GAME RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils beat the Hartford Yard Goats 3-1 on a beautiful Saturday night. Dominant pitching and clutch hitting gave Reading a big win. Herbert Iser tied the game with a single in the seventh Aldrem Corredor drove in the winning run in the ninth. Andrew Painter threw seven innings of one run ball. He allowed eight hits and no free passes. The #1 prospect struck out nine, for 141 K's on the season to lead the farm system. Matt Seelinger tossed a clean inning of relief and took the win. Billy Sullivan notched the save, striking out three batters to slam the door shut.

BRAND NEW BAKER:

Andrew Baker recieved the Phillies farm system Pitcher of the Month award for August. He garnered a 1.88 ERA in 14 innings. He struck out 23 and can hit triple digits on the radar gun. Batters hit just .185 against him, while recording a 39.7% strikeout rate. Baker was drafted in the 11th round of 2021 and was called up to Double-A on August 29th. He debuted on Tuesday inheriting two runners and stranding them on, getting the final out on four pitches. On Friday, he threw two clean innings with three punch outs.

CLUTCH CORREDOR:

Last night, Aldrem Corredor picked up two more RBIs in the ninth inning for the go-ahead runs. Corredor had a pair of singles in the contest for 83 total hits this summer. He recorded his career-high 14th homer of the season on Friday. He leads the team in runs batted in with 63. In the last 10 games, Aldrem has hit four homers. The 26 year old was signed as a free agent before this season.

HIGH STRIKEOUTS:

In 2019, the Reading Fightin Phils rewrote the record books with 1,271 total strikeouts recorded. 642 were by starters and 629 were by relievers. This summer the Fightins have 1,193 total punchouts just 78 away from tying the all-time record. Starters have compiled 498 K's while relievers have recorded 695 strikeouts.

PROSPECT CENTRAL:

The Fightins roster boasts many top prospects in the Phillies farm system. Andrew Painter (#1), Mick Abel (#2), Griff McGarry (#4), Johan Rojas (#5), Ethan Wilson (#8), Jhailyn Ortiz (#18) and McKinley Moore (#25) rank high.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies dropped a back and forth contest 5-4 to the San Francisco Giants. Philadelphia outthit their opponents 12-11, but also made two errors to their one. Bryson Stott launched his ninth homer of the season. The big club plays today at 4:05pm EST and sit 73-60 on the season good for third in the NL East.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

September 4, 1993: At Reading, the Phils sweep New Britain in a doubleheader. In game one, a 5-0 win, Robert Gaddy throws a 5-hit shutout. In game two, Craig Holman, Greg Brown, Toby Borland and Ricky Bottalico team up to toss a no-hitter, the first no-hitter in the Eastern League's history involving four different pitchers and the 5th straight no-hitter pitting Reading vs. New Britain. The 2-0 Phils victory takes just 1:15. A 6th inning walk is the Red Sox only base runner.
