LAST TIME OUT

ALLENTOWN, PA (August 15, 2026) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped a 13-1 decision to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Friday night at Coca-Cola Park. The IronPigs took control in the fourth, sending the RailRiders to their third loss in four games this week.

Anthony Volpe staked the RailRiders to a 1-0 lead in the third with a solo homer to right-center. The 408-foot blast extended his hitting streak to seven straight games.

Lehigh Valley took a 3-1 lead in the fourth on a run-scoring wild pitch and a two-run home run from Robert Moore off Scranton/Wilkes-Barre starter Adam Kloffenstein.

Tommy Pham extended the IronPigs advantage to 7-1 with a sixth-inning grand slam. Lehigh Valley plated five runs on five hits in the seventh, keyed by a Carter Kieboom home run and a two-run single by Pham, giving Lehigh Valley a 12-1 lead before adding one more run in the eighth to close out the scoring.

Kloffenstein (2-9) allowed three runs on three hits over 4.2 innings with six walks, a hit batter, and two strikeouts in the loss. Brian Keller (1-3) worked five innings of one-run ball for the win.

NEWS & NOTES

IN THE LEAGUE - Despite the loss yesterday, the RailRiders remain in third place in the International League. They are now a game behind the leading Indianapolis and a half a game back from Worcester and only a half a game in front of Durham. The RailRiders are 3-7 in their last ten games and nine contests above .500 on the full season.

HE'LL NEVER BECK DOWN - Yankees #28 prospect Brendan Beck impressed in a two-start week last week against Rochester. He threw six shutout frames last Tuesday with a career-high 12 strikeouts. He pitched again on Sunday, allowing just one run in 4.2 innings while striking out eight. It was his seventh scoreless start that helped him record his team-high ninth win. In 21 starts, Beck holds a 2.66 ERA through 115.0 innings of work. The righty has allowed just 36 walks to 126 strikeouts. He has been honored with the International League Pitcher of the Week award three times and was deemed the June Pitcher of the Month for the league. His nine wins top the league as does his innings pitched, WHIP, and strikeouts. He is now second amongst qualified pitchers in ERA to his own teammate Elmer Rodriguez who boasts a 2.63 ERA. The 27-year-old was drafted by the Yankees in the 2nd round back in 2021 out of Stanford University.

DUKE'S DASHING - Duke Ellis tied a record for single-season stolen bases, after adding one more to his total last night. His 44 tied a record set by Tommy Barrett in 1989. Barrett did so in 120 games, whereas Ellis marked his in 81 contests. Ellis also holds the franchise record for 86 total with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in 157 games. The prior record was held by Nick Punto who stole 82 bags in 263 games. Ellis's personal record is 57 in a single year done back in 2024.

BRAD'S DEBUT - Reliever Bradley Hanner received his call up to the big leagues on August 11 and made his Major League debut last night. Hanner struck out the first two batters he faced including, Charles McAdoo and George Springer, but allowed a homer to Alejandro Kirk. Hanner finished the contest with just the one-run in the ninth inning. With SWB, the righty was elite, holding a 2.10 earned run average in 40 appearances. He tossed 51.1 innings, totaling 61 strikeouts. The 27-year-old was originally drafted by Minnesota in the 21st round in 2019 but signed as a free agent with New York on December 16. The Yankees added him to the 40-man on July 18.

WELCOME JUSTIN - The RailRiders welcome Justin Topa to their roster after he was signed to a minor league contract with the Yankees yesterday. Topa opened the year in the Major Leagues with the Twins and appeared in 23 MLB games, pitching to an 8.05 ERA in 19.0 innings. He was designated for assignment on May 17 and released May 23. Topa signed with Toronto on May 30 and worked a 3.38 ERA over 8 games, but was released on July 4. He then signed with Kansas City on July 7 and was assigned to Omaha, but was released on August 9.

GARVER GARNERS ON - Mitch Garver had his first appearance with SWB last night, catching and hitting seventh. Garver had a double in the ninth inning and also earned a walk. He was signed by New York on August 8 to a minor league contract. He was playing with Seattle up until that point, totaling 50 games with the Mariners. Garver also played in the bigs Minnesota and Texas.

SCOUTS SAY: "Beck's control & command are more impressive than any of his individual pitches, the best of which is a solid low-80s slider with two-plane depth. His low-90s fastball peaks at 94 mph without much life and his upper-70s downer curveball are both fringy but he survives because he locates them well. He has little faith in a low-80s changeup with modest sink. A good athlete, Beck repeats his delivery with ease while working fast. Not only does he fill the strike zone better than any Yankees farmhand, but he also moves his offerings around all four quadrants to keep hitters off balance."

PERSONAL: Full name is Brendan Thomas Beck... pitched four years at Stanford (2018-21), going 22-10 with a 3.11 ERA, 1SV and 2CG (289.1IP, 257H, 122R/100ER, 69BB, 289K, 24HR) in 55G/46GS... earned Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and All-Pac-12 First-Team honors in 2021 after going 9-3 with a 3.15 ERA (108.2IP, 38ER) in 17 games (15 starts)... was named a First-Team All-American by the ABCA (American Baseball Coaches Association) in 2021... was tabbed by Baseball America as the No. 80 overall prospect in the 2021 Draft... his older brother, Tristan, is a pitcher in the Giants organization...
