Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders RHP Cody Poteet (3-0, 3.68) vs Worcester Red Sox RHP Sal Romano (0-0, 2.25)

Weekend with the Yanks – The Worcester Red Sox try to become the first team this season to win at least four games in a series against the 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA-New York Yankees) when they play game five of their 6-game set today at 4:05 pm (on NESN+ and NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). The WooSox have a 3 games to 1 lead in the series and have two chances (today & tomorrow afternoon) to win this series outright. The RailRiders have lost only one series all year (dropping 3 of 5 in an abbreviated set vs. Syracuse all the way back from April 4-7).

This Series – Worcester has gained their 3 games to 1 advantage thanks to consecutive comeback victories the past two nights in seesaw affairs that have seen eight ties and six lead changes combined during the last two games. Last night the Sox rallied from a 6-2 deficit after 3-innings and an 8-6 hole in the 7th-inning to pull out a 9-8 victory. That followed their back and forth, 13-12 slugfest walk-off win on Thursday. The Sox won the opener of this 6-game set on Tuesday evening, 8-4 before the RailRiders earned their only win thus far, 1-0 on Wednesday morning/afternoon. The series will conclude tomorrow at 1:05 pm.

Two for Ones — Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season — until Thursday night (and then Friday night as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until Thursday's dramatic, 13-12 win followed by last night's 9-8 triumph. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 3-5 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Chance to Get Even – The WooSox (now 21-22 on the year) can once again return to the .500 level with a victory today. They had climbed back to the .500 mark after their May 5th victory (at 16-16) for the first time in a month since they were 3-3 on April 5. They have not been over .500 since they were 2-1 on March 31.

Red Sox vs. Yankees – Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Omaha are tied for the best record in the International League. This week/weekend represents Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's only visit to Worcester all season. The WooSox do make two trips to Moosic, PA to face the RailRiders this season...the teams begin the official 2nd half of the IL schedule with a 6-game series from June 25-30 and then play another 6-game set at Scranton/WB from July 23-28.

Distance Apart – The WooSox are currently tied for 5th-place in the IL East and 7½ games behind front running Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. They faced a season-high 9½ game deficit on May 12 & 15.

Rivalry Renewed - Worcester is 36-39 all-time vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre including a 23-22 mark at Polar Park compared to 13-17 at PNC Field in Moosic, PA. The clubs finished 12-12 during the 2023 season series with the WooSox posting a 7-5 record here at Polar Park while the RailRiders went 7-5 at home in Moosic. Worcester went 10-14 vs. Scranton/WB in 2022 as the clubs split the 12 games at Polar Park but the RailRiders won 8 of 12 at PNC Field. During their inaugural 2021 season, the WooSox were 11-12 vs. the RailRiders going 7-10 at home but 4-2 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

What Have You Done for me Lately – Worcester is 8-6 in their last 14 games and they have won 11 of their last 18 games since April 28. They have also not lost more than two in a row since their season-high 4-game losing streak from April 10-14.

HomeGoods - The WooSox – who have won 9 of their last 11 home games at Polar Park – have begun their longest homestand of the season at 3-1. The stand includes these 6-games vs. 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre followed by 6 more games against the defending International League Champion Norfolk (AAA-Baltimore) and top prospect INF Jackson Holliday next week/weekend. The 12-game WooSox homestand runs through Sunday, May 26.

Home Getting Sweeter & Sweeter - Worcester has also won 12 of their last 16 home games dating back to April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 13-8 at home and a season-high 5-games over the .500 mark at Polar Park. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (13-10) than at night (8-12).

Four of a Kind – The WooSox had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a season-long 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 35 times this season.

Rankings – Worcester is 15th in the IL in team batting with a .244 average while Scranton/WB is 9th at .254. On the pitching side, the Sox are 14th in team ERA (5.13) while the RailRiders are 3rd with a 4.32 ERA.

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 11 CFB victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off.

Series Math – Worcester – 3 games to 1 in this 6-game set - is 3-4-0 in their first seven series of 2024 (3 wins, 4 losses, and no splits). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5th-place and 7 games back. They were in 8th-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

May So Far – Worcester is 9-7 in May. Sox pitchers have a 4.80 ERA (72 ER in 135 IP) with 12 HRA while Sox batters are hitting .250 this month (125-for-501) with 21 HR.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (19-16) fell to Somerset, 9-4 last night. Marcelo Mayer did have two hits & scored 2 runs and is now batting .304. Mickey Gasper had 2 hits & 2 RBI. Isaac Coffey was the loser – 4.2 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 4 ER.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of early afternoon.

Worcester has already used 48 players this season (21 position players and 27 pitchers) and that does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox last week but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on Sunday with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 10 players to Boston in the 6+ weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, and RHP Nick Pivetta who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec and Uwasawa are both back with the WooSox, Heineman is currently on Boston's injured list (rehabbing with the WooSox), and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
