field foul pole to give the R-Phils a 7-5 win in 18 innings.

This is the third series of the season between Reading and Hartford. The Yard Goats currently sit in fifth in the Northeast Standings, three games ahead of Reading. Last week, Hartford dropped five-of-six games to Somerset at home, winning on Wednesday. After this week, the Yard Goats return home to host Erie for a six-game series to close the first half. Reading is hitting .321 against Hartford this season.
