BRATT BRILLIANT, MISSIONS WALK-OFF RIDERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were upended by the San Antonio Missions 2-1 on Saturday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium, snapping a three-game winning streak. With the Missions (16-16) down to their final out, Romeo Sanabria hit a two-run, walk-off homer to complete the comeback. Riders (20-12) starter **Mitch Bratt** earned his third quality start of the season, pitching six shutout innings, allowing just one hit, while taking a no-hitter into the sixth. He struck out the final batter he faced in Cody Roberts to collect his 10th strikeout on the night, setting a new professional high. Frisco's lone run came off an RBI single by **Keyber Rodriguez** in the top of the sixth, plating **Sebastian Walcott** to take a 1-0 lead. The base hit extended Rodriguez's hit streak to eight games. In the bottom of the seventh, San Antonio's Brandon Valenzuela led off the inning with a double, but RoughRiders reliever **Larson Kindreich** induced a ground out and a strikeout. Next at-bat, a line drive clipped Kindreich and Rodriguez made a barehand play at third to preserve the lead. Missions pinch hitter Kai Murphy hit a lead-off triple in the bottom of the ninth. RoughRiders closer **Skylar Hales** then recorded the next two outs before Sanabria's walk-off homer. Hales (1-2) took the loss while San Antonio reliever Stephen Jones (2-0) picked up the win.

NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .310 (13-for-42)/.464/.548/1.012 over his last 14 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (26) and is fourth in OBP (.429) while leading the league in walk rate (25.5 percent), a mark which also ranks fourth in Minor League Baseball (min. 90 PA). He is currently on a six-game hitting streak, batting .444 (8-for-18)/.600/.667/1.267 with 10 runs scored, a double, home run, two RBIs and seven walks.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders have dominated the Missions over the last four years, but sludgehammered them in 2024. The Riders went 20-4 against the Missions last year and 12-1 at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Since 2021, Frisco is 36-9 at The Wolff and 64-29 (.688) overall against the Padres affiliate.

THE ROAD IS WHERE MY HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season, going 11-6 away from Riders Field. **Keyber Rodriguez** (.386) leads active Texas League players in road batting average. **Josh Hatcher** has hit all of his four home runs on the road, tied for the league lead. Frisco's 17 road home runs are second in the league. The Riders have averaging 5.7 runs per game on the road vs. 4.2 runs per game at home.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTER THAN THE SWORD:

The RoughRiders have pitched very well out of the bullpen in nine May games, allowing just 14 earned run over 41.2 innings (3.02 ERA). Overall, the RoughRiders have a 3.79 ERA out of the bullpen (ranked fifth in the Texas League).

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first six starts, his 1.99 ERA is fifth in the Texas League. It is also the second-best start to a season through the team's first 32 games (min. six games start) recorded franchise history, only trailing **Justin Grimm** in 2012, who had a 1.60 ERA through seven starts. His 3.9 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.80 K/BB is also first.

SCORE, SCORE, SCORE SOME MORE:

Outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** is off to a great start scoring runs in 2025. Osuna's 26 runs scored are tied for the most in the Texas League this season (Jac Caglianone and Kristian Robinson, 26). The outfielder ended a 17-game hitting streak on Wednesday, in which he hit .391 (25-for-64)/.453/.547/1.000 with 12 runs scored in the 17 games with six walks to five strikeouts. His hitting streak was tied for the third-longest in franchise history. He is currently on a 21-game on-base streak, reaching base at a .415 clip. It is the longest-active streak in the Texas League. Since his streak started on April 15th, the outfielder is second in the Texas League with his .338 batting average. Osuna is also second in the Texas League with 36 hits (Jac Caglianone, 40).

KEYBERRRRR, RODRIGUEZ IS ANYTHING BUT COLD:

Keyber Rodriguez has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 26 games this season, he is hitting .337 (32-for-95)/.393/.453/.846. He is second in the Texas League with his .337 average, but Peyton Wilson, who leads the league with a .392 average, is in Triple-A currently. So, Rodriguez is the active TL batting leader. In his last 18 games, he is slashing .368 (25-for-68)/.411/.515/.926 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, 13 RBIs, seven runs scored, four walks and six stolen bases. On an eight-game hitting streak, he is slashing .387 (12-for-31)/.424/.581/1.005. Over the season, he has seven multi-hit games.



ABOUT TREY

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

2025 SEASON

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-80 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
