Down to their final strike, Springfield tied the game at 5 on an RBI single by Chandler Redmond in the top of the 9th only to see the RoughRiders rally with two outs in the bottom half. The Cards continued to hit, putting together their 6th straight game with double-digit hits.

the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

ROAD WARRIORS: To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League. Winning 3 of the first 4 games in Frisco this week, Springfield is 34-20 (.630) away from Hammons Field this season, and .500 at home (29-29). The Cardinals' .630 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 36-19 (.655).

This week represents a clash of strengths; the RoughRiders own the best home winning percentage in Double-A at .667 (36-18). The Cardinals' three wins to start the series over Frisco at Riders Field is the first time the RoughRiders have lost three straight games at home this season.

POWER SURGE: The 2024 season has been a tale of two halves when it comes to the Cardinals' power numbers. Dispite going homerless in their last 2 games the Cards have still hit 41 HR in 43 games in the 2nd half, and has already eclipsed its 1st half total of 37. The Cards are on pace for 66 longballs in the 2nd half of Texas League play, a number that would have been good for 3rd in the 1st half

The Cardinals lead the league in runs scored (229, 5.3/game) and OPS (.762) in the 2nd half and are 2nd in SLG (.414). In the 1st half, the Cards were 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712).

CARDIAC CARDS: This week in Frisco, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in each game of the series, Springfield is 3-1 this week at Riders Field. The Cards have scored 17 of their 28 runs this week in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored the Riders 12-4 from the 8th inning on. Entering the series with 12 blown saves in 108 games, the RoughRiders have been charged with a blown save in each of the first four games of the series.

HITTING (IN) THE "DOG DAYS" OF AUGUST: After putting together their best month of the season with a 16-7 July, the Cardinals have gotten off the a good start in the month of August at 8-6. The Cards lead all of Double-A with a .291 batting average through the month's first 14 games and have also scored a league-high 80 runs (5.7/game). The Birds have racked up double-digit hits in each of their last 6 games, totalling 80 knocks during that time and are batting .348 since August 10.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 34 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .362 average while adding 10 of his 11 HR this season and a league-high 32 RBIs, . Crooks during that stretch is slugging a leaguehigh .654 and has a 1.067 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, Crooks batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games and is batting .400 (18-for-50) with 4 HR over 12 games in August.

MONTH OF TORRES: Cardinals leadoff man Bryan Torres is enjoying a red-hot start to the month of August. In 13 gamess, Torres leads all gualified Texas League hitters with a .420 batting average (21-for-60) and has also scored a league-high 11 runs. He set a new career high and tied a franchise record for hits in a game with a 5-for-5 performance on Wednesday night at Frisco. During his current 6-game hitting streak, Torres is 15-for-27 (.556).

LEAGUE LEADERS: Among active, gualified hitters Bryan Torres (.321/.410) and Jimmy Crooks (.319/.407) are 1-2 atop the league in batting average and OBP, while Crooks leads the circuit in OPS (.916) and SLG (.509). Torres is 1st in hits (116) while Nathan Church is 3rd with 108.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 21-for-21 and his 21 saves and 43 appearances lead all of Double-A. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 19.0 IP (0.47 ERA) and is 11for-11 in save opportunities. Svanson has been unscored upon over his last 16 appearances, allowing just 9 H with 14 K over his last 18.0 IP. The Cardinals are 44-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
