TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series against the Chattanooga Look outs at AT&T Field. This is one of two trips the M-Braves will make to Chattanooga this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves took their first road loss of the season, dropping last night's game to the Lookouts 8-3.

- RHP Alan Rangel went five innings, allowing five runs off five hits and a walk with eight strike-outs in his 2023 debut.
- The Lookouts hit four home runs, accounting for six of their eight runs. They led 6-0 before the M-Braves got on the board. Drew Lugbauer smacked a three-run homer to right field to make it 6-3 in the seventh, his second home run of the season.
- The M-Braves struck out a club-record 20 times and left five runners on base.

MISSISSIPPI

- THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer entered the season with a club record 46 home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26)
- The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 48th M-Braves home run on Thursday at Chattanooga
- MILLI ROCK: The versatile OF/IF Cody Milligan just lost a five-game hit streak. He currently has seven hits and four doubles. Milligan played in 68 games for the M-Braves last season, slashing .271/.345/.326 with a home run, 10 doubles, and 21 RBI.
- WADDELL YA KNOW: IF Luke Waddell has hit in all four games he has played in with five RBI and a seven walks, which is tied for the league lead. Waddell played in 41 games for the M-Braves last season before being shut down with an injury.
- Atlanta promoted Waddell to Triple-A Gwinnett on Friday morning, marking Waddell's first time on a Triple-A roster.
- THE GORDON MOBILE: RHP Tanner Gordon went five scoreless innings in his 2023 debut on Saturday, picking up a win. He gave up three hits and a walk with three strikeouts. Gordon made 21 starts for the M-Braves last season. In his final six starts, he posted a 4-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (11 ER/33.0 IP).

SIZZLIN' BULLPEN: The M-Braves bullpen has posted a 3.14 ERA over 29.2 innings in the first six games.

- RHP **Kyle Wilcox** posted 3.1 shutout innings in three appearances with six strikeouts, touching 100 miles per hour on his fastball. Wilcox is in his second year with the Atlanta organization.
- RHP Victor Vodnik tossed three shutout innings in three appearances. Vodnik made 24 appearances in Triple-A last season and received a NRI to Atlanta's spring training. He is currently Atlanta's No. 11 prospect on MLB Pipeline.
- In his Double-A debut, RHP Jose Montilla went three innings, allowing an unearned run with three strikeouts. Montilla has allowed one earned run in four innings.
- LHP Hayden Deal pitched two scoreless innings on Friday and picked up his first win with two innings on Tuesday. Deal made 31 appearances, four starts, in a long relief role for the M-Braves last season.
- RHP Alec Barger has three shutout innings over two relief appearances in his first Double-A season. Barger made 38 appearances for High-A Rome last season.
- BIG WHEELS KEEP ON TURNING: The M-Braves have already had several roster moves early in the season, with four players being promoted to Triple-A. RHP Beau Burrows, IF Luke Wad-dell, C Hendrik Clementina, and RHP Domingo Robles have all been promoted to Gwinnett this sesaon. Robles was transferred back to Double-A Mississippi on Thursday.
- M-BRAVES FEATURE 16 RETURNERS FROM LAST SEASON: The M-Braves Opening Day squad includes six Top-30 MLB Pipeline prospects and 16 players who made at least one appearance with the M-Braves last season.
- The Top-30 prospects include RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 11), INF Cal Conley (No. 13), RHP Roddery Muñoz (No. 21), RHP Alan Rangel (No. 26), RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 28), and LHP Luis De Avila (No. 30).
- Returning M-Braves position players include C Hendrik Clementina, C Javier Valdes, INF Cade Bunnell, INF Drew Lugbauer, INF Luke Waddell, OF Cody Milligan, OF Jacob Pearson, and OF Landon Stephens.
- Returning M-Braves pitchers include LHP Hayden Deal, RHP Tanner Gordon, RHP Coleman Huntley III, RHP Roddery Muñoz, RHP Alan Rangel, RHP Trey Riley, RHP Victor Vodnik, and RHP Kyle Wilcox.


